


Trans World Airlines ordered the Boeing 747 on September 2, 1966. Eventually TWA took delivery of 19 aircraft between New Year's Eve 1969, and October 27, 1971.

Registration numbers ran in sequence from N93101 to N93119. Sadly, after 30 years of service TWA withdrew the venerable 747 from service in 1999.

Paint the model according to the instructions on the back of this sheet. Place decals as designated by the numbers. Most pieces are self explanatory as to their location.

Corrogard inspar panels are found only on the top of the wings. The entire bottom of the wings should be Boeing 707 Gray. Note that the details for the engines are handed and should be applied to all engines, per side, as directed.
