

MCDONNELL F-101 VOODOO. F-101A, F-101B, CF-101B, RF-101A/C, RF-101H

This decal sheet can be used with any of the commercially available Voodoo kits. By using the "D.B. Conversions" and "Airwave" kits, any of the versions illustrated can be modelled.

Subjects have been chosen to give the modeller a wide choice of Voodoo types, including both single and dual seaters.

Natural metal aircraft carried Olive Drab anti-glare panels on their noses and Flat Black nose cones.

The USAF F-101B aircraft shown had an overall ADC Grey colour scheme, with Black radomes and lettering.

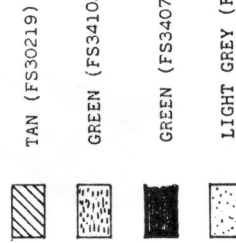
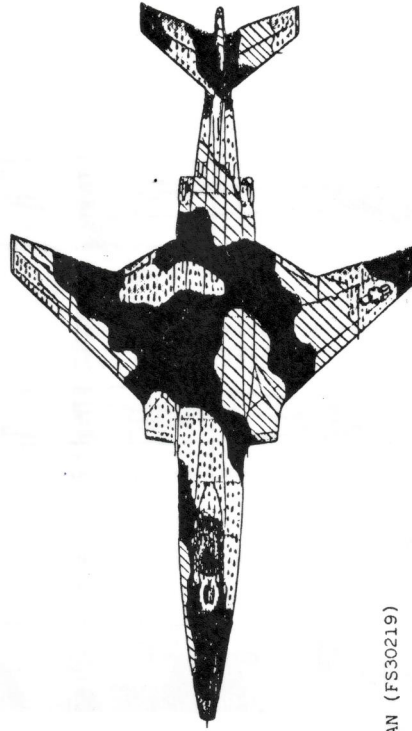
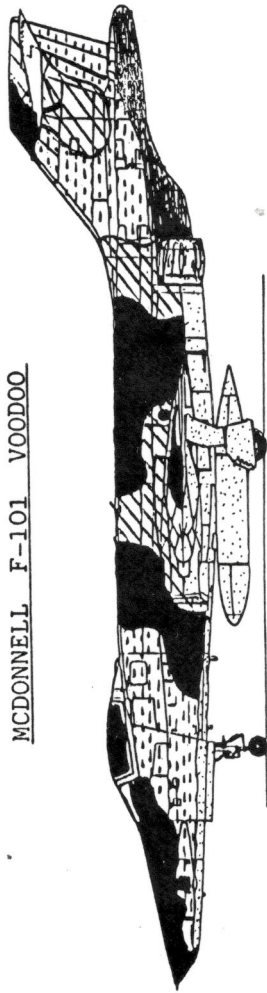
Camouflaged aircraft carried the standard S.E.Asia scheme of Green(FS34102) Green(FS34079) Tan(FS30219) and Grey(FS36622)

THE RCAF CF-101B had a Natural Metal finish, with white panels backing the fuselage titling. By deleting these panels and using the Canadian Flags provided, the earlier RCAF marking scheme can be obtained. Alternate tail markings are provided for an aircraft of 409 Sq participating in the USAF "William Tell" meets at Tyndall AFB Florida. These would replace the kit emblems provided. The lobster zaps were often put on aircraft visiting USAF bases, and highlighted the unofficial "contraband" carried in their weapons bays. It was applied to speed brake doors or lower forward fuselage.

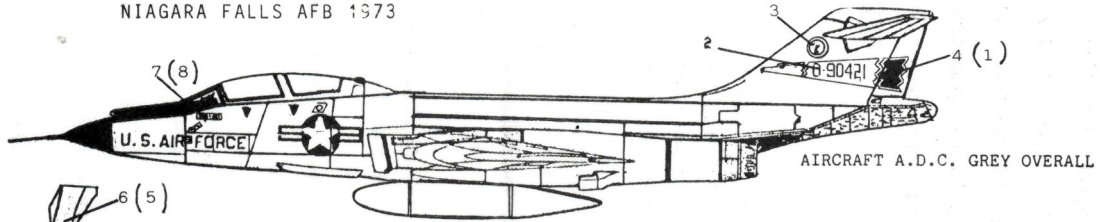

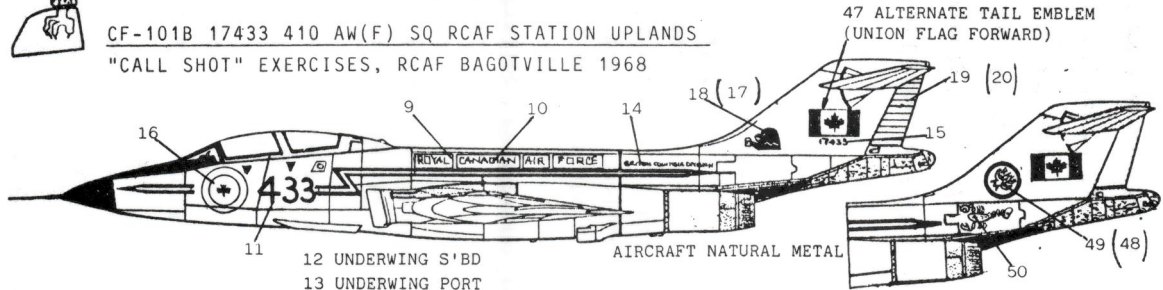

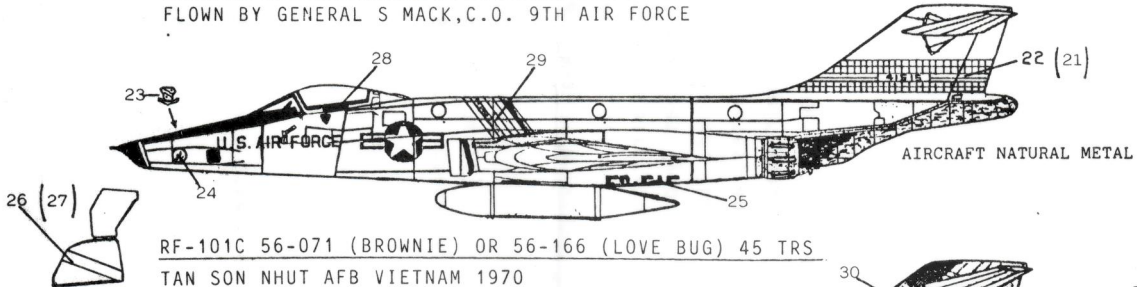

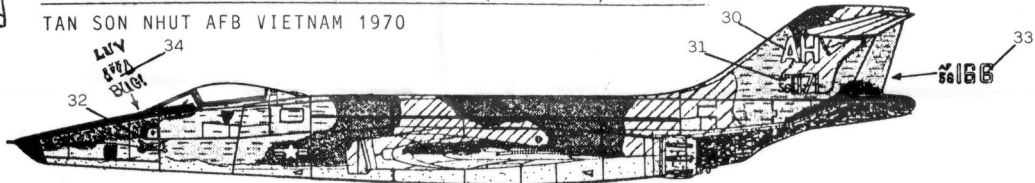

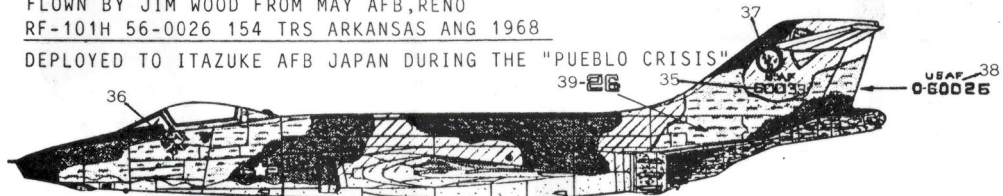

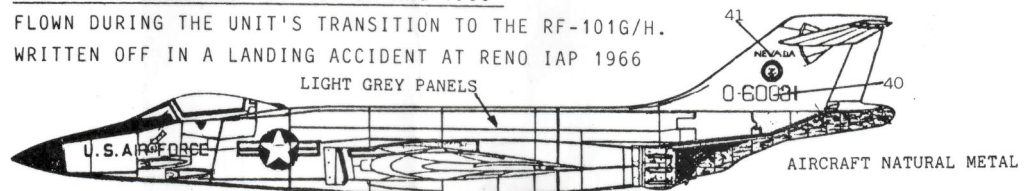

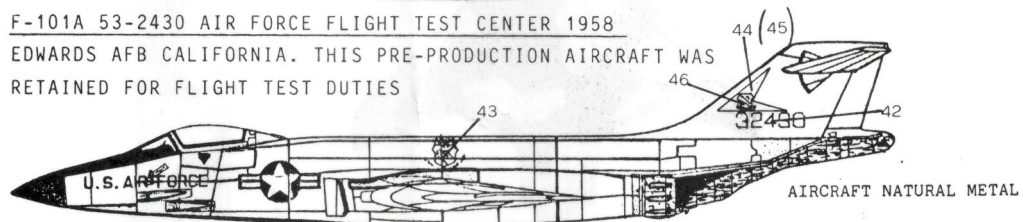
