The F-5A Freedom Fighter is a lightweight and low-cost sophisticated aircraft intended for air-to-ground operations. It was originally designed in the 1950s as a potential jet fighter to operate from the US Navy's Escort Carriers but eventually served the U.S. Cold War allies after the Navy's withdrawal of the Carrier.

The Freedom Fighter first flew in 1959 and entered service in the 1960s. Standard armament includes 2 M39 20mm cannons with additional pods or missiles of up to 6200lbs on 5 hardpoints and 2 wingtips. While the F-5A was an aircraft with basic equipment, it has reached across the world to countries including Iran, South Korea, the Philippines, Turkey, Greece and Taiwan through the U.S. Military Assistance Program (MAP) as an ideal solution for an inexpensive, easily maintained but Mach 1.4-capable combat fighter.

Among the F-5A's foreign operators, Canada has made direct purchases and received license to produce the aircraft locally. The Canadair F-5A, designateed CF-5A (officially CF-116), has an in-flight refueling probe and was powered by Orenda J85-CAN0-15 series engines. The CF-5A was also sold to the Royal Netherlands Air Forceand was designated as NF-5A.

レーダーを持たず目視のみで戦闘を行う限定されたものであったにも関わらず、優れた空対空戦闘能力を有し、対地攻撃機能も兼ね備えた F-5 A フリーダムファイターは、低コストで運用可能な小型軽量の高性能戦闘機でした。 当初、アメリカ海軍。悪衛空母での運用の可能性も、踏まえたジェット戦闘機として1950年代に設計されましたが、全ての護衛空母が退役した結果、軍事援助計画(MAP)を通じて、冷戦時下のアメリカを中心とする西側同盟諸国 の防衛に貢献しました。1959年初飛行に成功し1960年代より導入が進められたフリーダムファイターは、両翼端および胴体・両翼下面の5つのパイロンに、ミサイルや爆弾など6,200ポンド(2,812キロ)にも及ぶ追加兵装が 搭載可能で、機首には M-3 9 2 0mm機関砲 2門が固定武装として装備されていました。また最高速マッハ1.4を発揮する格闘戦闘機でありながら、安価で機体維持が容易である理想的な機体で、導入当時F-5 Aが戦闘機に要求 される 基本装織を十分に有する機材であったことから、アメリカの軍事援助計画によりイラン、韓国、フィリピン、トルコ、ギリシャ、および台湾 など各国空軍に広く採用・配備されたのですそして空軍 戦闘機として導入した国のうち、 カナダではF-5 Aの機体を直接購入したのに加え、国内でのライセンス生産も行われ、その機体はC F-5 A(カナダ空軍正式型式名:C F-116)と呼称されました。オレンダ J 8 5-C A N 0-15 ターボジェットエンジンに、 空中給油プローブを装備するカナダ製の機体は、その後NF-5Aの型式名でオランダ空軍にも採用されました。ベトナム戦争の最中、同型諸国にF-5Aの概觀実積を示す必要があったことから、アメリカ空軍は空中給油プローブに、 対空火器から機体を守る防弾装甲を追加装備させた特別仕様機で評価試験部隊を領成し実戦投入しました。その機体が投入された作戦は、スコシタイガーと命名され、地上近接支援で活躍したと伝えられています。 尚、作戦名の中の"スコシ"とは日本語の「少し」に由来します。

3. 63-8381, USAF. The delivery to Greece was not made until 1988; it was flown by Kelly AFB for the period.
















