

INSTRUCTIONS

Decals:



1

Make sure that the surface is clean and glossy.



2

Carefully cut the decals, to avoid damaging the printing.



3

Dip the decals in tap water and wait a minute or two.



4

Remove the decals from the water before they loosen from the backing paper and place them on tissue paper.



5

Place some water over the surface and carefully slide the decal from the backing paper onto the model.



6

Use some paper tissue to remove any air bubbles and excess water from the decal.



7

Use decal softening agents to better conform the decals to the surface of the model.



8

Wait some 24 hours for the decals to fully dry before applying any kind of final gloss coats.

Resin parts:

1

Carefully remove the resin molding blocks from the parts.

Safety first!

Resin dust is dangerous: **Wear a dust mask!**
Wear eye protection when cutting resin with power tools.

2

Prepare the place where the resin parts are to be applied. Carefully measure and test fit so that the resin part perfectly fits its sitting place. Use cyano or epoxy glue to bond the parts together.



3

Thoroughly wash the assembly to remove any dust, debris, grease or contaminants from its surface. Allow to dry.

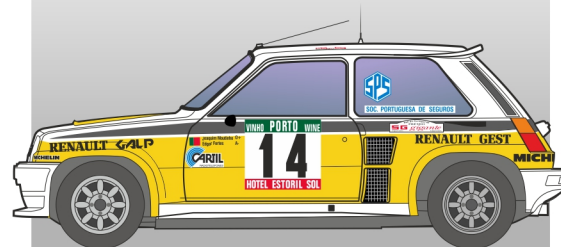

Apply your favourite primer and paint, according to the instructions or your references, seeing that the correct sequence and drying times are respected.

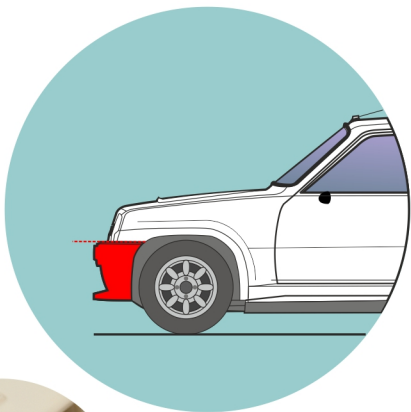

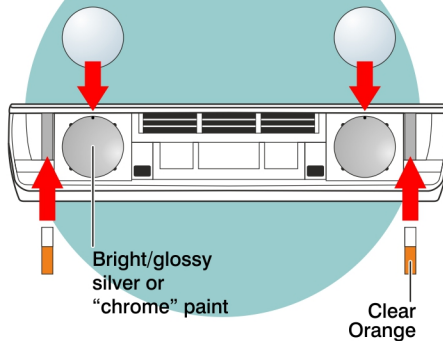

Carefully cut the bumper from the kit using the back of a x-acto blade. Work your way slowly to get the best results.

Tip: Keep the lower part of the kit headlights to help the aligning of the resin bumper.

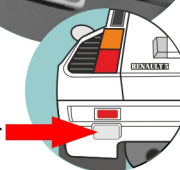


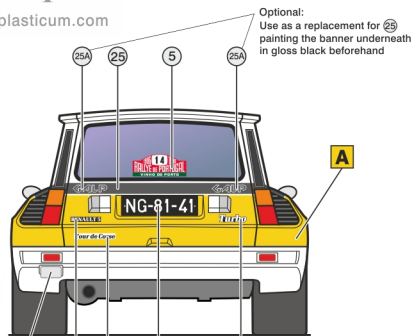

Leave clear



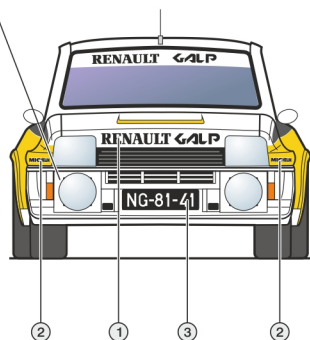


Optional:

in gloss black beforehand

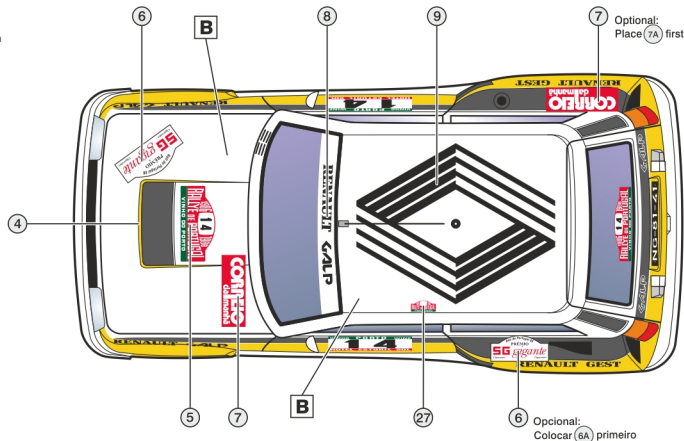
Optional:

"plasticard" strip → 18,5 x 4,9 mm

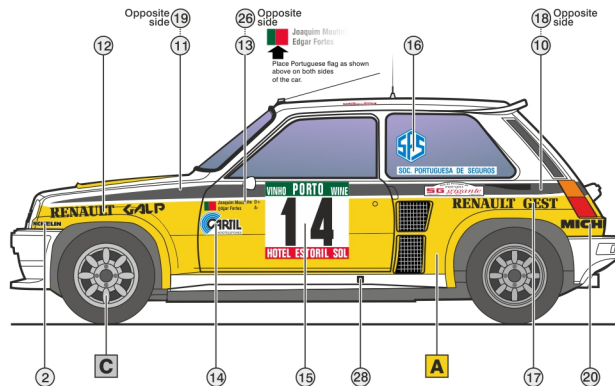
