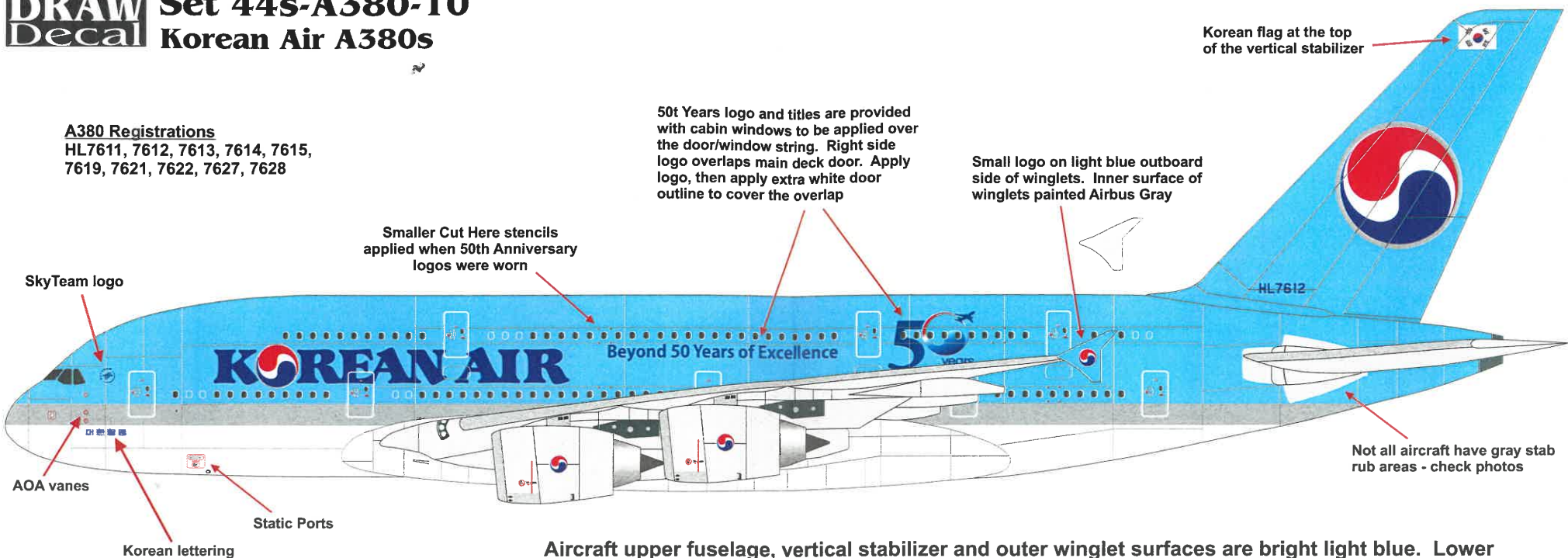


DRAW Decal Set 44s-A380-10

Korean Air A380s

A380 Registrations

HL7611, 7612, 7613, 7614, 7615,
7619, 7621, 7622, 7627, 7628



Korean flag at the top of the vertical stabilizer

50t Years logo and titles are provided with cabin windows to be applied over the door/window string. Right side logo overlaps main deck door. Apply logo, then apply extra white door outline to cover the overlap

Small logo on light blue outboard side of winglets. Inner surface of winglets painted Airbus Gray

Smaller Cut Here stencils applied when 50th Anniversary logos were worn

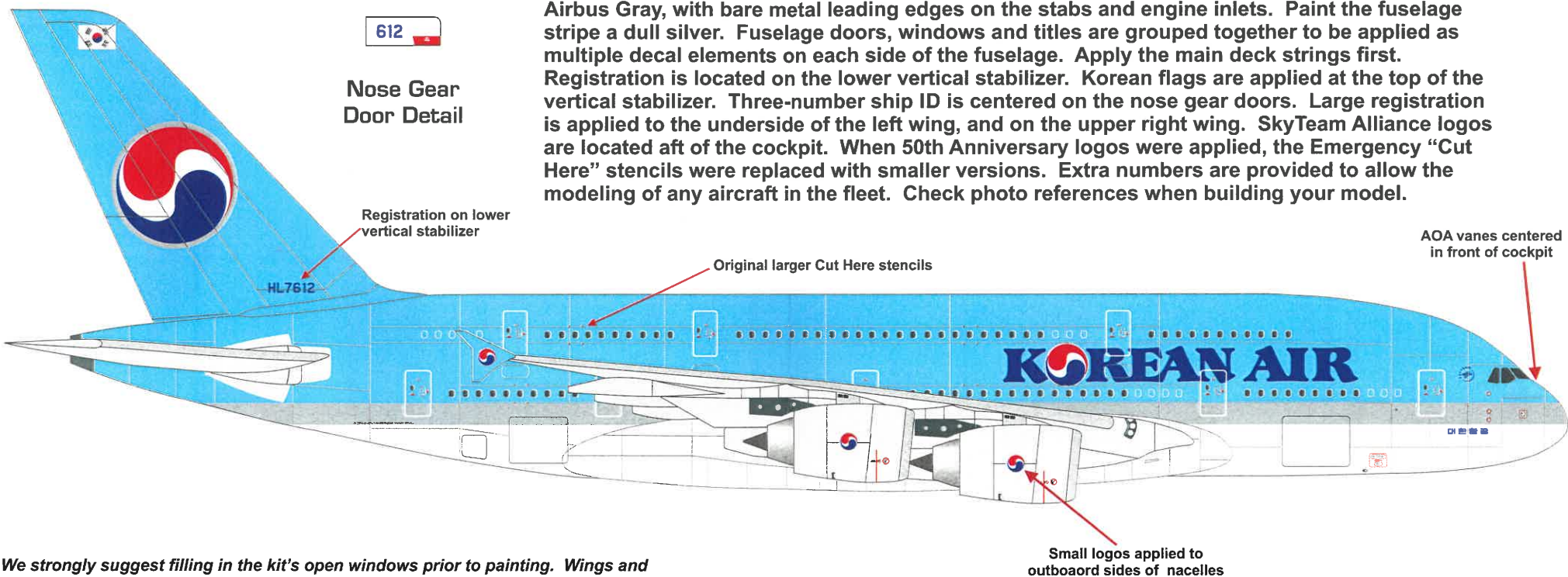

Nose Gear Door Detail

Registration on lower vertical stabilizer

Original larger Cut Here stencils

AOA vanes centered in front of cockpit

Small logos applied to outboard sides of nacelles

Aircraft upper fuselage, vertical stabilizer and outer winglet surfaces are bright light blue. Lower fuselage, is white. Wings, horizontal stabilizers, engine nacelles and inner winglet surfaces are Airbus Gray, with bare metal leading edges on the stabs and engine inlets. Paint the fuselage stripe a dull silver. Fuselage doors, windows and titles are grouped together to be applied as multiple decal elements on each side of the fuselage. Apply the main deck strings first. Registration is located on the lower vertical stabilizer. Korean flags are applied at the top of the vertical stabilizer. Three-number ship ID is centered on the nose gear doors. Large registration is applied to the underside of the left wing, and on the upper right wing. SkyTeam Alliance logos are located aft of the cockpit. When 50th Anniversary logos were applied, the Emergency "Cut Here" stencils were replaced with smaller versions. Extra numbers are provided to allow the modeling of any aircraft in the fleet. Check photo references when building your model.

We strongly suggest filling in the kit's open windows prior to painting. Wings and horizontal stabs have standard bare metal leading edges, always consult prototype photos.

Please note that filling in the kit's windows and door scribing will work best to allow the decal to fit properly.

PLEASE NOTE: ALL decals need to be applied to a smooth and glossy surface!

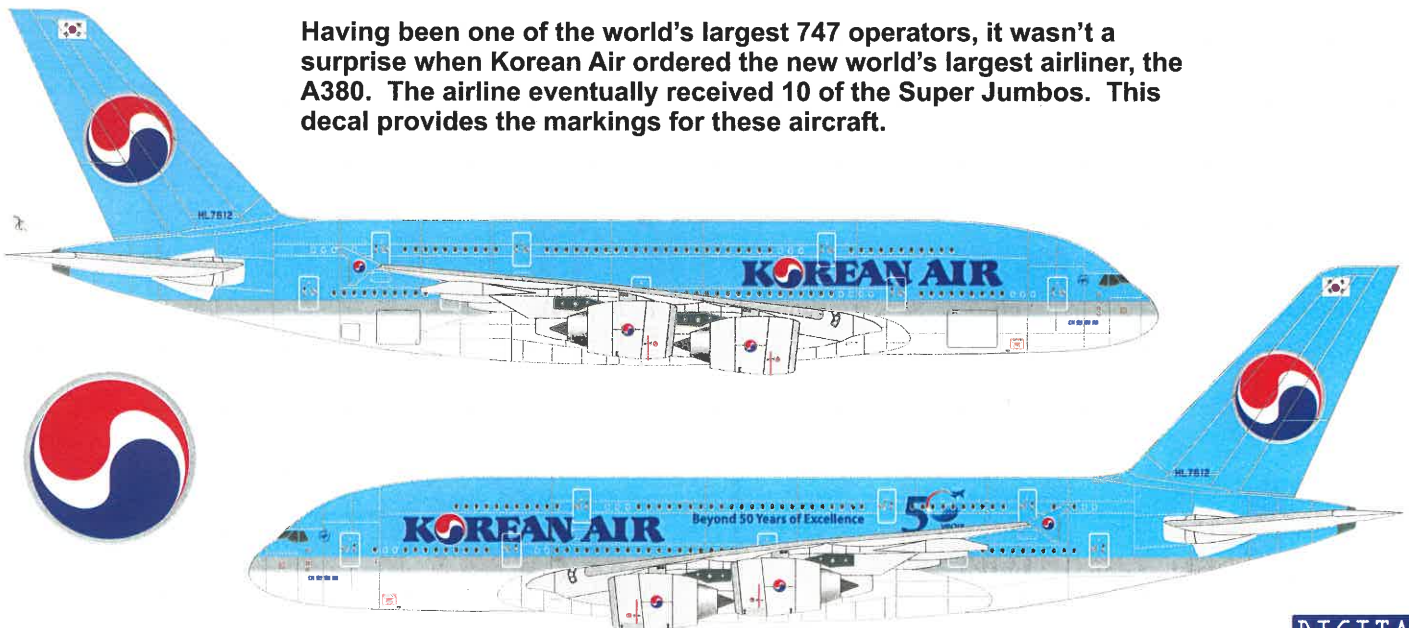
PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS, as these decals may apply a bit differently than you may be used to using.

Next Generation DIGITAL Silk decals are extremely durable and do not easily scratch, and are printed on a continuous, clear film. Each design will need to be cut out individually. **Next Generation** DIGITAL Silk decals do not generally need to be clear coated prior to use. Use care when applying as the decal film is **exceptionally** thin. **Next Generation** DIGITAL Silk decals are tough, durable and exceptionally *flexible*. **DO NOT** float the decal off of the backing paper, as it will curl up and likely become unusable. Rather, soak the decal in warm water for about 5 seconds then remove it and allow it to sit for 30 seconds before trying to slide it off of the backing paper. "Normal" decal setting solutions can be used with these decals but will have little effect. For most applications, NO decal solvent will be needed. If you feel the need, we recommend using Microscale's Micro Set (a wetting agent) and Micro Sol (a SOLvent), but note the decal solvents only effect the clear film and have **LITTLE** effect on the inks. Brush the Micro Set directly on your model before sliding the decal into position. Only slide a small portion of the decal off of the backing paper, place the decal into position then pull out the backing paper allowing the decal to land in place. After you adjust the decal into position and soak up the excess liquid, apply a thin coat of Micro Sol (the **solvent**) to soften the clear carrier. It is important to get the Micro Sol **under** the decal, as the solvent has little effect on the ink, but it will dissolve the clear carrier which allows the decal to dig into the paint. After this coat dries and you are certain the decal is in its final position, apply a second heavier coat of Micro Sol. Note repeated applications of decal solvent will only wash away the glue. After the decals are **completely** dry, clear coating your model after applying these (or any) decals is a **must!** I repeat this is a **must**. The clear coat will seal your decal and prevent it from becoming damaged. Airbrush lacquers only in very light, misting coats. Another method to clear coat the decal is to use Future acrylic floor polish. Good luck and thank you for using **Next Generation** DIGITAL Silk decals!
