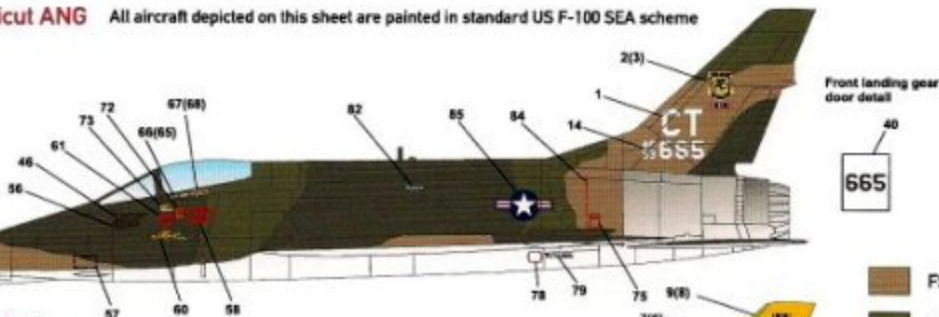

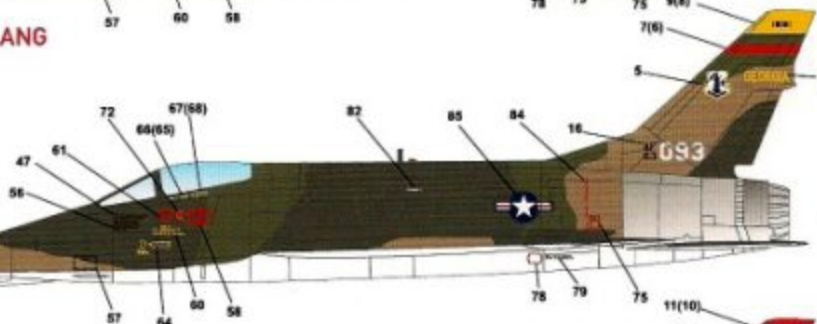
Front landing gear door detail

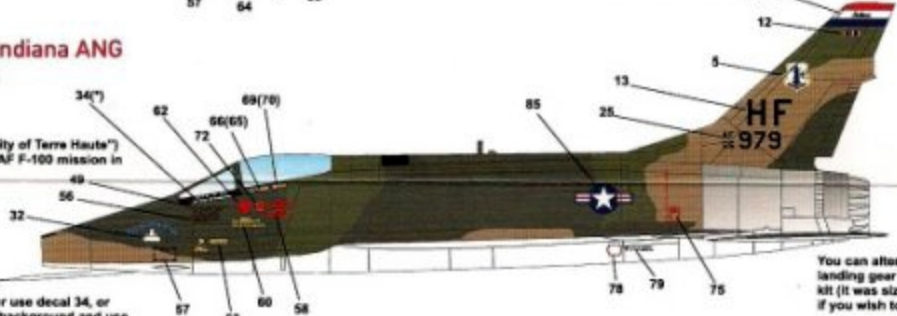
Option 2: Georgia ANG

This aircraft ("City of Terre Haute") flew the last USAF F-100 mission in 1975.

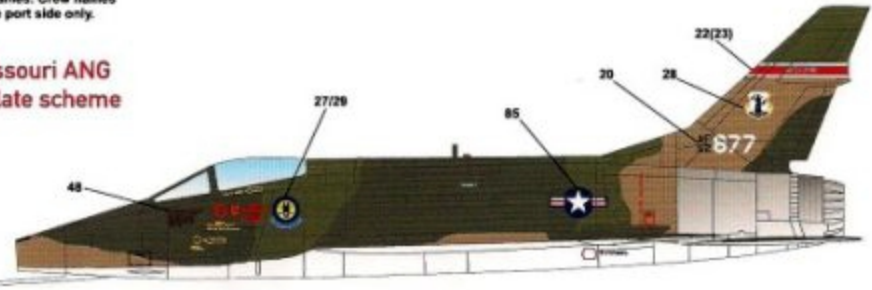

You can alternatively use decal 36 if the landing gear door decal does not fit your kit (it was sized for Trumpeter kits) or if you wish to paint the red portion yourself.

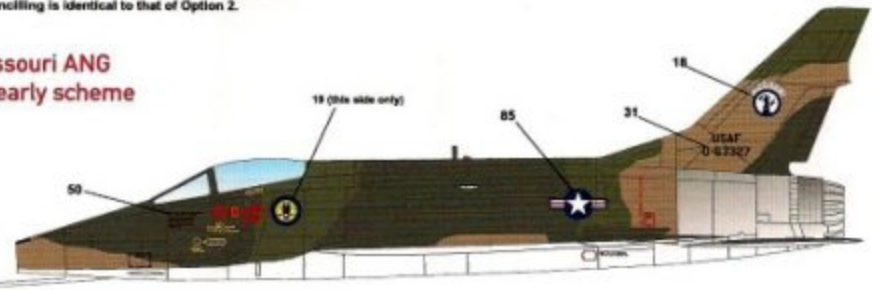
Option 4: Missouri ANG

Use the ANG bicentennial badge (29) on the other side of the aircraft. All maintenance stenciling is identical to that of Option 2.

Option 5: Missouri ANG
110th TFS - early scheme

The 110th TFS badge was applied on the port side of the aircraft only (as shown). Do not apply the badge on the other side. All maintenance stenciling is identical to that of Option 2.
