









Fokker D.XXI, FR-104 of 3/LLv 24, Immola, December 1939.



Brewster Model 239, BW-393 of 1/LeLv 24, Suulajärvi, November 1942. Standard Finnish Warpaint of Olive Green and Black with aluminium dope bottom. Tactical marking White 7 on Blue rudder. Luukkanen scored 7 victories in this plane.

Tactical marking Yellow 5 on fin. Out of his 54 aerial victories Major and squadron commander Eino Luukkanen scored 17 in this plane.
