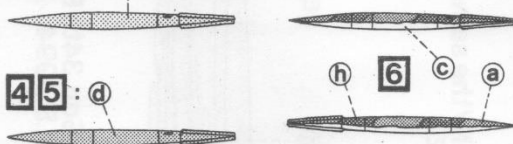

**1 2 3 : g Fuel Tanks "F"**



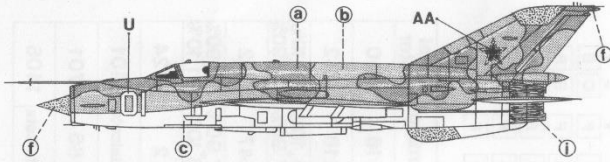

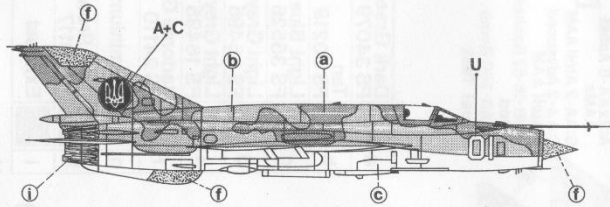

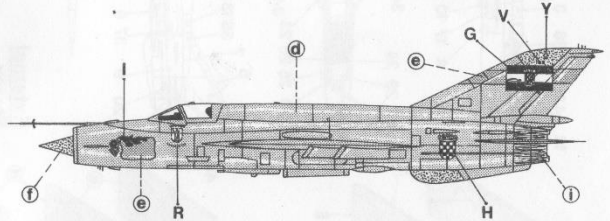
**1** MiG-21bis-SAU Fishbed N, Soviet Air Force, 1989.



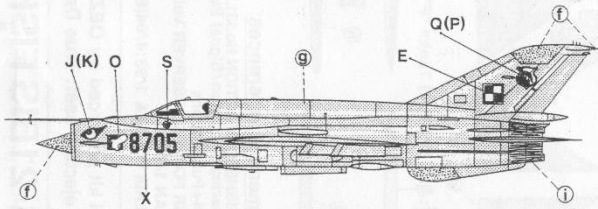
**4** MiG-21bis-SAU Fishbed N, Yugoslav Republic Air Force; Batajnica A.B., 1993.



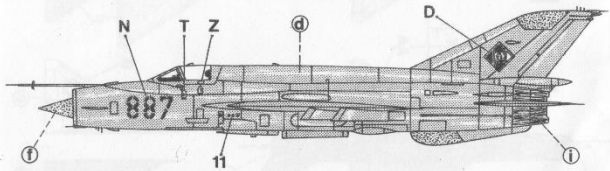
**2** MiG-21bis-SAU Fishbed N/the same aircraft as **1**/ Ukrainian Air Force, 1992.
