These bulged cablin windows are intended as an addition to AS-2011 [212/412 and long-bodied UH-1 kts. Warry operators fit them to aid downward vision from the rear cablin - especially good in SAF role.

Attach with PVA - do not use cyanoscrylate adhesive.



The above photo shows a bulged cabin window on a German Army UH-1D at the R.Neth.AF Show at Twenthe in 2003. The installation is typical - either the front or rear cabin door window can be replaced with a bulged version. This aircraft was unusual in that the starboard cabin door had a bulged window (illustrated), but the port door did not. Apparently, someone had broken it shortly before the aircraft left for the show...
