Fleet numbers go on nose wheel doors. Use black with black titles and blue with blue titles. The numbering did not follow a set pattern. In fact, there were so many variations that we possibly couldn't list them all here. There were a few trends, however, and we will list them here. But, to be 100% certain, locate a JP Fleets from 1972 to 1974 and look it up.

Usually if the registration numbers starts with:

- 90xx then it stays 90xx or becomes 95xx
- 97xx becomes 91xx
- 99xx becomes 92xx

Again these are general guidelines and there were exceptions.

One of the first operators of the baby Boeing, United eventually went on operate several hundred of what has become the best-selling jetliner of all time. Perhaps the best-looking livery to ever adorn the United 737s, the "Stars & Bars" scheme is certainly a classic. This decal depicts the latter wide red stripe with the option of blue or black titles and registration numbers. The choice is yours. Use the info on the side here to pick your favorite city name and match it to the correct registration number. With 72 city names provided, one is sure to interest you.

Paint the fuselage overall gloss white. Use a copy of the decal to help mask the belly for the bare-metal areas. Notice the odd shape of the Boeing 707 Gray area behind the wing-root fairing and how it sweeps up to the tail area. Paint the wings and stabilizers in the normal pattern of Boeing 707 Gray and bare-metal leading edges.
