The Mosquito FB VI was the natural evolution of the early bomber version adapted with an additional fighter capability. Given the popularity of the subject, kits are available in four scales; 1/72nd, 1/48th, 1/32 and 1/24th.

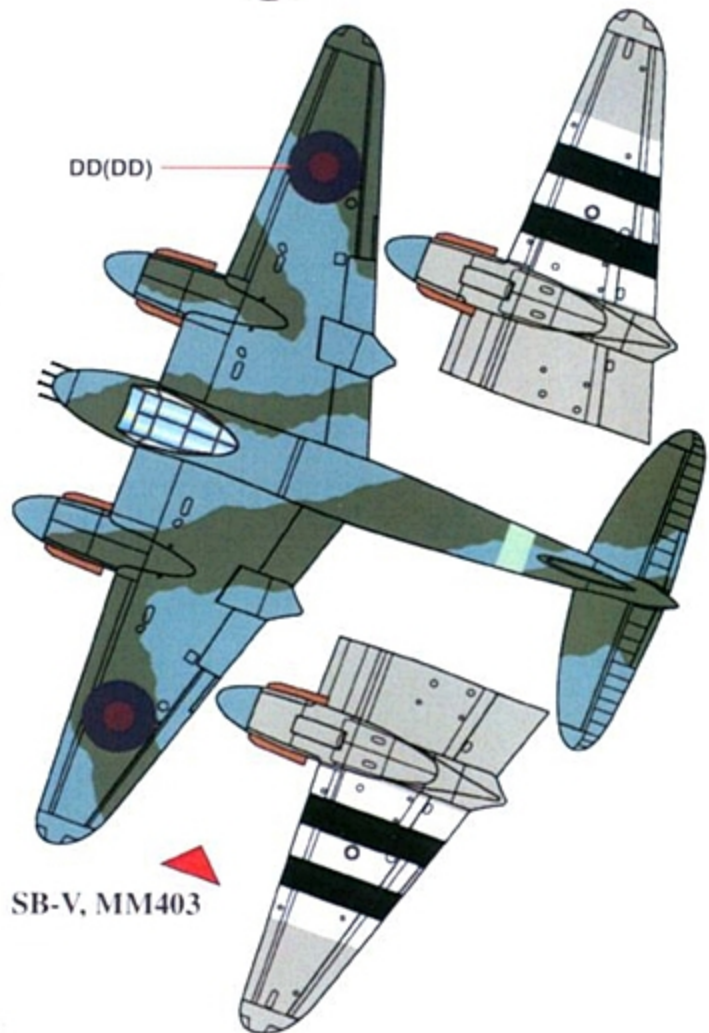
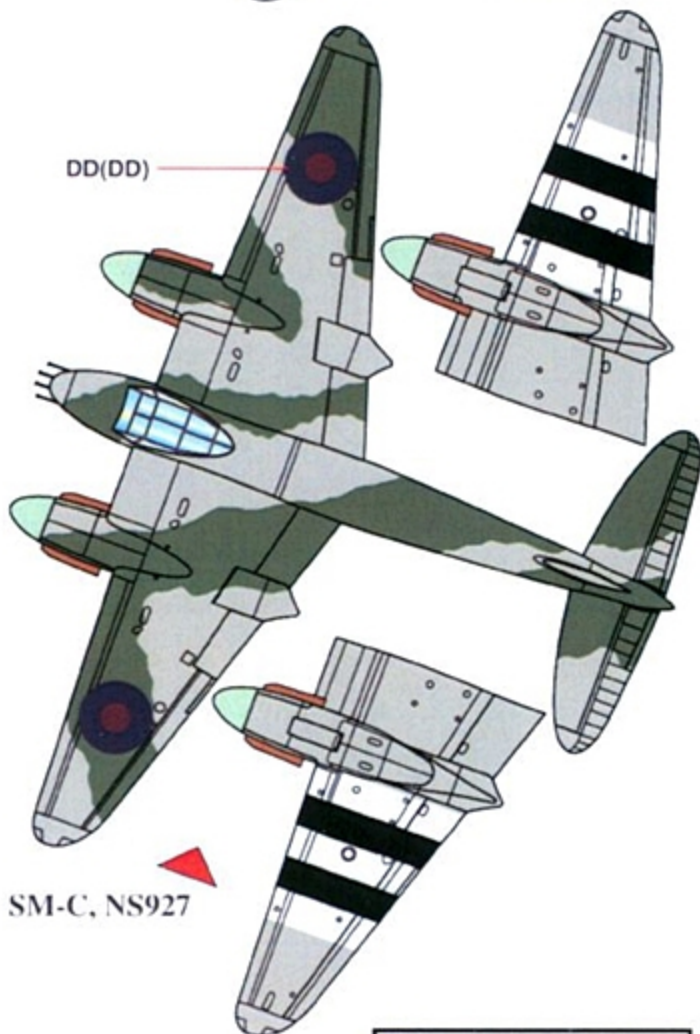
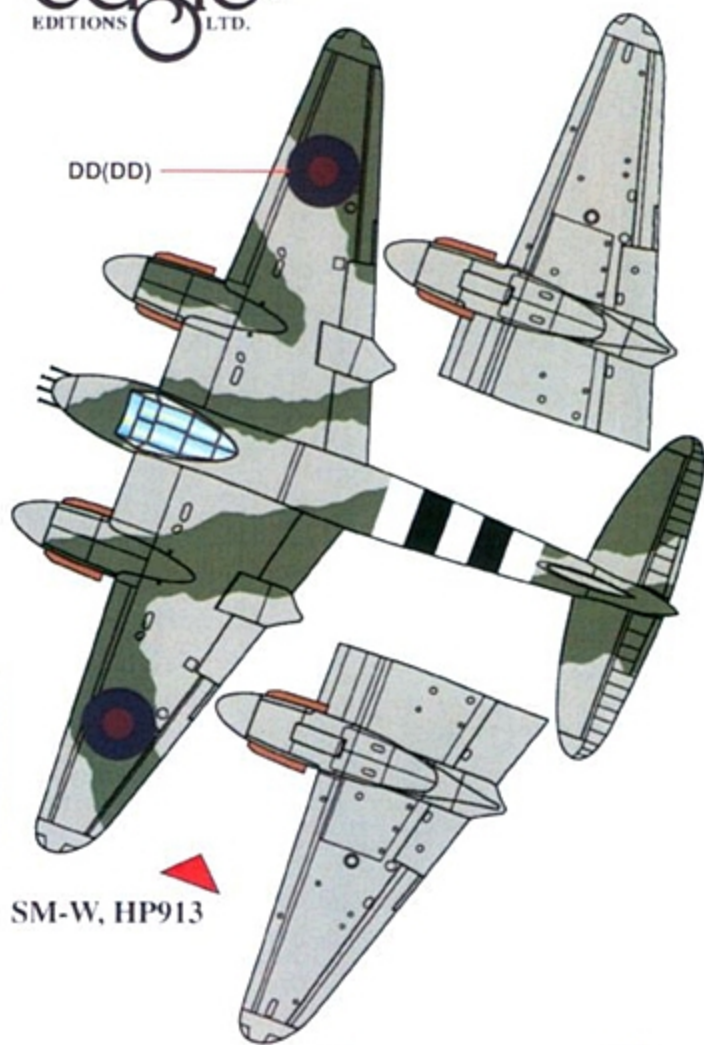
wing trailing-edge camouflage demarcation, MM403





UX-P, HR551 Stripe Widths:

1:72 Wing	= 9.9 mm
1:72 Stabilizer	= 6.4 mm
1:48 Wing	= 14.8 mm
1:48 Stabilizer	= 9.5 mm
1:32 Wing	= 22.2 mm
1:32 Stabilizer	= 14.3 mm
