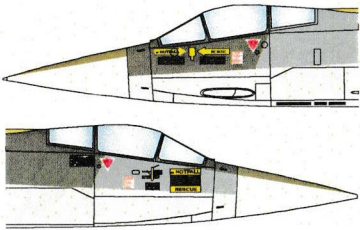
# Guide to warning and rescue symbols

Application of warning and rescue symbols is variable according to air force and/or camouflage pattern. Always check your reference when building your model. Following pictures are examples only.

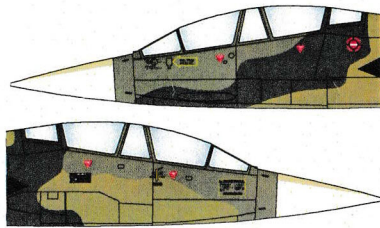
Example 1 - Factory applied symbols  
(typical for early Starfighters of European air forces)



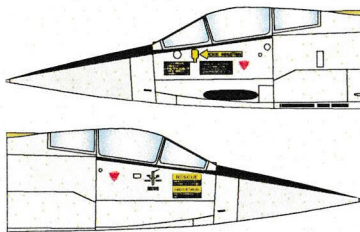
Example 2 - F-104G of German Air Force in Norm 62 camouflage



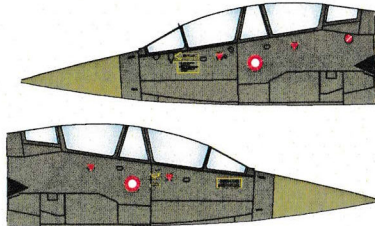
Example 3 - TF-104G of German Air Force in Norm 83 camouflage



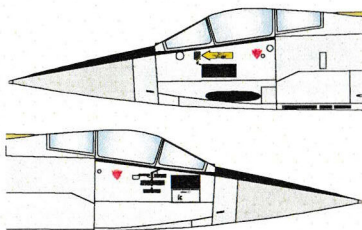

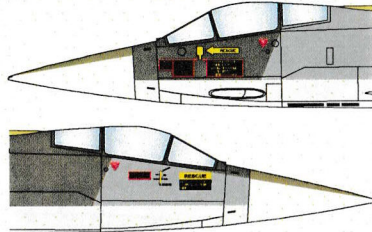

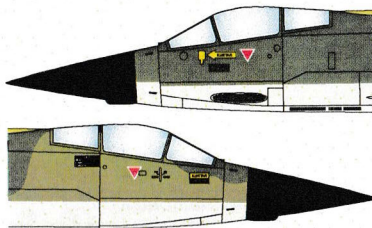

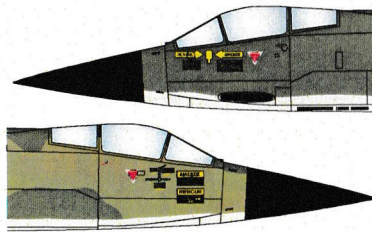
