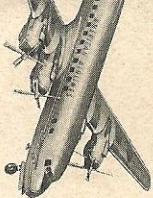


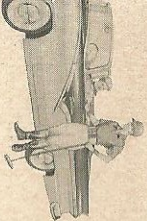

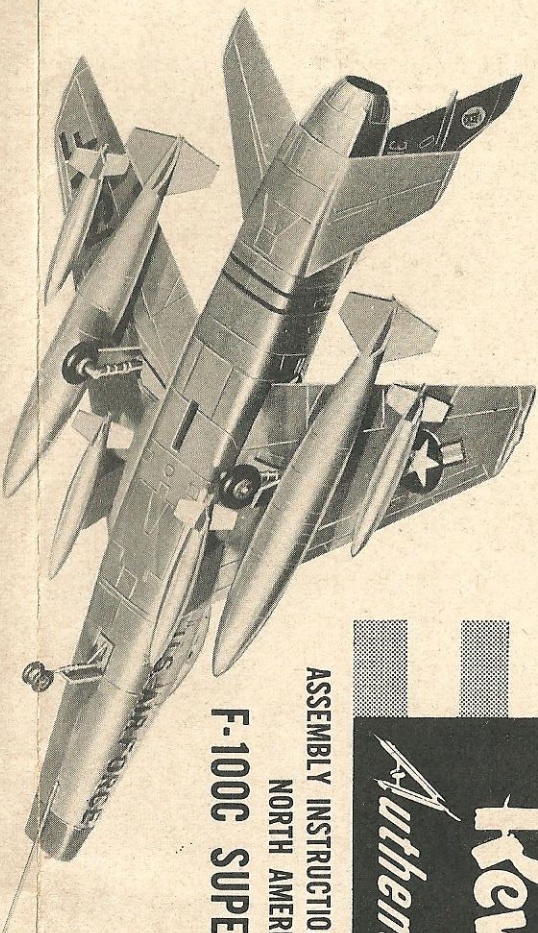

F-100C SUPER SABRE

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT YOUR F-100C SUPER SABRE

A recent addition to the fast growing might of the Tactical Air Command, the North American F-100C set the first supersonic aircraft record over a measured course. Flown by Colonel Horace A. Hanes, Director of Flight Test at Edwards Air Force Base, the Super Sabre streaked along at a clocked speed of 822 miles per hour.

The new long range F-100C, a late modification of the earlier F-100A, has provisions for in-flight refueling, extra drop tanks, and bombs carried externally, and improved electronics methods that will insure accurate delivery of bombs to the selected target.

The addition of the in-flight refueling system will permit the use of the aircraft as an escort for high speed bombers on long range missions, or allow it to be used as a fighter-bomber against distant targets.

The F-100C is powered by a Pratt and Whitney J-57 turbojet engine, with afterburner, and is rated in the 10,000 pound thrust class. It has a span of 38 feet, with wings sweeping back at an angle of 45 degrees, and an overall length of 47 feet. Its armament consists of four M-39 20mm. cannons, and its firepower can be further increased by the use of externally mounted rockets.

First Tactical Air Command unit to receive the F-100C was the 322nd Group of the 450th Fighter Day Wing, based at Foster Air Force Base, Texas, and commanded by Colonel C. M. Talbott.

Colonel Talbott stated on taking delivery of the planes that, "They will add materially to the Tactical Air Command's ability to strike back in a hurry in the event of any attack."

The Black Panther Squadron insignia, illustrated on your box cover, and supplied on your Decal Sheet, is the insignia used for the 21st Day Fighter Squadron which will add some authentic detail on your Revell Model.

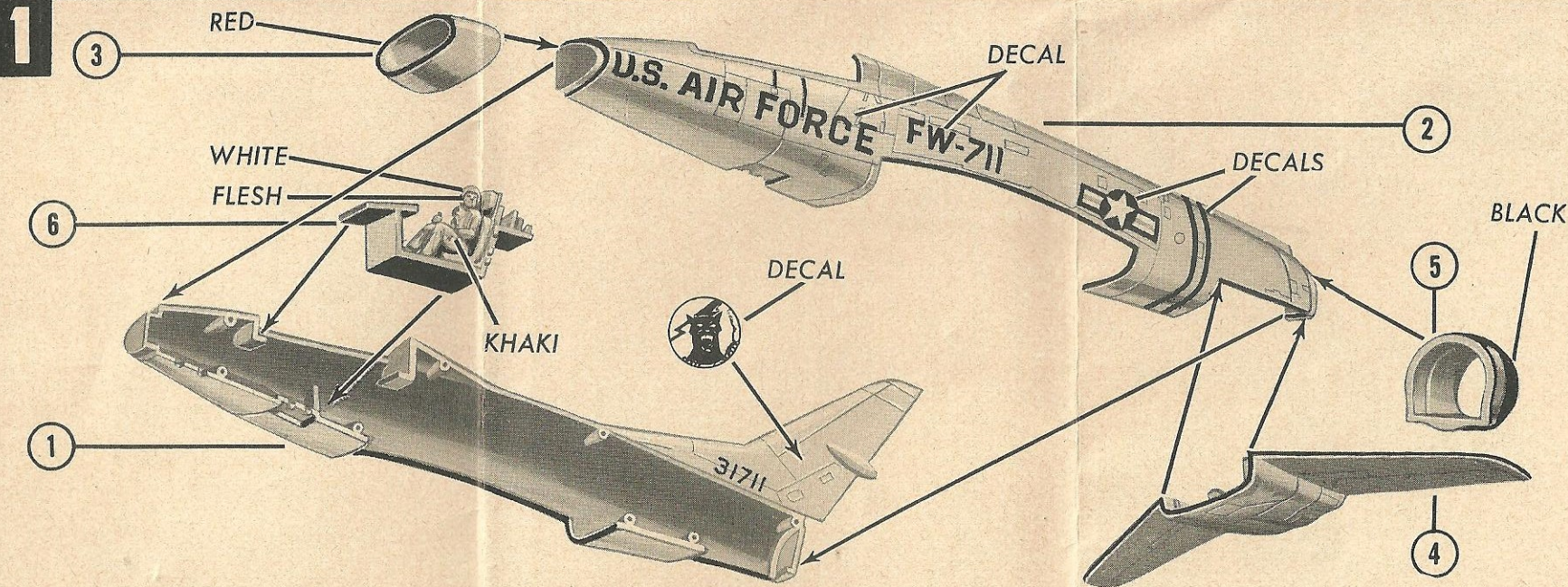

NOTE: Apply cement sparingly, since it will soften plastic if too much is used. Do not let cement touch the eyes or your clothing.

Read complete instruction sheet before building your model. This kit is molded of Styrene Plastic. Be sure to use only **REVELL TYPE © CEMENT** for best results. Ask for it by name. Be very careful when applying cement. Apply cement only to the area that you wish to cement. Before assembling this kit, where needed, trim all excess plastic from parts for a good fit. Paint all parts with **REVELL PAINT SET** enamel colors before assembling, if possible. Lay out parts needed for each step and follow carefully. Read instructions on back of decal sheet before applying decals. Apply decals after completing model.

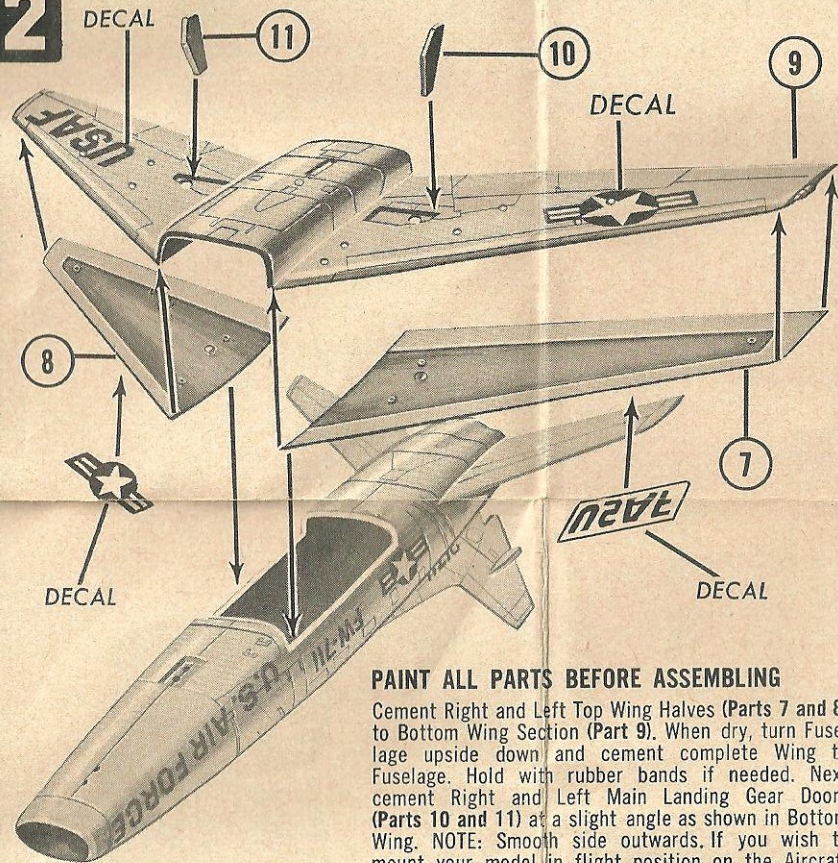


PAINT ALL PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLING

Paint Pilot and details before cementing into place. Now carefully cement Right Fuselage Half (Part 2) to Left Fuselage Half (Part 1). Next cement Jet Intake Scoop (Part 3) to

Front of Fuselage. Now cement Horizontal Stabilizer (Part 4) to cutout at rear of Fuselage. Cement Jet Exhaust Cap (Part 5) into place as shown. Finally, cement Pilot (Part 6) into place as shown. Set aside to dry.

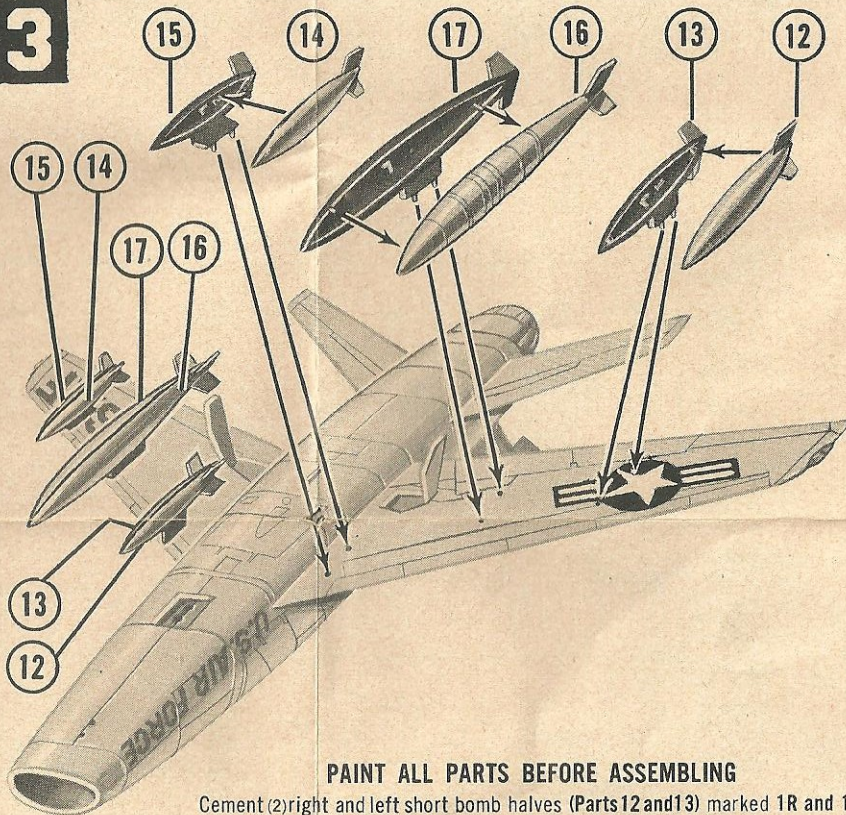


PAINT ALL PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLING

Cement Right and Left Top Wing Halves (Parts 7 and 8) to Bottom Wing Section (Part 9). When dry, turn Fuselage upside down and cement complete Wing to Fuselage. Hold with rubber bands if needed. Next cement Right and Left Main Landing Gear Doors (Parts 10 and 11) at a slight angle as shown in Bottom Wing. NOTE: Smooth side outwards. If you wish to mount your model in flight position on the Aircraft Display Stand, do not cement Landing Gear into place and cement all doors in closed position.

APPLY DECALS TO WINGS AT THIS TIME. SET ASIDE TO DRY.

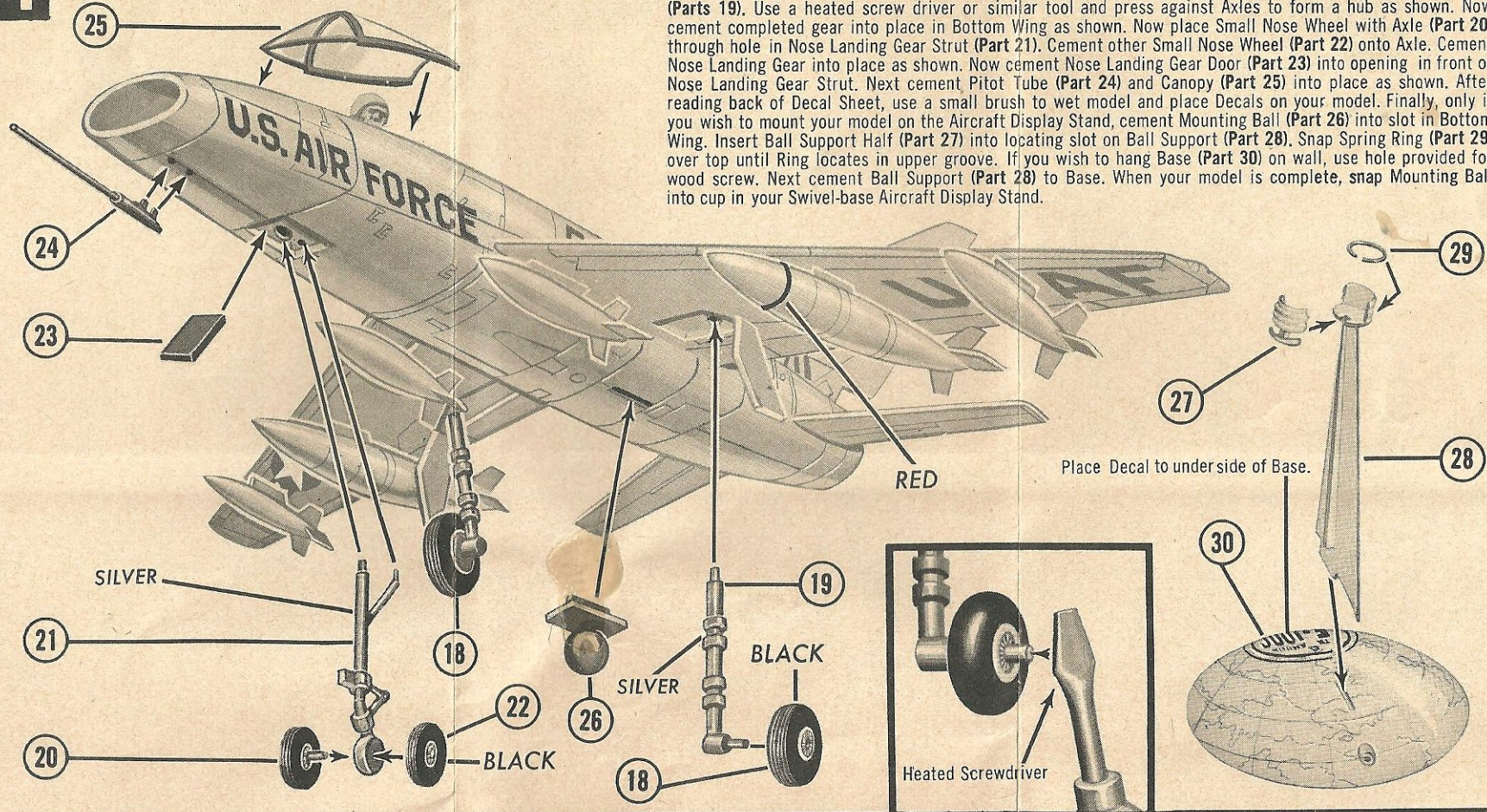


PAINT ALL PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLING

Cement (2) right and left short bomb halves (Parts 12 and 13) marked 1R and 1L, together. Now apply a small amount of cement to location pins on completed bombs and cement to location holes out toward tips on bottom wing as shown. Next cement (2) right and left long bomb halves (Parts 14 and 15) marked 2L and 2R, together. Now apply a small amount of cement to pins on bombs and press into locating holes next to fuselage on bottom wing as shown. Finally, cement (2) right and left tank halves (Parts 16 and 17) marked L and R, together. Now cement completed tanks to bottom wing as shown. Set aside to dry.

PAINT ALL PARTS BEFORE ASSEMBLING

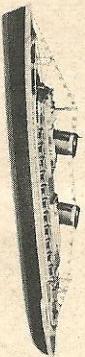
Place the Large Main Wheels (Parts 18) with spoke detail outwards onto Axles of Main Landing Gear Struts (Parts 19). Use a heated screw driver or similar tool and press against Axles to form a hub as shown. Now cement completed gear into place in Bottom Wing as shown. Now place Small Nose Wheel with Axle (Part 20) through hole in Nose Landing Gear Strut (Part 21). Cement other Small Nose Wheel (Part 22) onto Axle. Cement Nose Landing Gear into place as shown. Now cement Nose Landing Gear Door (Part 23) into opening in front of Nose Landing Gear Strut. Next cement Pilot Tube (Part 24) and Canopy (Part 25) into place as shown. After reading back of Decal Sheet, use a small brush to wet model and place Decals on your model. Finally, only if you wish to mount your model on the Aircraft Display Stand, cement Mounting Ball (Part 26) into slot in Bottom Wing. Insert Ball Support Half (Part 27) into locating slot on Ball Support (Part 28). Snap Spring Ring (Part 29) over top until Ring locates in upper groove. If you wish to hang Base (Part 30) on wall, use hole provided for wood screw. Next cement Ball Support (Part 28) to Base. When your model is complete, snap Mounting Ball into cup in your Swivel-base Aircraft Display Stand.



Place Decal to underside of Base.

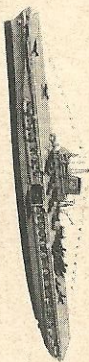

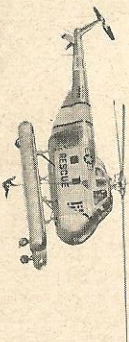
