



KC-135A, 61-0300, 22 ARW, March AFB, CA, 1988. 15th Air Force Commander's aircraft. Overall F.S. 16473 with white engine center cowling areas and pylons. Note white outlined black mask around cockpit. Use black pieces provided aft of cockpit windows, then apply white stripes as shown. Use wide SAC Milky Way bands. Vertical fin tip black.





KC-135A, 62-3509, "Spirit of the Seacoast", 509 BMW, Pease AFB, NH, 1988. Overall F.S. 16473 with black vertical fin tip. Use narrow SAC Milky Way bands.








Standard SAC shield placement on left side of aircraft A through D (aircraft A shown).
