

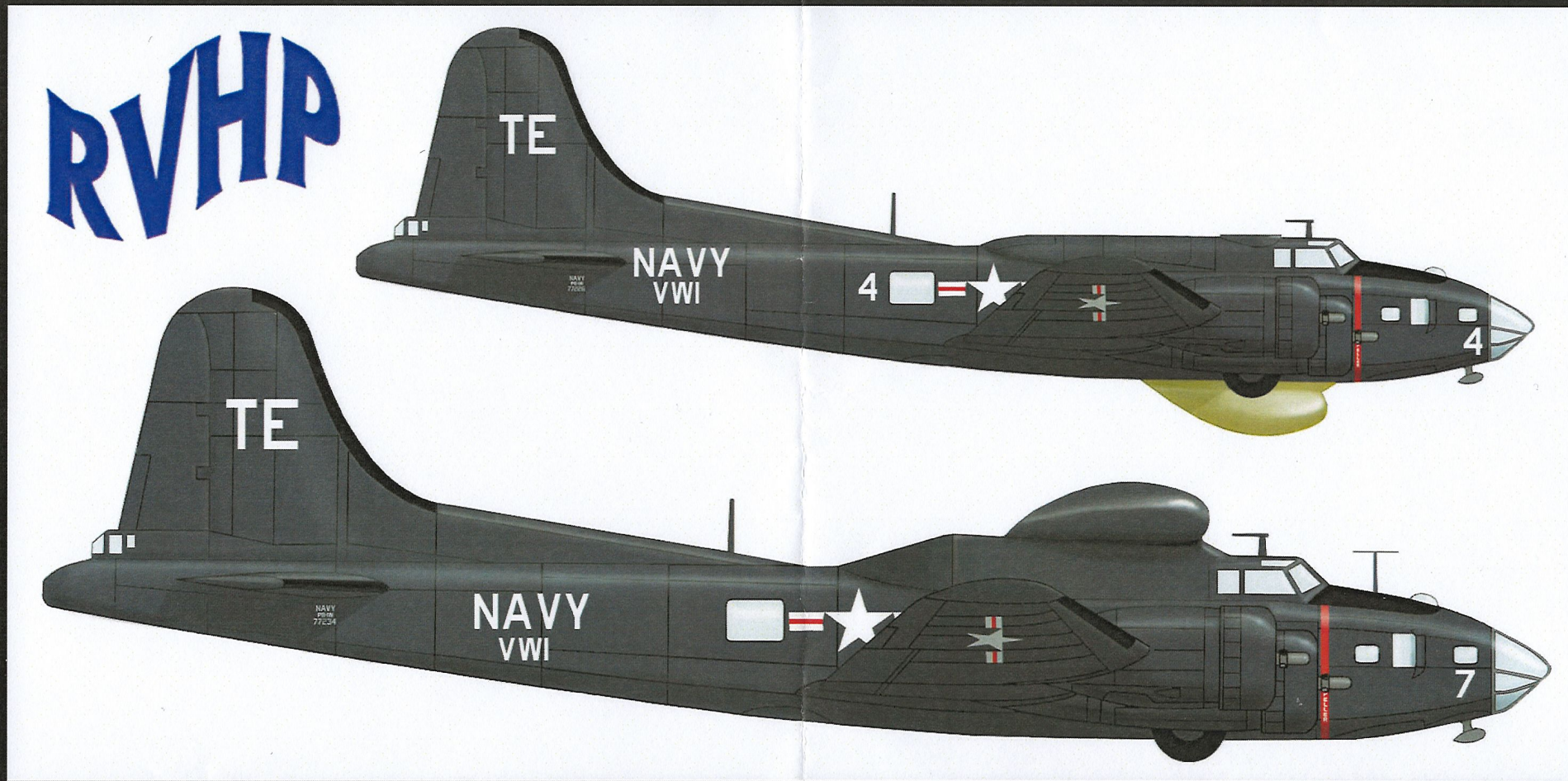

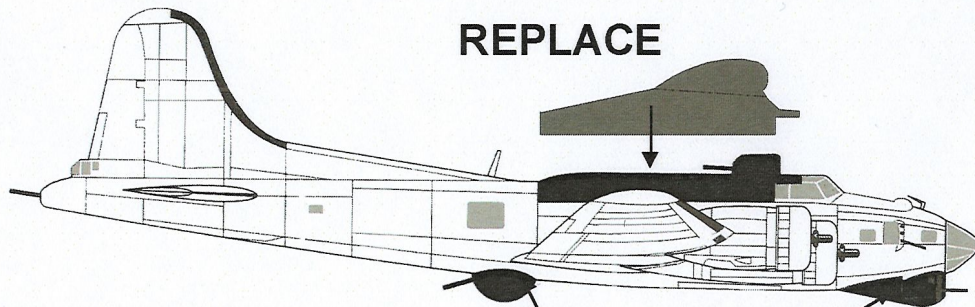


RESIN CONVERSION SET FOR ACADEMY B-17G

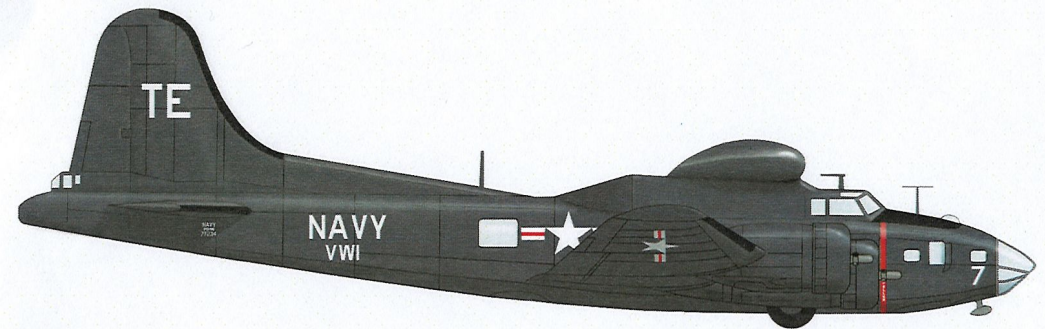
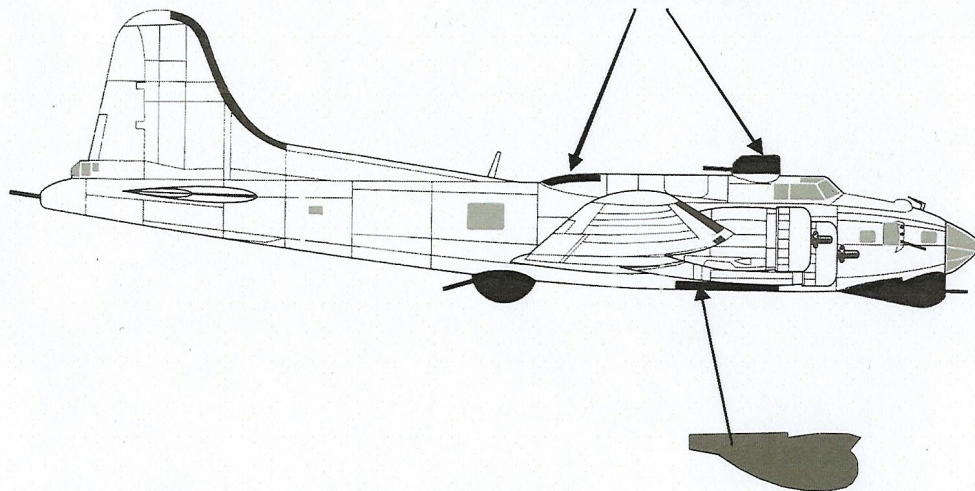

CONVERSION FOR ACADEMY B-17G

HISTORY

A total of 31 Flying Fortresses acquired by the U.S. Navy as surplus from the USAAF in 1945 were designated PB-1Ws. These aircraft were converted for use in anti-submarine warfare. New B-17Gs held in the USAAF supply pool were ferried to the NAMU (Naval Aircraft Modification Unit) at NAS Johnsville, Pennsylvania, for conversion. The major change was the installation of the AN/APS-20 search radar. The bomb bay was sealed, and a large radome was attached over the doors. All turrets were removed and sealed over. A later version of the aircraft had the large belly radome moved to a position on top of the fuselage. Armament was not carried on these aircraft.

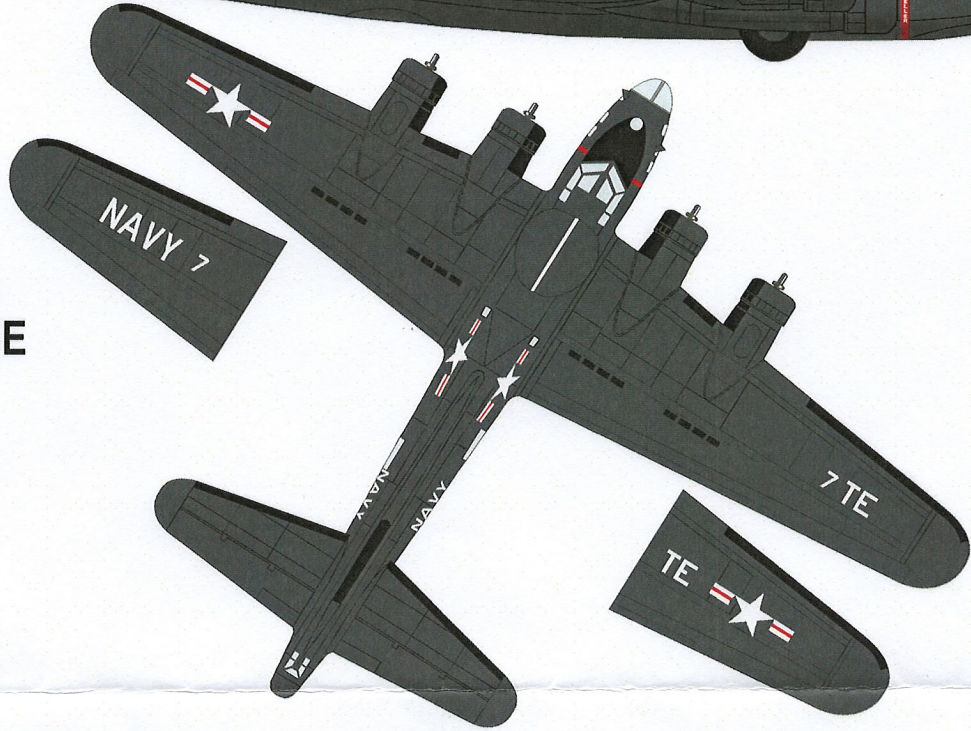

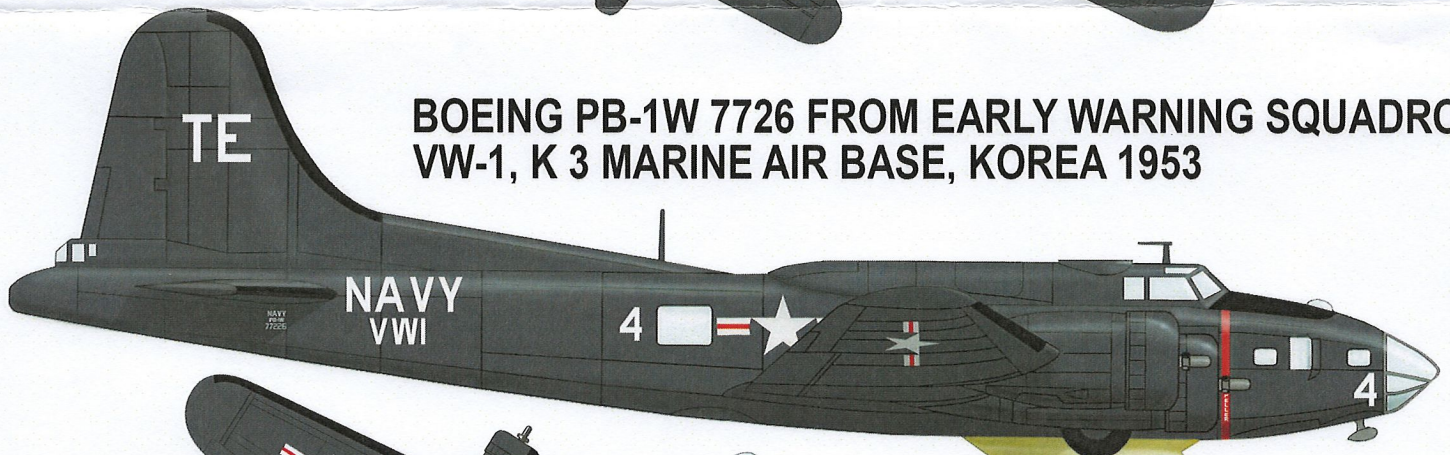
**SOLE BOEING PB-1W 77234 WITH TOP FUSELAGE MOUNTED

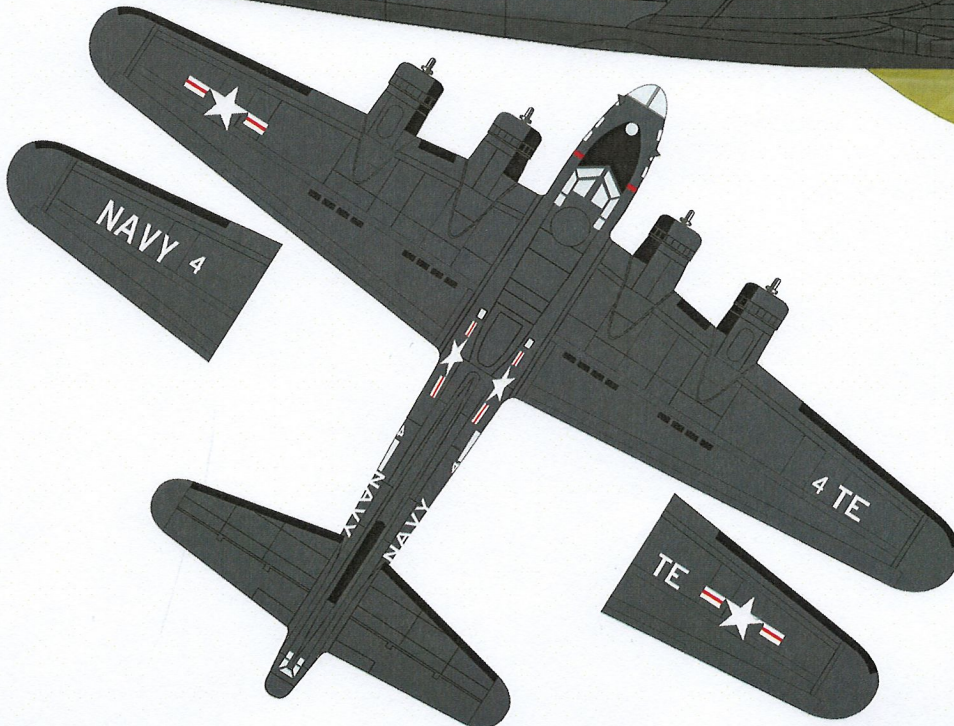


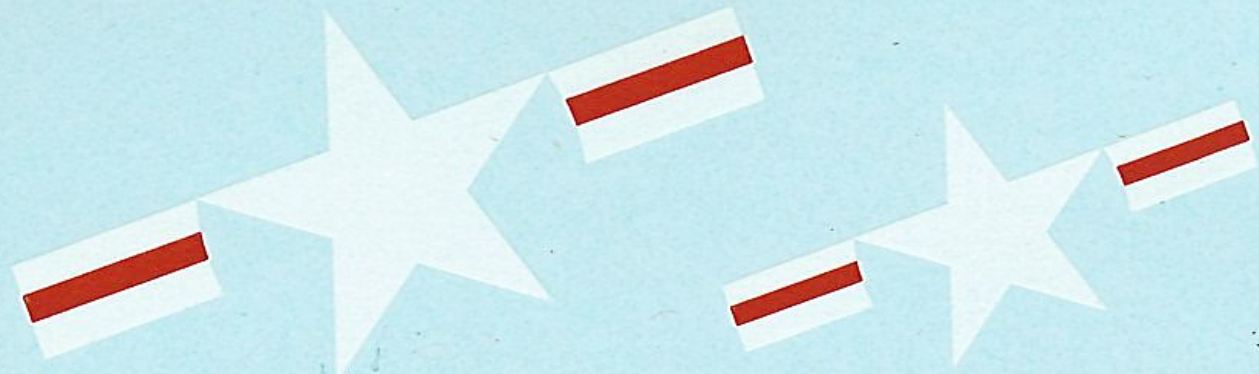
**BOEING PB-1W 7726 FROM EARLY WARNING SQUADRON 1

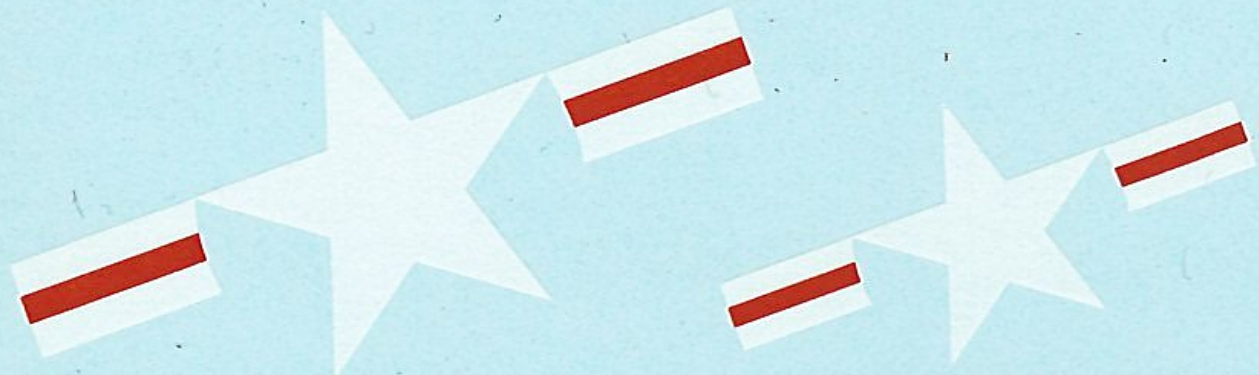

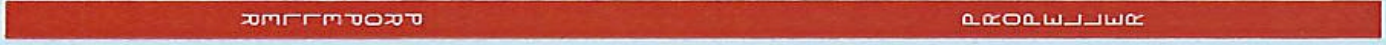
