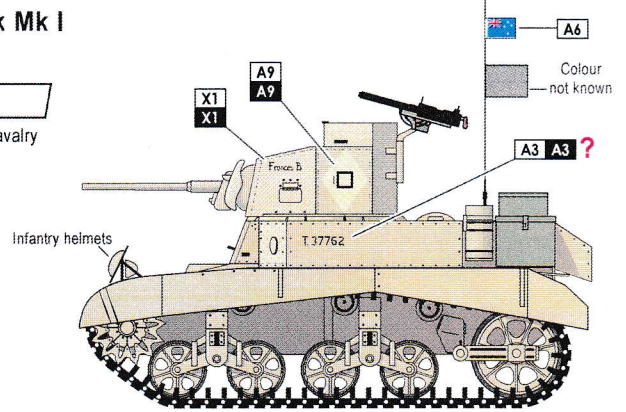

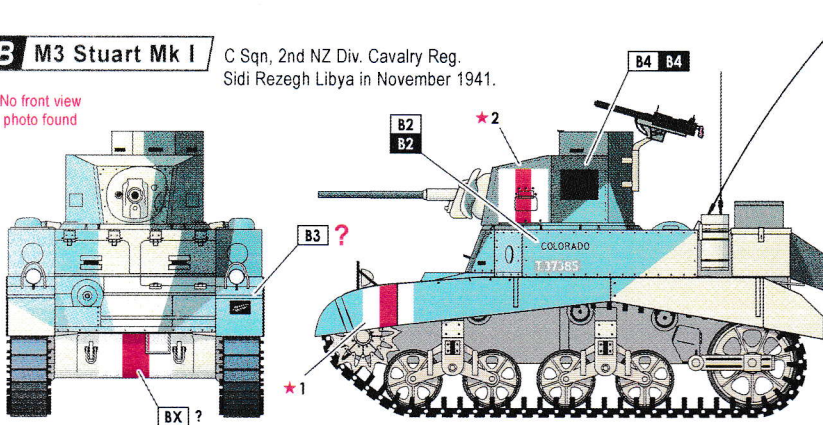

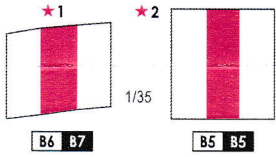

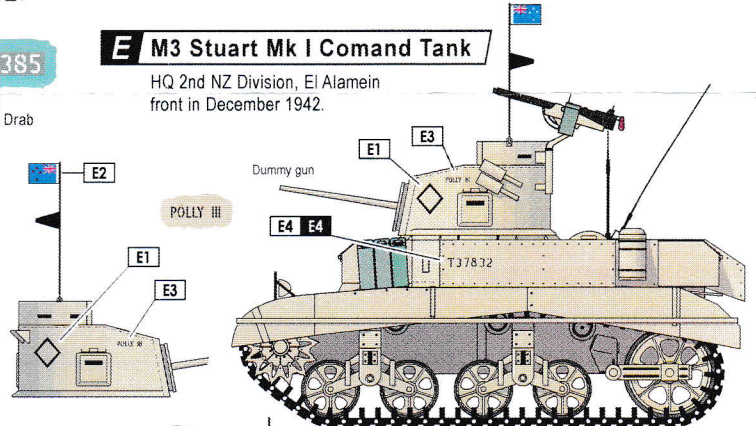

E M3 Stuart Mk I Comand Tank

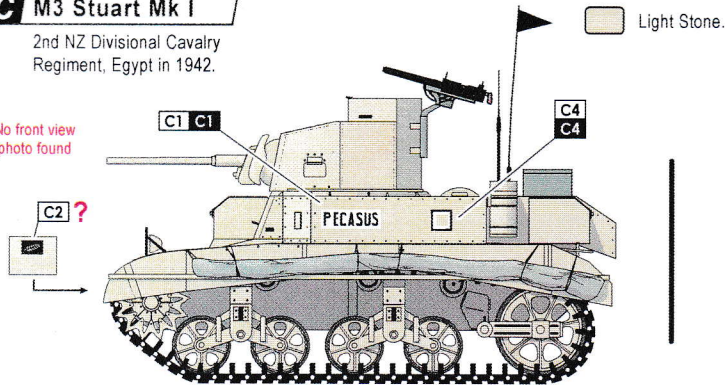

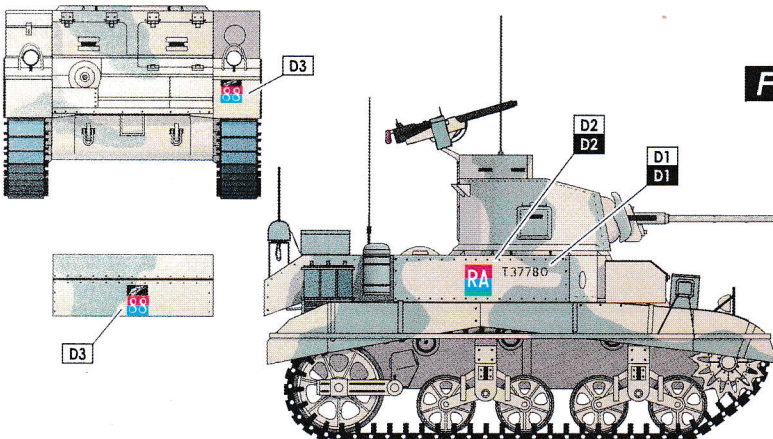

NZ, 25 Battery, 4th Field Regiment, near Medenine Libya in March 1943.

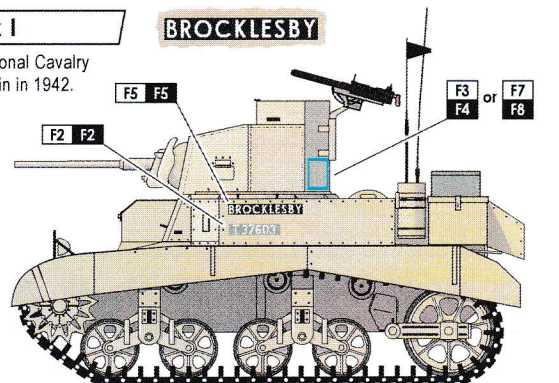

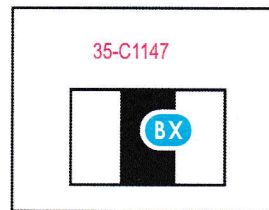
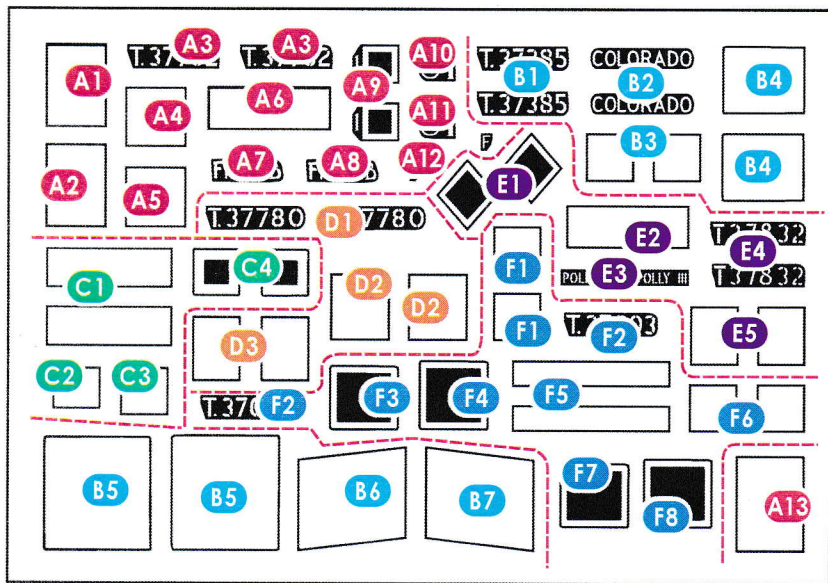


F M3 Stuart Mk I
