

Do-17Z

Designed to meet a request by Deutche Lufthansa for a small, high-speed mail and passenger plane, the prototype Do-17 took to the air in October 1934. Although possessing excellent speed and handling, the design proved impractical due to the cramped fuselage. After three prototypes were built, the transport development was abandoned. However, the aircraft's performance suggested to the RLM that the Do-17 design would make an excellent high-speed bomber. More prototypes were ordered, and the V4 was the first to be equipped with the type's characteristic twin tails. The first operational models, the Jumo powered E-1 bomber and F-1 reconnaissance versions equipped the first Do-17 Squadrons by mid-1937. A number of Do-17s were sent to Spain for evaluation, and proved to outpace most Republican interceptors, reinforcing the RLM's belief in the small bomber platform. Because the Do-17 design proved flexible and amenable to various powerplant installations, constant improvements were incorporated in subsequent versions, leading to the Bramo 323 powered Do-17Z. The Do-17Z played a major role in the Battle of Britain, but losses were heavy. Despite this, the type was used extensively in the Balkans and on the Russian front. A small number of Do-17Z aircraft were modified for use as nightfighters. Approximately 522 Z series aircraft were produced in 1939-40.
