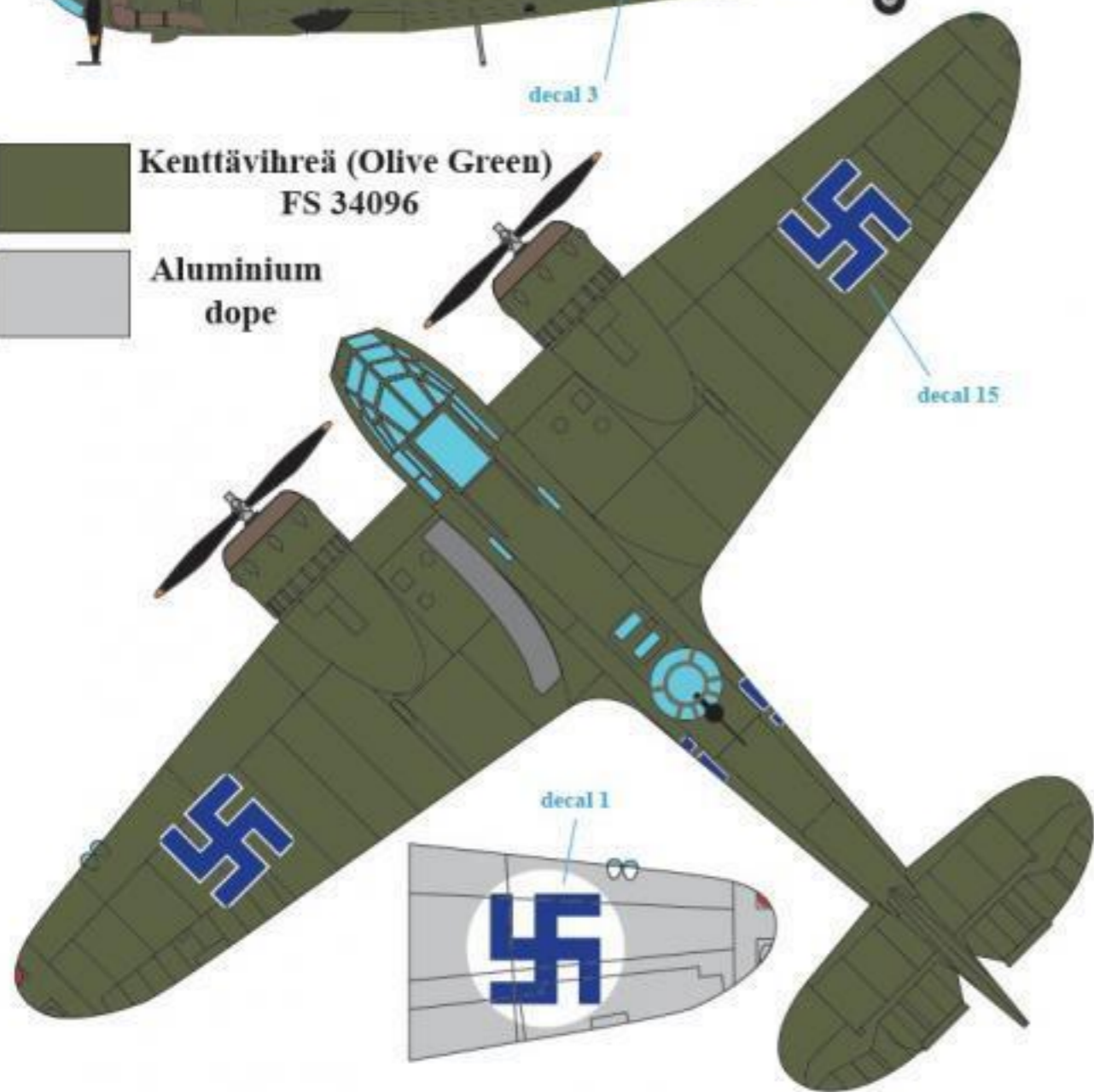

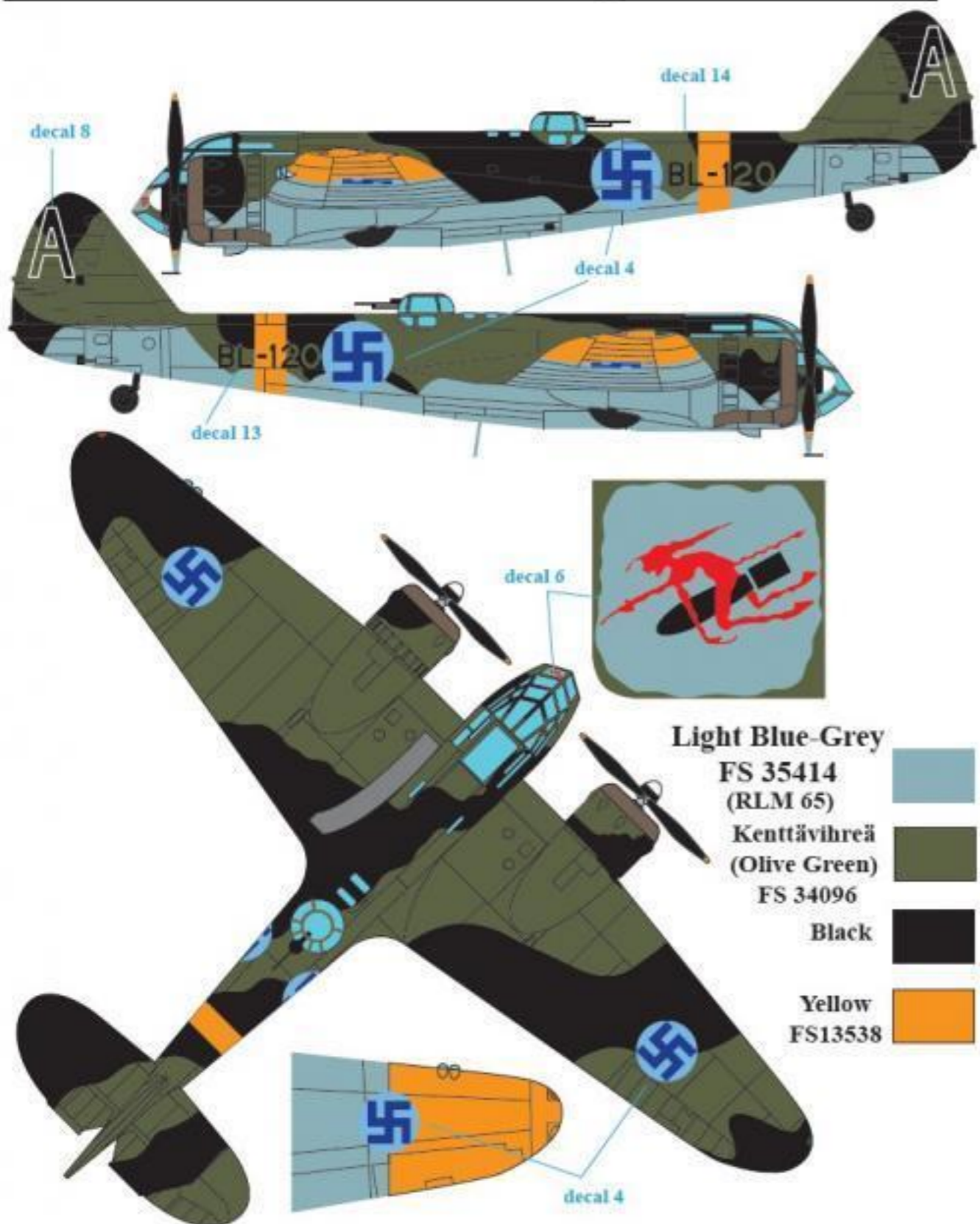


BL-143 of LLv 42 based at Siikakangas in summer 1940. Standard British bomber camouflage of Dark Green and Dark Earth top and Black underside.

108 Sqn badge retained on the fin.

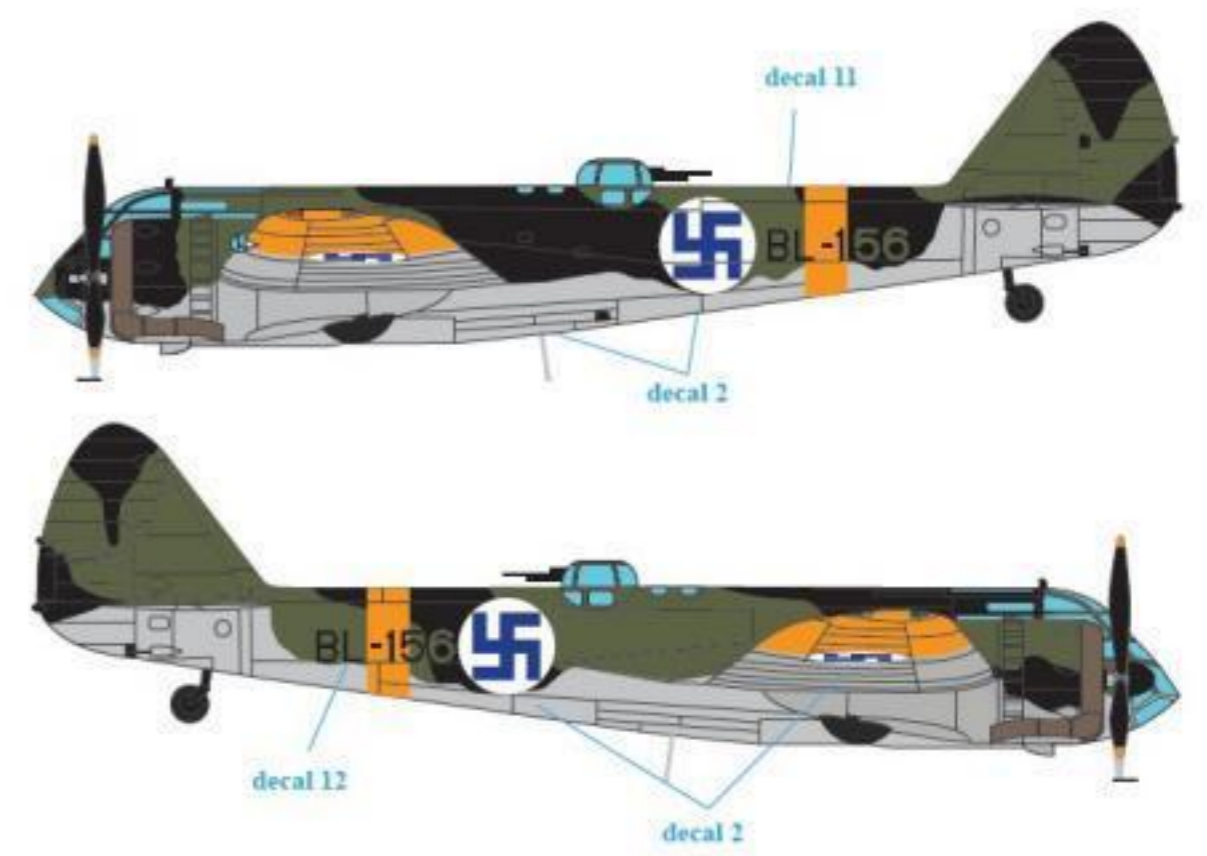
