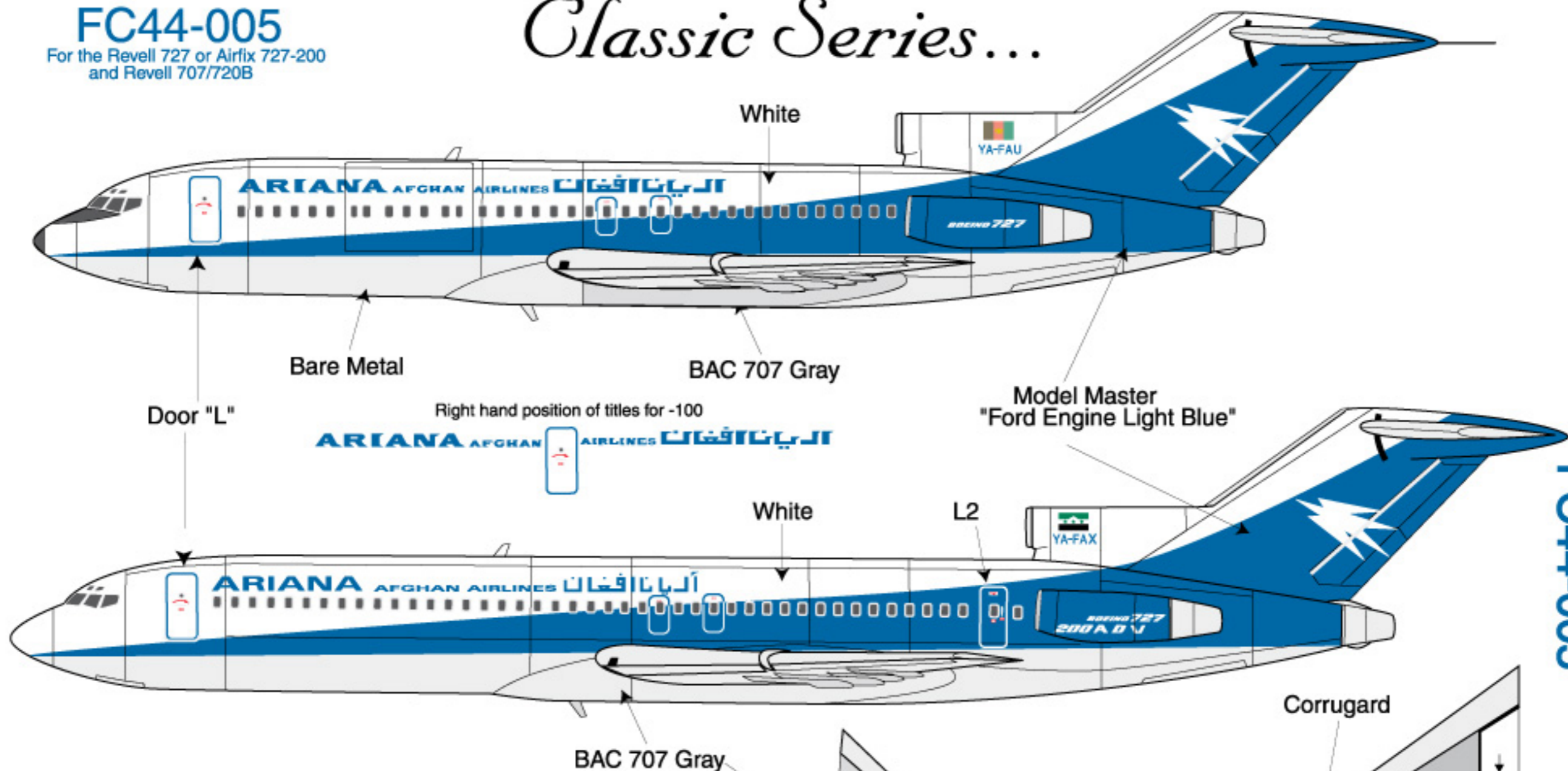

and Revell 707/720B

This decal will allow the modeler to do either a Boeing 727-100 or -200 as well as a Boeing 720B of Ariana Afghan Airlines. Ariana Afghan Airlines started flying the Boeing 727 in April of 1968. A total of three 727-100Cs were operated and one still remains in service today. Ariana's attractive scheme has remained virtually the same since delivery. The commie scheme of the 80s is gone and all aircraft have been repainted in the original delivery scheme.

Start by painting the upper fuselage white. All the blue areas should be painted Model Master Ford Engine Light Blue. All the blue on the decal sheet were specifically matched to this color, thus ensuring an exact match. Paint the belly bare-metal and the wings and horizontal stabilizers in the regular Boeing gray, corrugard and bare-metal pattern. It may be better to do the belly after the blue areas have been painted. Place the titles and flying bird logo as shown in the drawings above. The red, black, and green flags are the original flag. During the communist era, these were replaced by the red flag. The current flag is green, white, and black with green stars in the middle. Choose the right flag depending on which era you wish to represent.

In October of 1993 Ariana purchased three ex Air France 727-200 Advanced models. Again, refer to the drawing above for proper placement of decals. The lettering is different from the earlier scheme. Also, the anti-glare panel and black anti erosion boot have been removed from the nose area. The fuselage colors remain the same. The only difference being the gray belly instead of bare-metal. To do this aircraft you will need some decal parts intended for the -100. For example the left main door, over wing walkways, etc.
