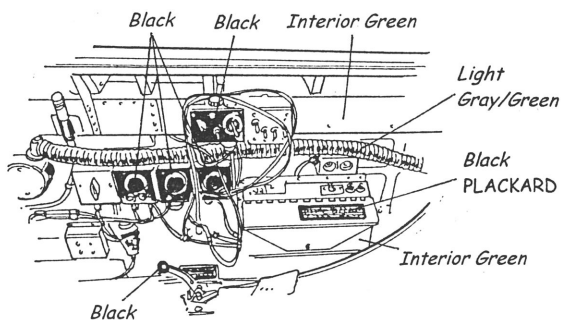
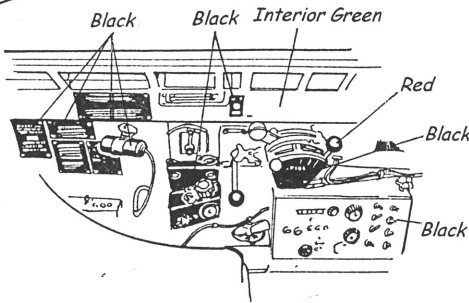


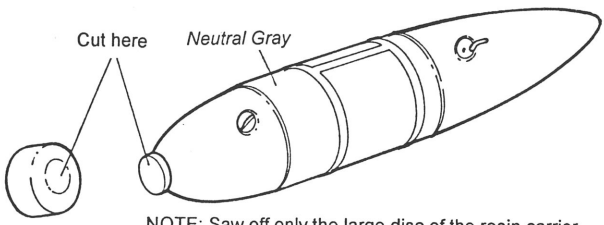
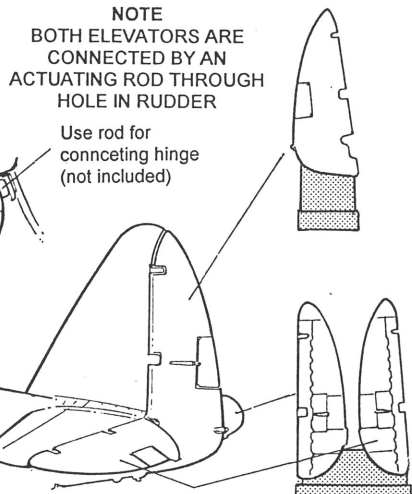
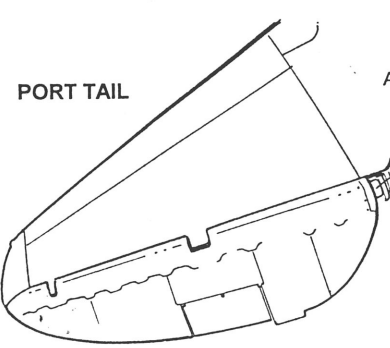
**PAINTING GUIDE FOR COCKPIT SIDEWALLS**

 Check AEROMASTER's catalog for colorful "RAZORBACK" markings.

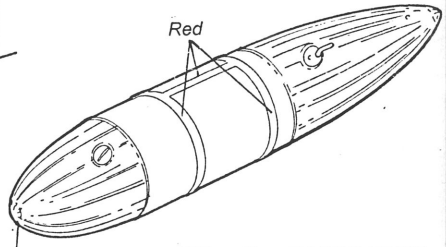
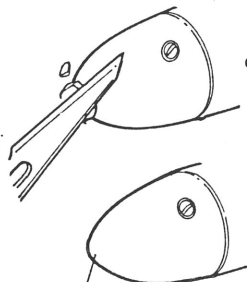
REMOVE SHADED AREAS



**NOTE:** Saw off only the large disc of the resin carrier. Shave remaining material to shape. Sand smooth

**COLORS**  
 Metal Tanks, when Natural Metal, often used straps of the previous underside color (usually Neutral Gray)

**COLORS**  
 Paper Tanks were painted very bright or dull Aluminum or the aircraft underside color. Straps were often a contrasting color and Red is identified in several color photos.
