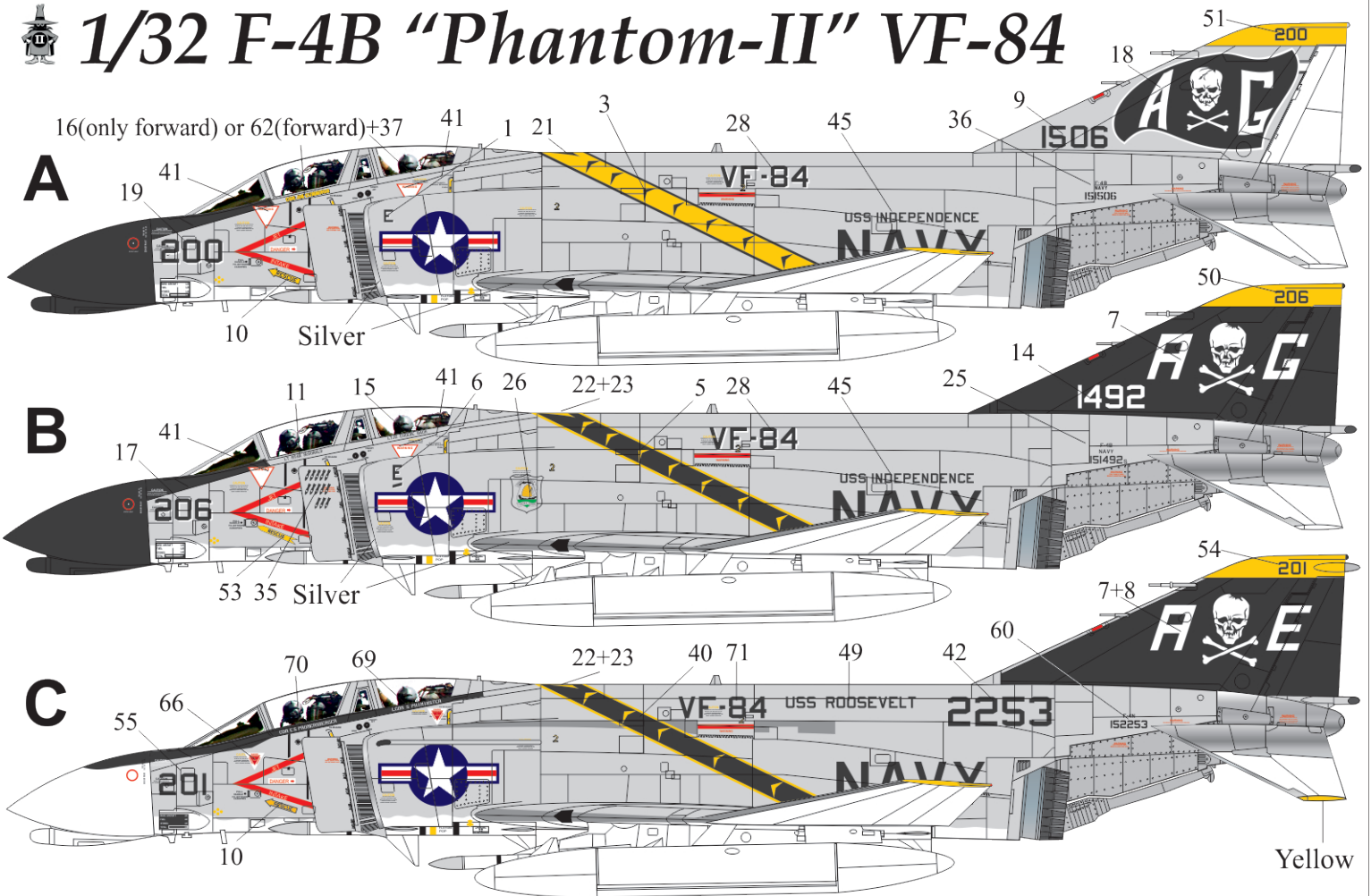




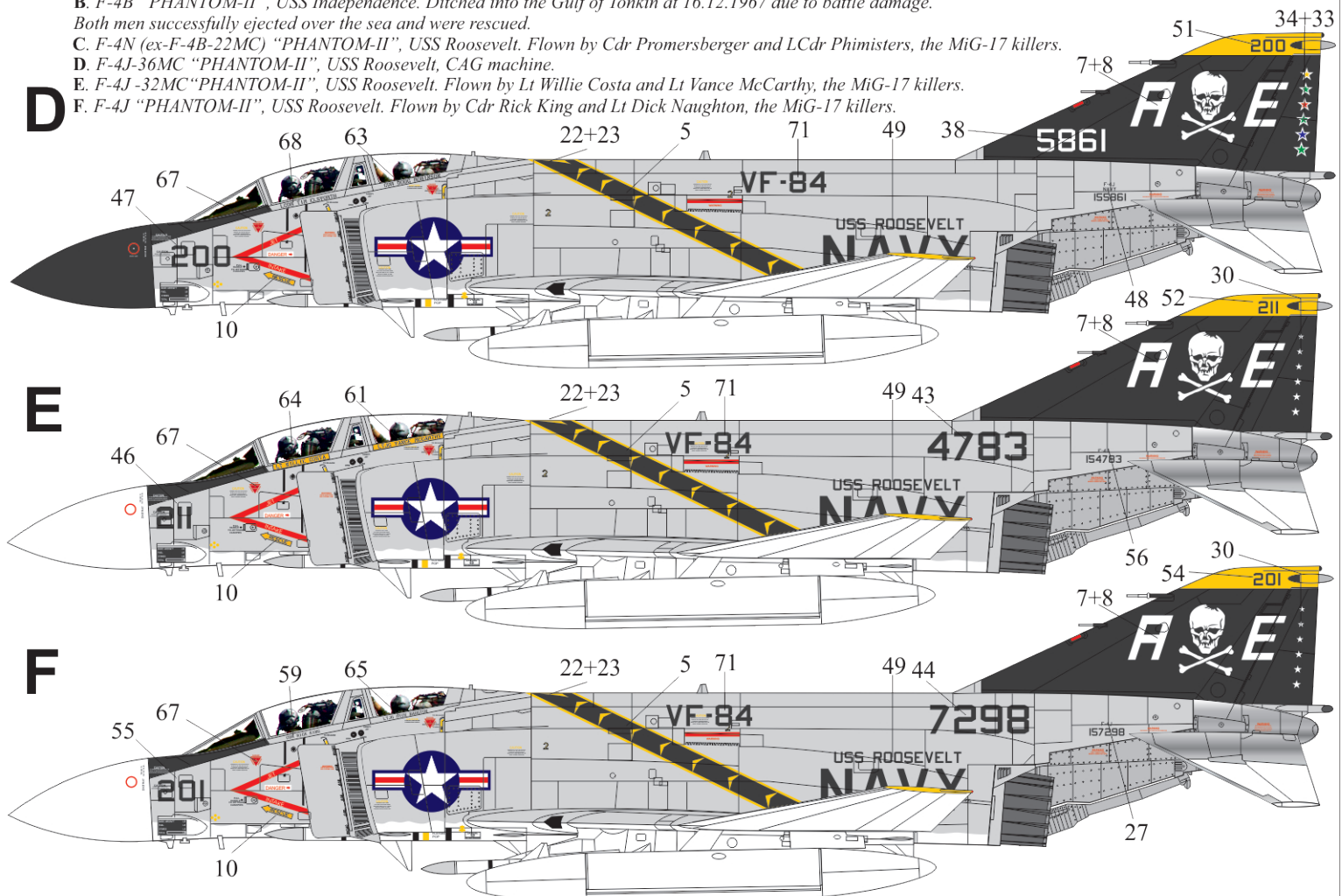

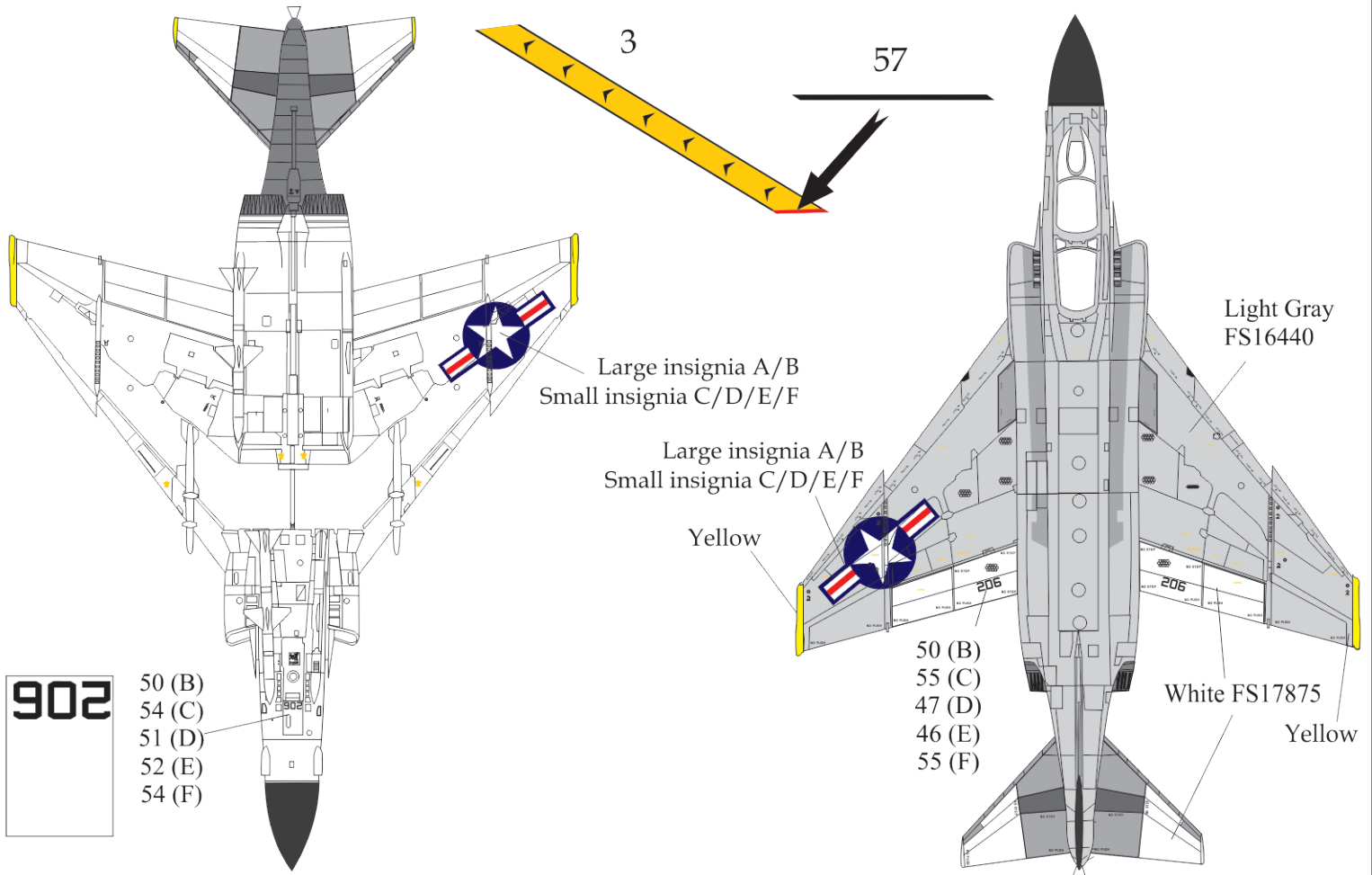

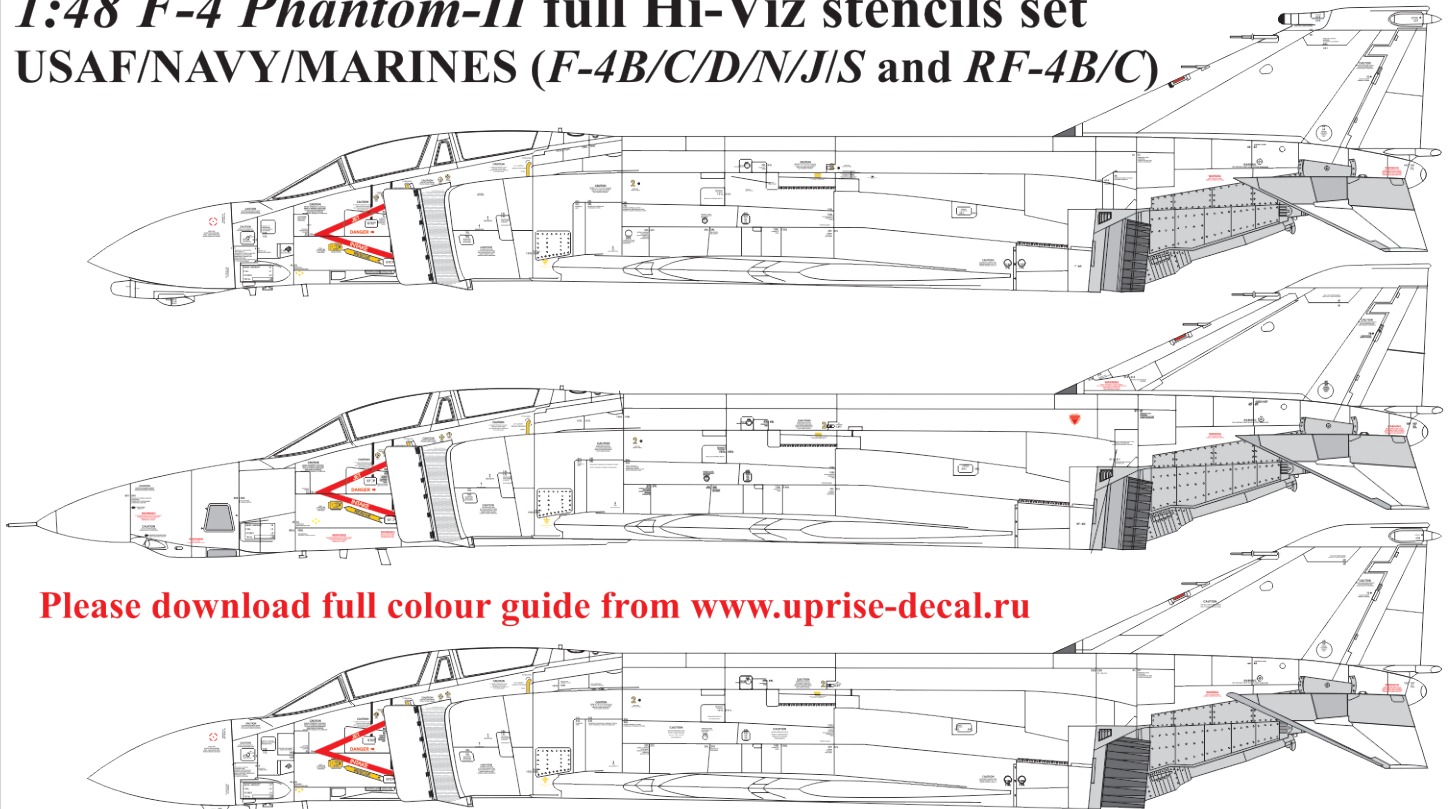
- A. F-4B-20MC "PHANTOM-II", USS Independence. The a/c was lost in Vietnam 1968 in midair collision.
- B. F-4B "PHANTOM-II", USS Independence. Ditched into the Gulf of Tonkin at 16.12.1967 due to battle damage. Both men successfully ejected over the sea and were rescued.
- C. F-4N (ex-F-4B-22MC) "PHANTOM-II", USS Roosevelt. Flown by Cdr Promersberger and LCdr Phimisters, the MiG-17 killers.
- D. F-4J-36MC "PHANTOM-II", USS Roosevelt, CAG machine.
- E. F-4J-32MC "PHANTOM-II", USS Roosevelt. Flown by Lt Willie Costa and Lt Vance McCarthy, the MiG-17 killers.
- F. F-4J "PHANTOM-II", USS Roosevelt. Flown by Cdr Rick King and Lt Dick Naughton, the MiG-17 killers.

The decal set is created by accordance with official military USA docs. and contain three types of the stencils: instructional, service and ADM (access door marking) All the stencils are typically for early and middle period of Phantom-II deployment. It were present on new Phantom-II when it arrived from plant or after service/repaint works. But they gradually disappeared during the service and at last period of deployment the stencils were presented partially. Please use your reference photos.
