Continental Airlines took delivery of its first Boeing 707-321C in September 1964. Wearing a revised Golden Jet scheme these aircraft would operate for several years before being repainted in the 3-stripe scheme and black meatball on the tail.

Paint the crown and fin gloss white and the belly bright bare-metal. To aid in masking for the curve at the nose of the aircraft, use the thin gold stripe as a template. A photocopy should help greatly. Paint the wings and horizontal stabilizers as shown.

Door outlines and wingwalks were not carried initially. They were carried much later in the aircraft's life and for a short time before being painted the next scheme. Separate door details have been provided if you wish to leave the door outlines off. Place other decals as shown and as indicated on the decal sheet.

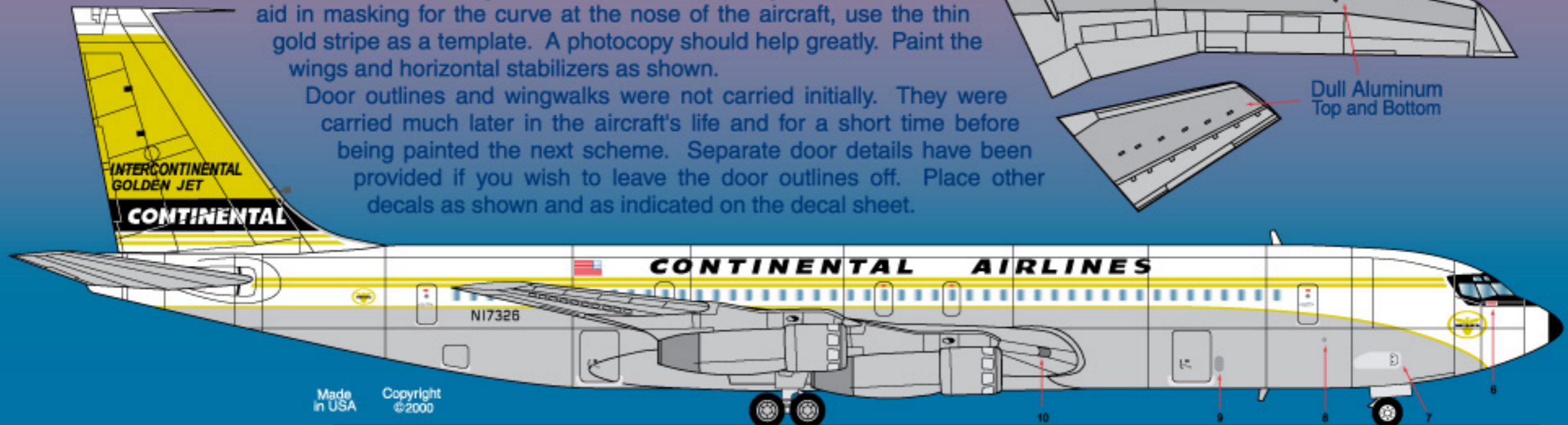
