1/350 SCALE SET 3525

Do not remove the parts from tree until you are ready to add them to the model. Before assembly, soak brass items in solvent or warm soapy water to de-grease the surface for later painting. Brass parts may be assembled and added to model using cyanoacrylate glues (super glue). When removing parts from tree, place on a hard flat surface underneath the brass when cutting tabs, this will prevent bending of parts. When shaping or bending a part, a straight edged blade such as an x-acto chisel type blade (#17 or 18) will give a good square corner. It will also help to make some bending dies out of plastic strip or other materials. Should you bend a part incorrectly, lay the part on a hard flat surface and roll flat again.

Additional detailing note Most aircraft had two nose wheels, the kit aircraft only provides one. The modeler may wish to purchase additional aircraft sets to obtain the second wheel.
