

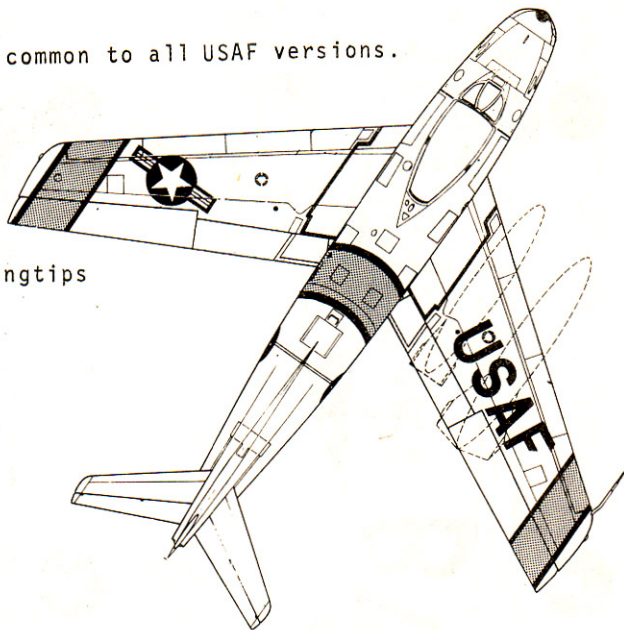
MICRO SCALE SHEET #72-100 F-86 SABRES, Korean War

Recommended Kit: Hasegawa/Minicraft F-86F Sabre

Note: Kit producer model of Japanese F-86F-40. Korean vintage Sabres had a shorter wing span. For correct span, wingtip should be removed to outside edge of aileron and a new tip formed. (Korean Sabres had a wingspan of 37'1".)

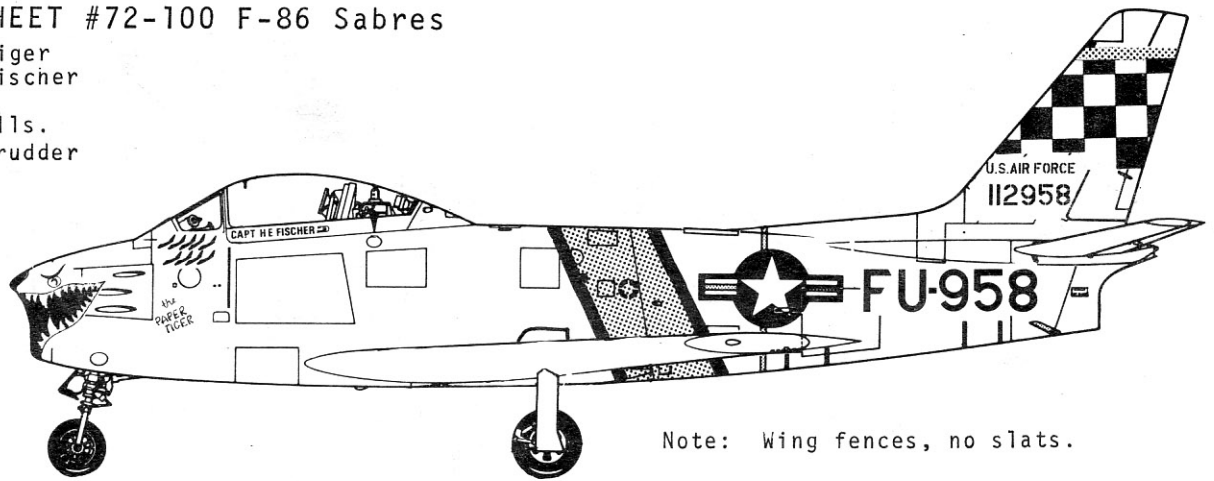
Markings common to all USAF versions.

yellow bands FS 13432
bordered in black
around fuselage and wingtips



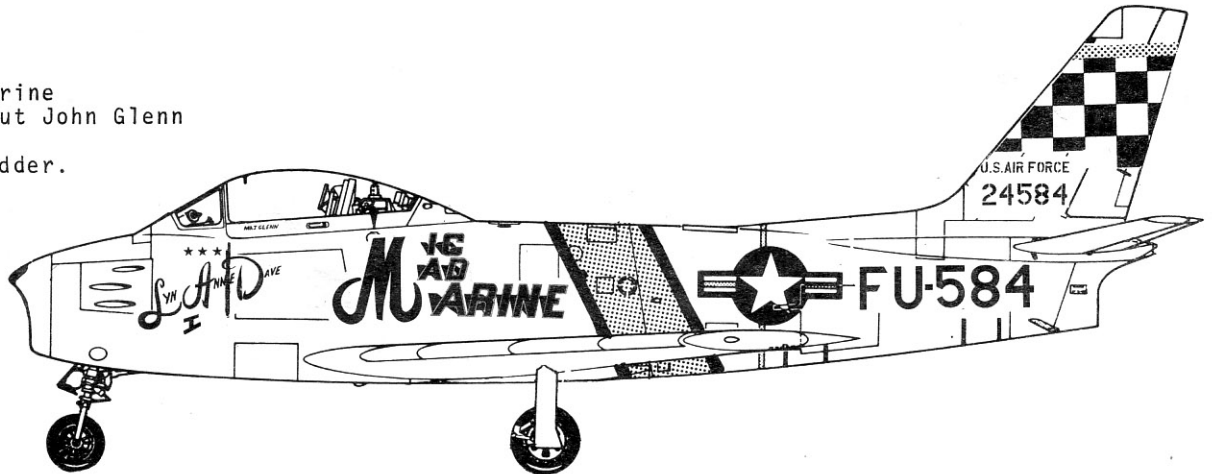

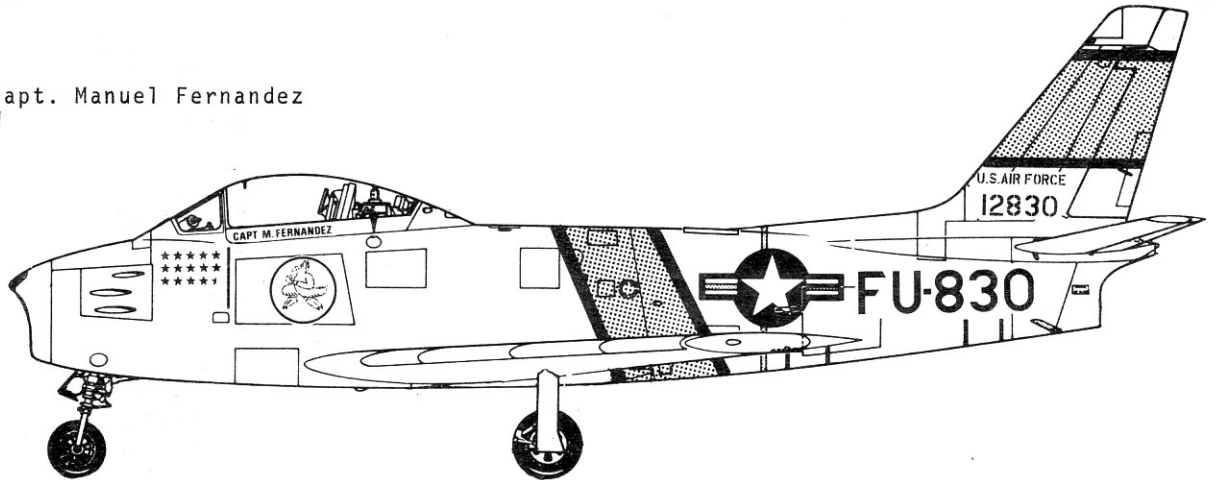

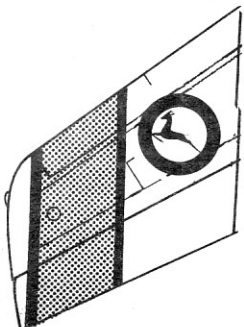
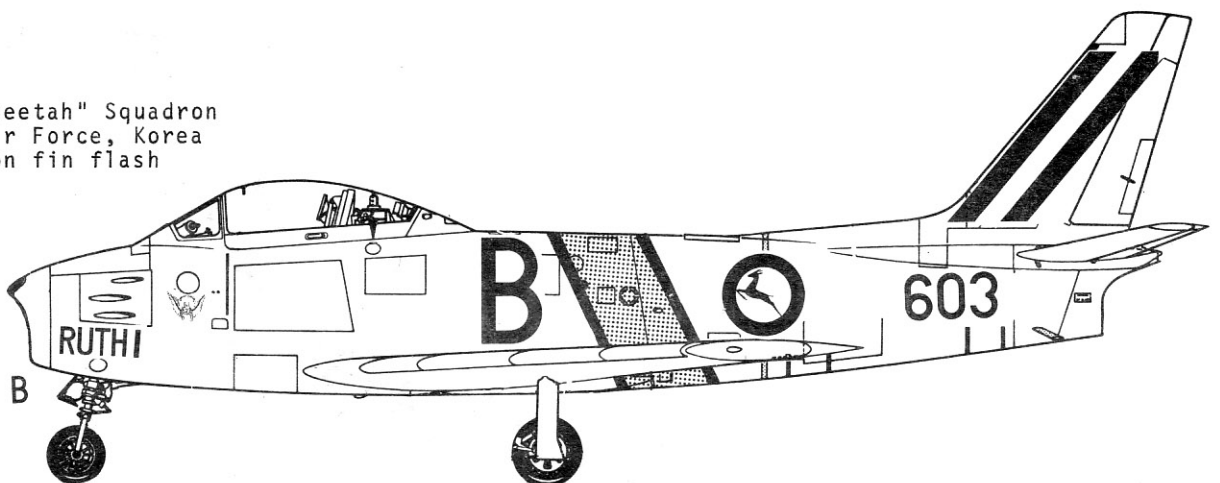
F-86E Mig Mad Marine

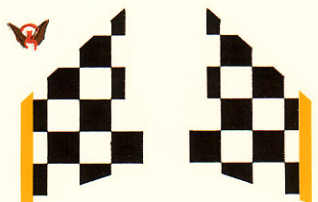
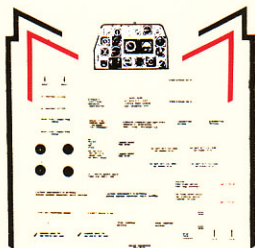
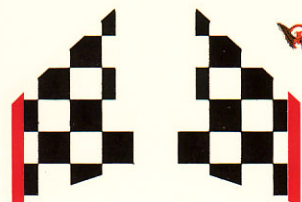
