




INSTRUCTIONS FOR MASK'S USE

OPTION 1: Painting white layers

- 1) Retire the elements inside the delimiting frame for the decal you want to place, to leave negative spaces for paint the white layer. (See example).
- 2) Place the delimiting frame on the model's area where the decal will be placed.




- **3)** Mask around the delimiting frame to avoid to stain the model.
- **4)** Paint the negative spaces of the mask in white to make the white layer for the decal and avoid that the decal turns darker at the moment to place it on the model.
- 5) Carefully retire the mask and let the paint dries.
- **6)** Carefully place the decal over the white layer and let dry.

NOTE: The vinyl of the mask contains a soft adhesive that allows it to be placed on a painted model without tear off the paint at the moment of remove it, but we recommend to test the adhesive to be sure it will not tear of the paint.



OPTION 2: Using vynils as white layers

- 1) Take off the elements of the delimiting frames (See example).
- 2) Place the elements on the model in the place where the decal will be placed
- **3)** Carefully place the mask on the white vinyl layer and let dry.



NOTE 1: The vinyl of the masks could be a little thick to use it as white layers, so this option is leaved to your consideration.

NOTE 2: The vinyl of the masks contain a soft adhesive that allows it to be placed over the painted model, but with time it could lift, so is recommended to apply a light layer of transparent varnish before or after to place the decal to improve its adhesion. If you apply the varnish before to place the decal, you must wait until the varnish dries before to place the decal.

NOTE 3: Most elements of the mask has a code near the delimiting frame, that is the same code of its corresponding decal.
