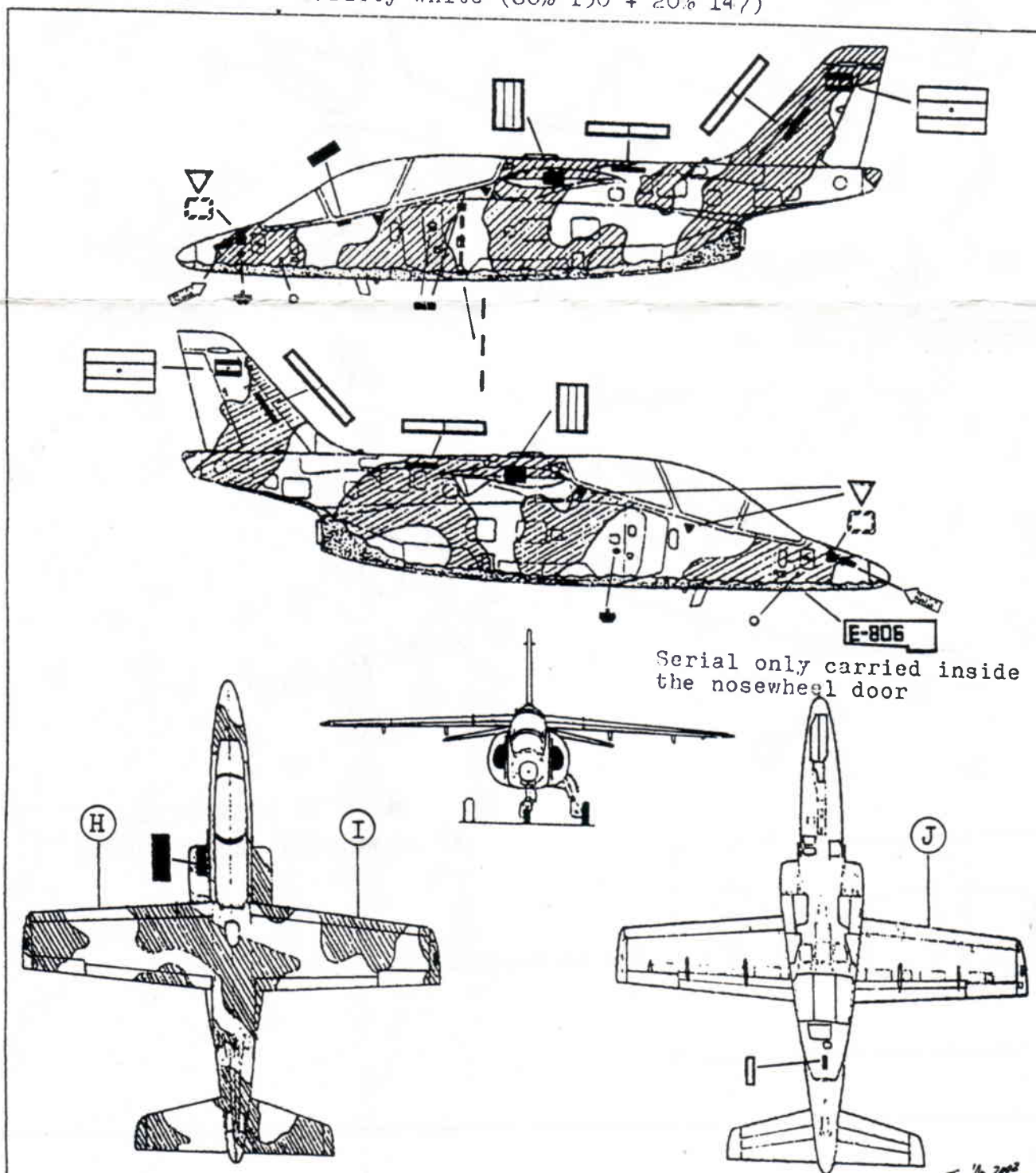
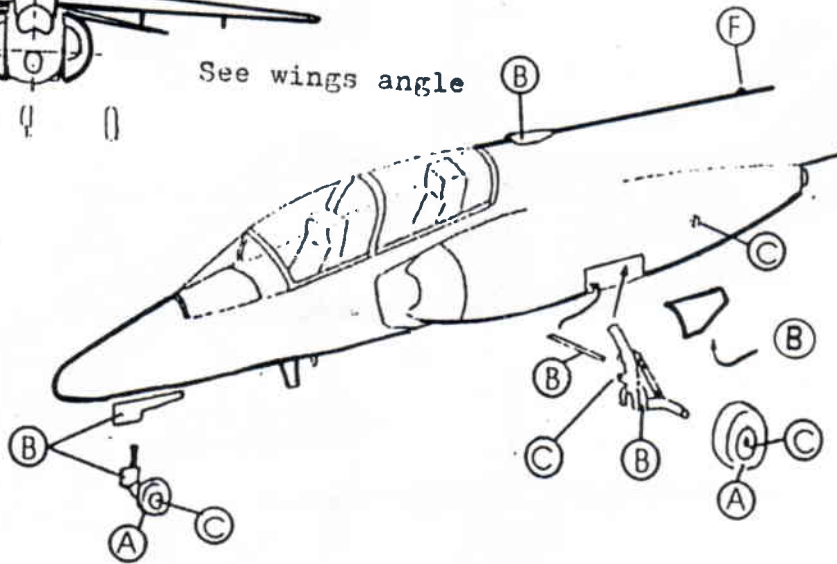
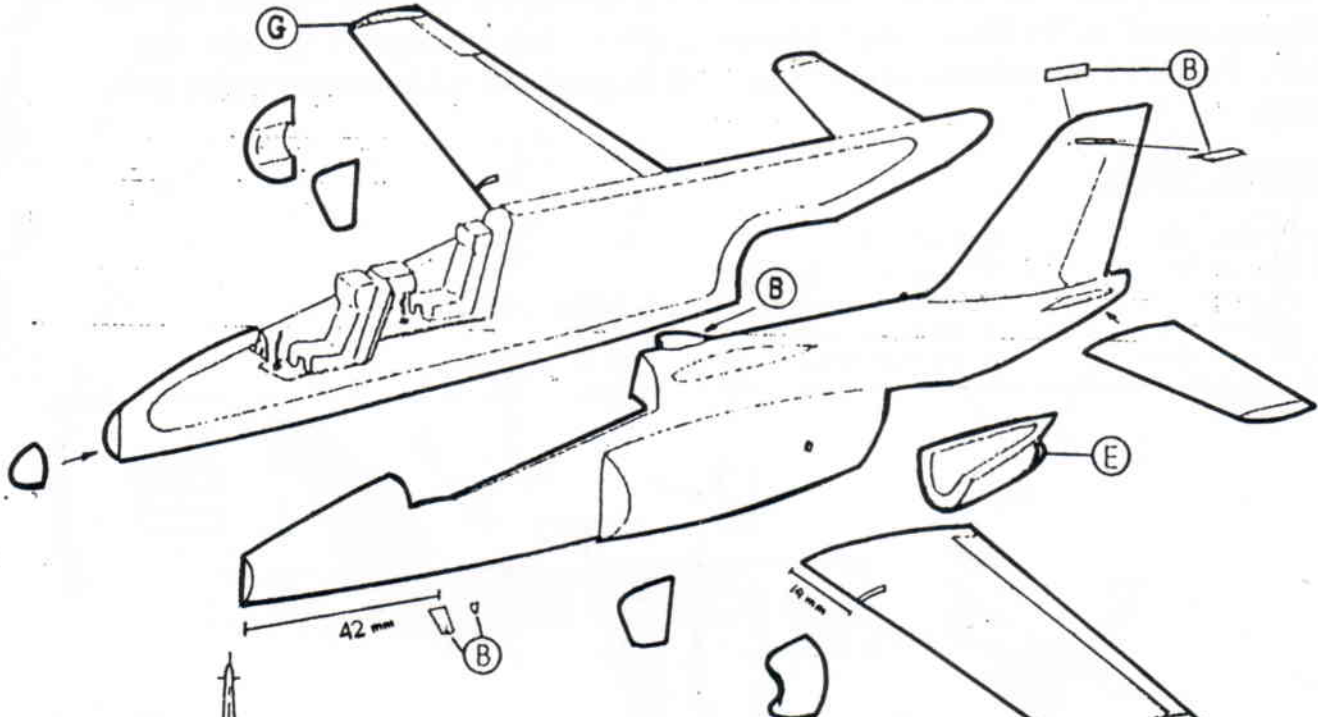
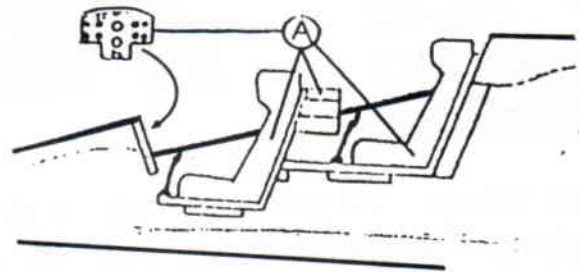
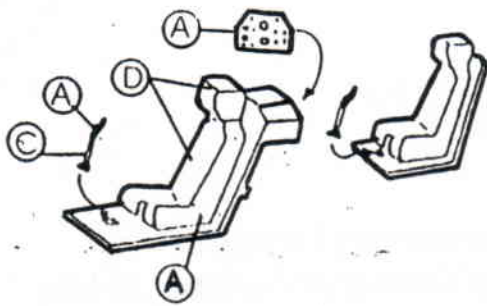


IA-63 "Pampa" is a twin seat single jet, developed by The Military Factory of Airplanes of Argentina (FMAA) with the collaboration of Dornier of Germany, to be used as advanced trainer and tactical support airplane. The first flight was done on October 6th 1984. The first airplanes entered in service on May 9th 1988 in the "IV Brigada aerea" in "El Plumerillo", Mendoza, where they will replace the MS-760 Paris. To the 17 manufactured airplanes, will be gradually added other twelve until 2005.

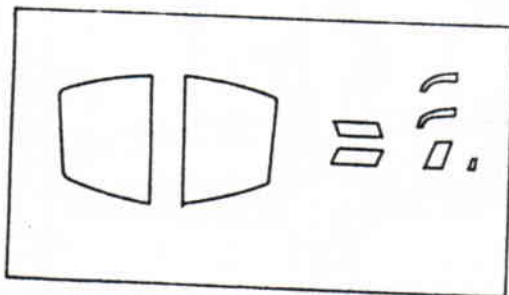
