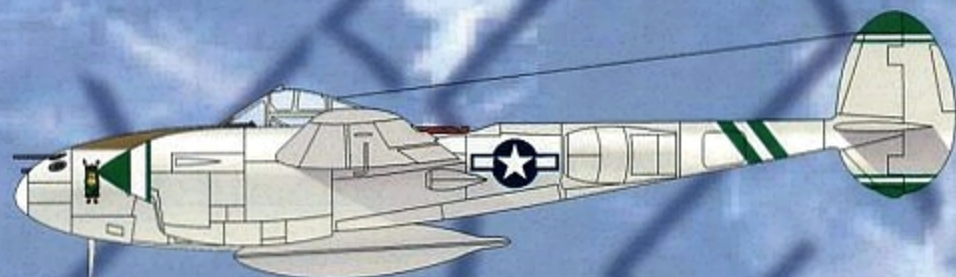
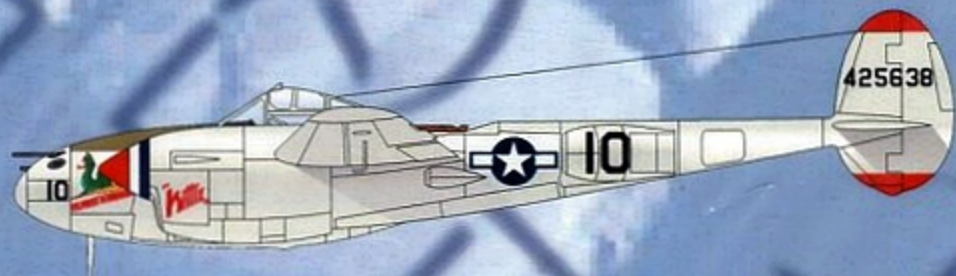
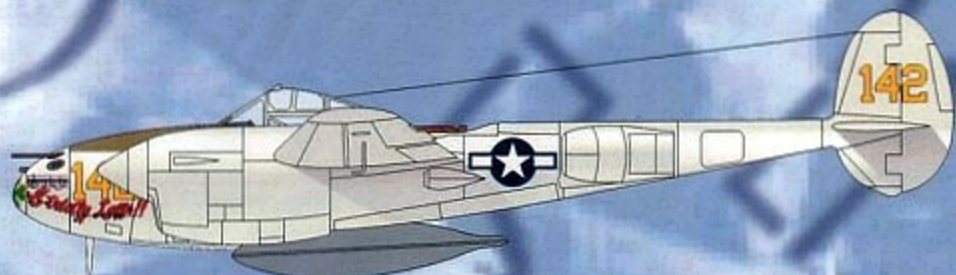

Suggested Kit: Hasegawa/ Academy P-38 Family



P-38J, 432nd FS., 475th FG., Hollandia, New Guinea, 1944. "Strictly Laffs" was decorated with a Yellow/Green clover on the nose tip. Black or Dark Olive Drab Antiglare Panels. Neutral Gray Drop Tanks on this A/C. Reason for A/G panel shape is unknown.

P-38L-5-LO, 9th FS., 49th F.G., Lyngayen, Philippines, 1945. Red spinner tip and fin/rudder tips decorate this A/C, flown by Maj Clayton Issacson. He had 4 German victories while flying in Europe. Notice the Red/White/Blue spinner. Modellers must paint the Red tip, then apply decal 7. The name *Kittie* may have been on both sides.

P-38J, "Jandina IV", 80th FS, 8th FG, S.W. Pacific, 1944. Flown by Maj. J. T. Robbins. Overall natural metal. O.D. anti-glare panels on nose & inboard side of engine nacelles. Spinners Green with White bands. Tip of nose White. Upper & lower tips of tails Green with thin White stripes. Add White spinner bands after painting spinner Green, and before assembling prop/spinner.
