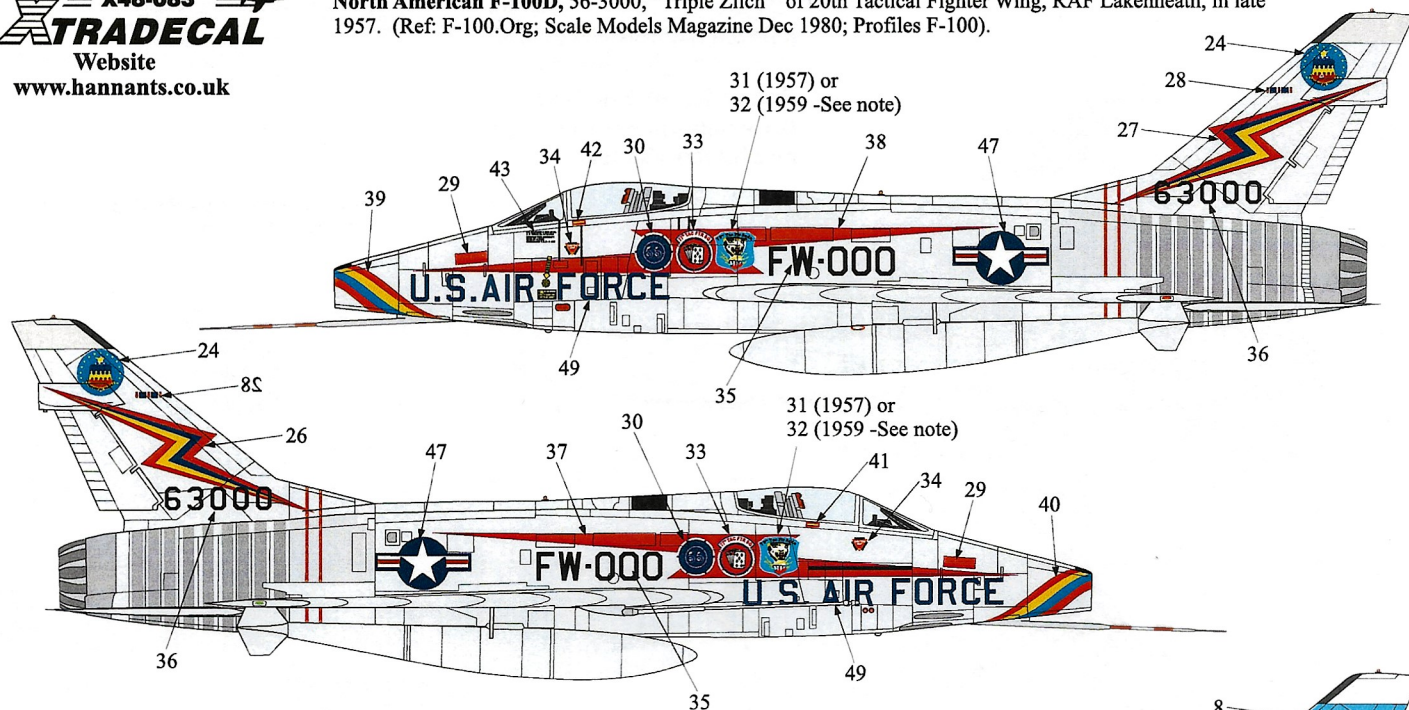
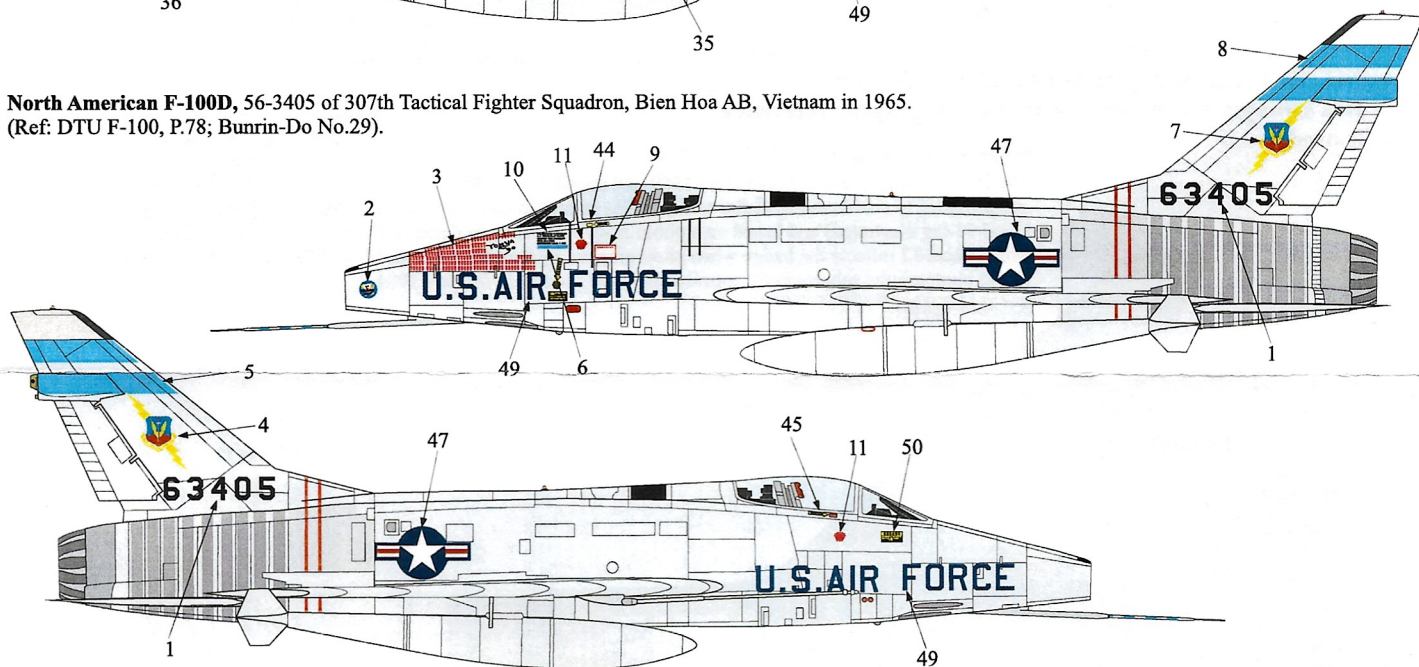


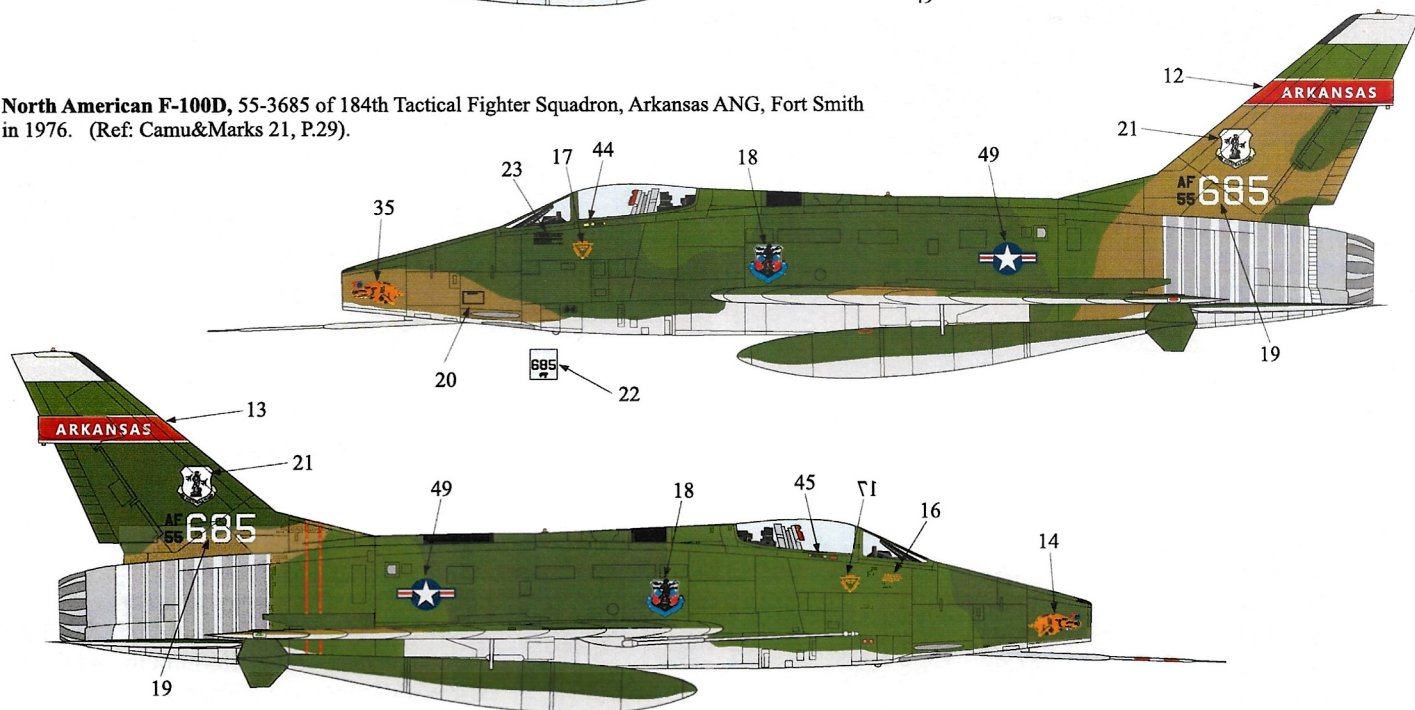

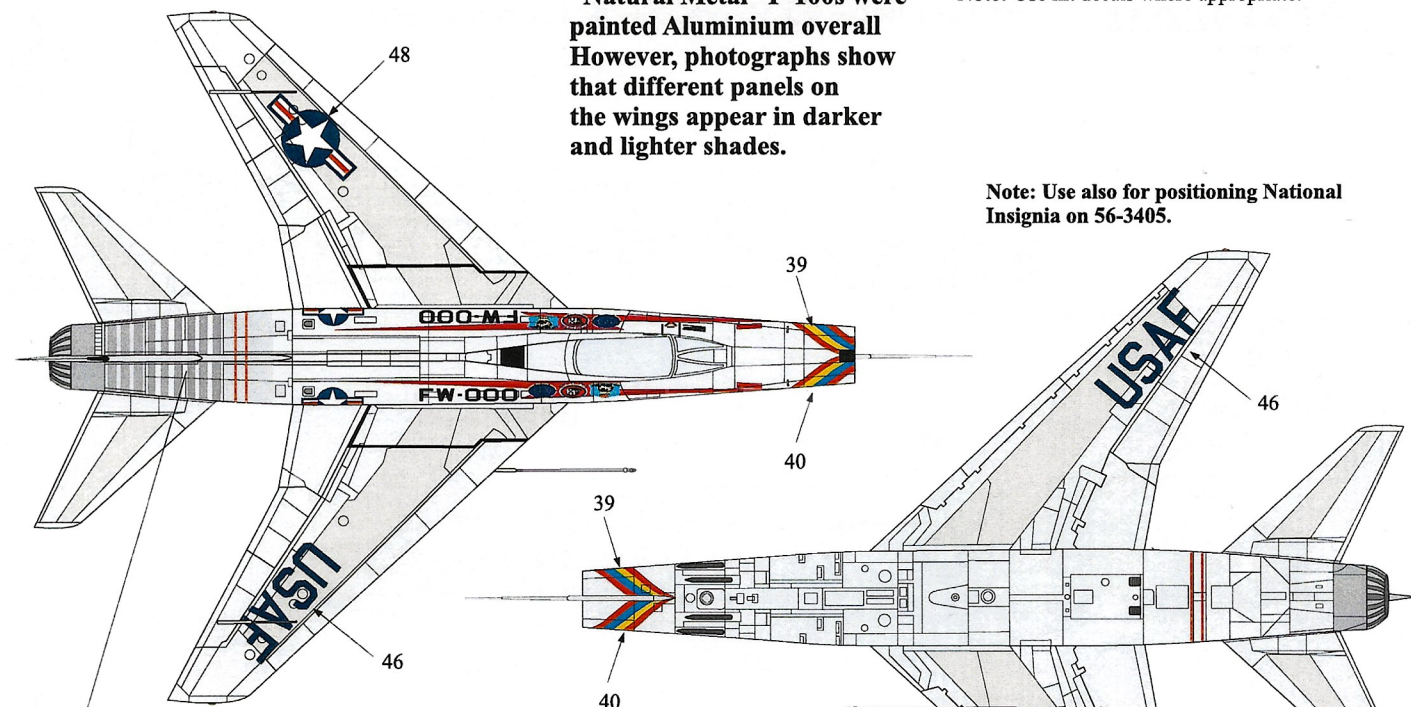

Note: Use kit decals where appropriate.

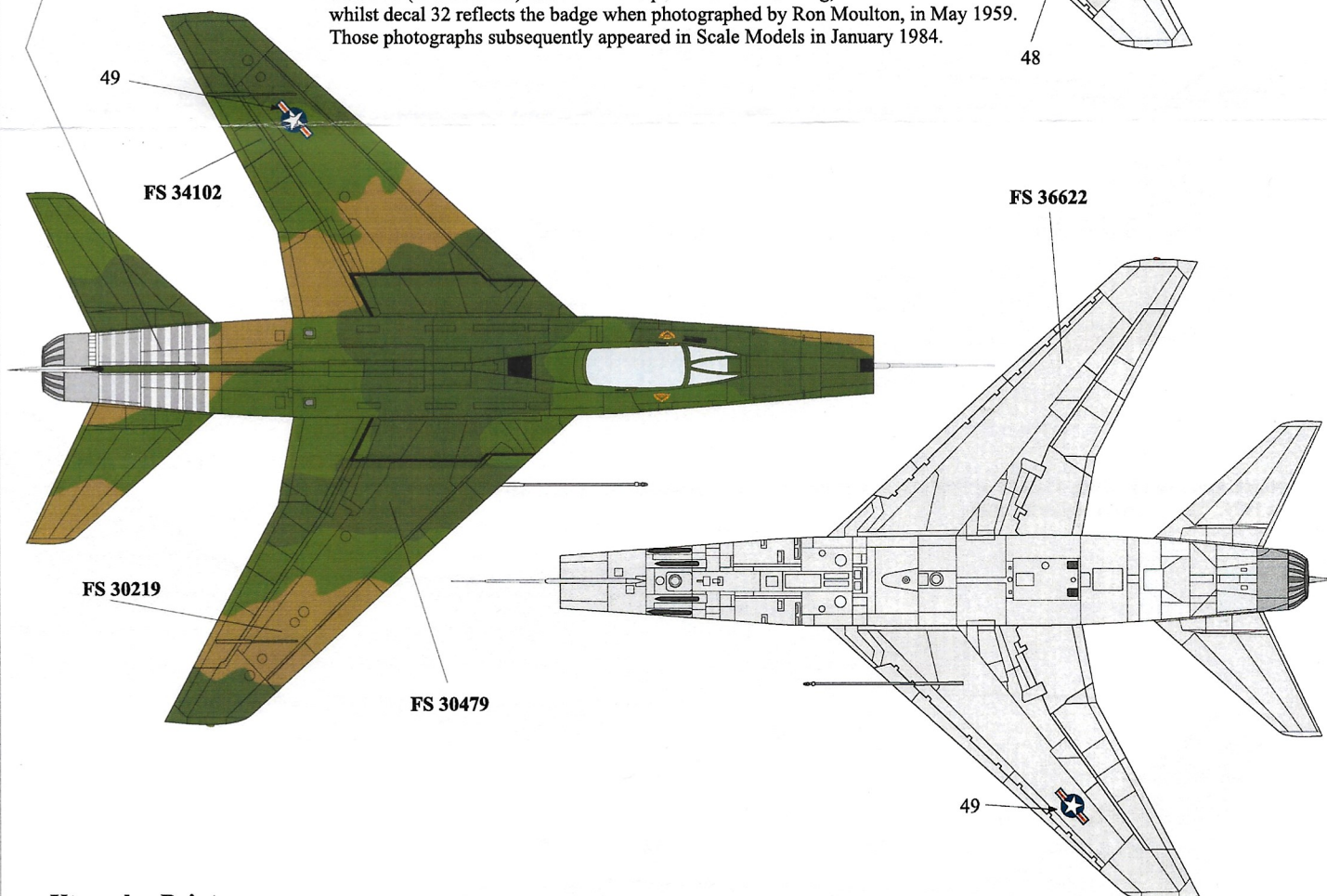
Note: Use also for positioning National Insignia on 56-3405.

NOTE: 56-3000 "Triple Zilch":-

The 79 TFS Badge, was changed circa 1959 and decals 31 and 32 are provided to enable the modeller to depict the aircraft at these different periods. Decal 31 (as illustrated) and based on a photo from F-100.Org, is dated late 1957 whilst decal 32 reflects the badge when photographed by Ron Moulton, in May 1959. Those photographs subsequently appeared in Scale Models in January 1984.
