

FS 34087 Gunze Sangyo H304/Humbrol 155 Olive Drab Neutral Grey FS 36173 Gunze Sangyo H053/Humbrol 156

> 1. The propeller hubs were natural metal. We suggest Aluminium. 2. Place fire extinguisher sign decal under elliptical window. Refer to reference material for exact placement.

Decal Application


Note


Cut around the required design.
Soak in luke warm water for 3-4 seconds.

Stand the decal on facial tissue.

Moisten the application with plenty of water.
Apply decal by carefully sliding off the backing paper.
Use decal setting agent to nestle decal around body detail.
Paint model with clear laquer to hide decal film.

NB: Decals adhere best to gloss surfaces. This decal film is very thin and will need extra care in application. We suggest using a small paint brush and tweezers when doing Step No.5.
