## 1/32nd UH-72 Medevac Interior

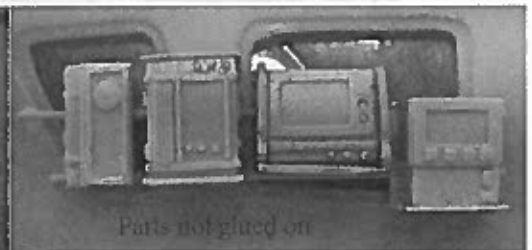
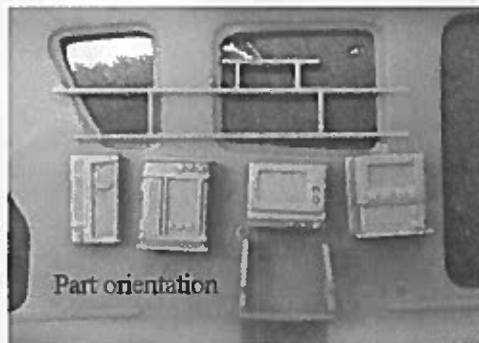
- Your Werner's Wings UH-72 Medevac Interior set provides the parts necessary to convert the Revell 1/32nd EC-145 into a US Army Medevac UH-72A.
- As always, read and understand the instructions BEFORE you start to cut plastic!
- CERTAIN PARTS ARE DELICATE! Please be careful with the slender

### Construction Notes:

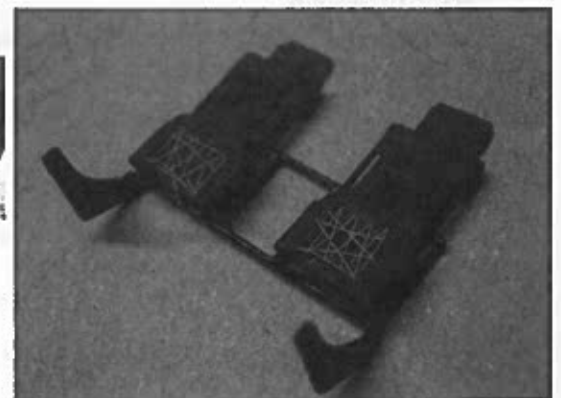
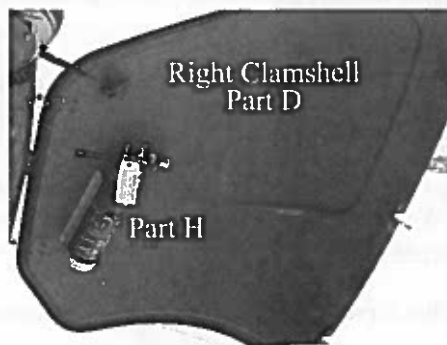
-Replace the kit rear clamshell doors with the resin ones (Part D & E). A resin bottle (Part H) goes on each door (see the photos for proper position).

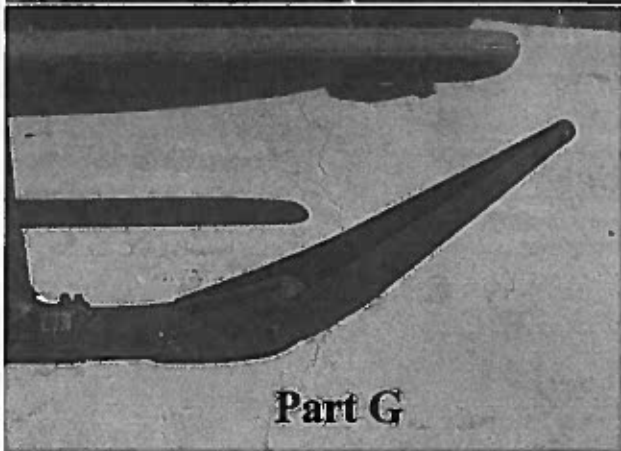
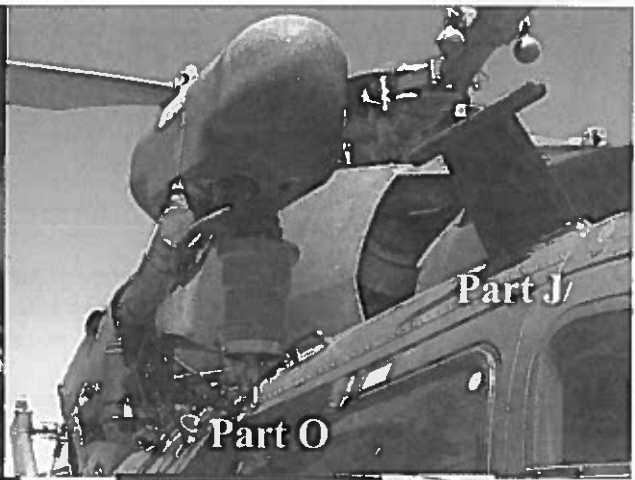
- The bracket (Part F) needs to be removed from the back piece and then simply added to the inside of the cabin as can be seen in the photos. Be careful once removed it will be fragile. The mounting bracket (Part N) is fit over the appropriate medical box prior to adding it to the bracket. The various medical equipment (Part A) is arranged on the support bracket as shown in the photos. Sorry but they are not in the proper position or orientation on the pour block.

- The stretchers are assembled by adding the four legs (Part L) to the bottom of stretcher (Part K). There are two of them and they are loaded on the floor on each side of the cabin. The supply bags (Part B & C) can be added anywhere but typically they are strapped down to the stretchers.



- The Wire Strike Protection System (Part G) are added to the front of each skid. They are oriented vertically as per the picture.
- The hoist is easily assembled by adding (Part O) to the kit hoist assembly.
- The antenna (Part J) is added to the roof as per the photo on the reverse.
- The folded up seats (Part I) are added to the seat bracket (Part M) as per the photo. We provide you with three seats. There can be either two or three seats mounted. Typically three.
