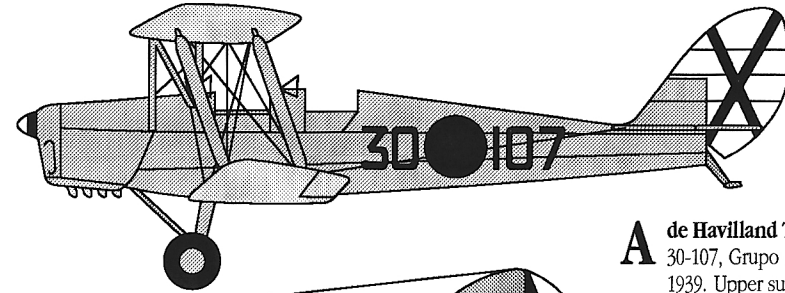




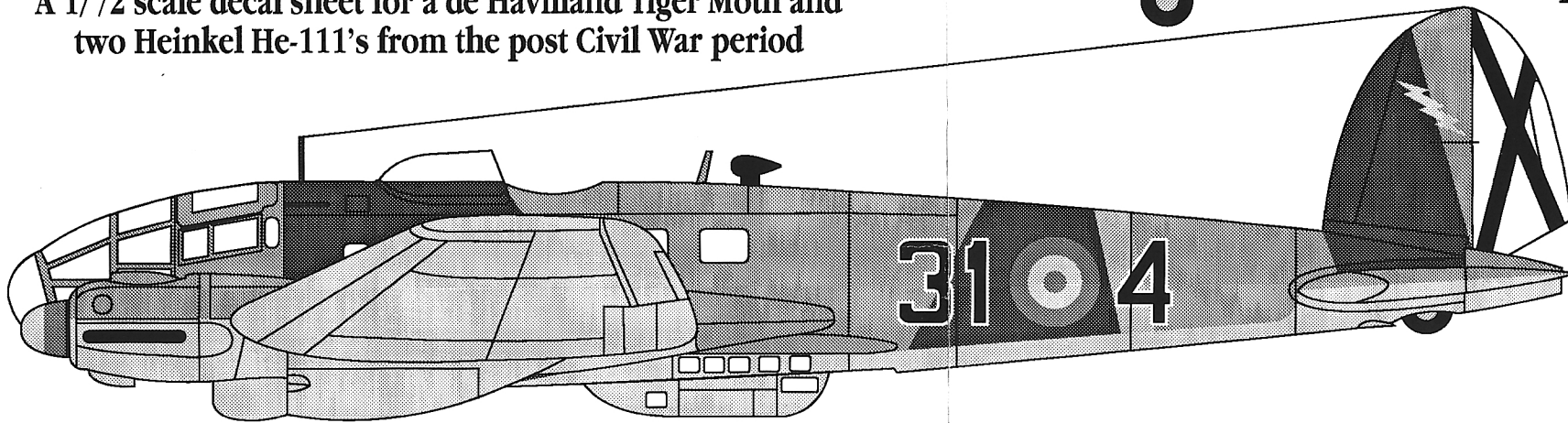

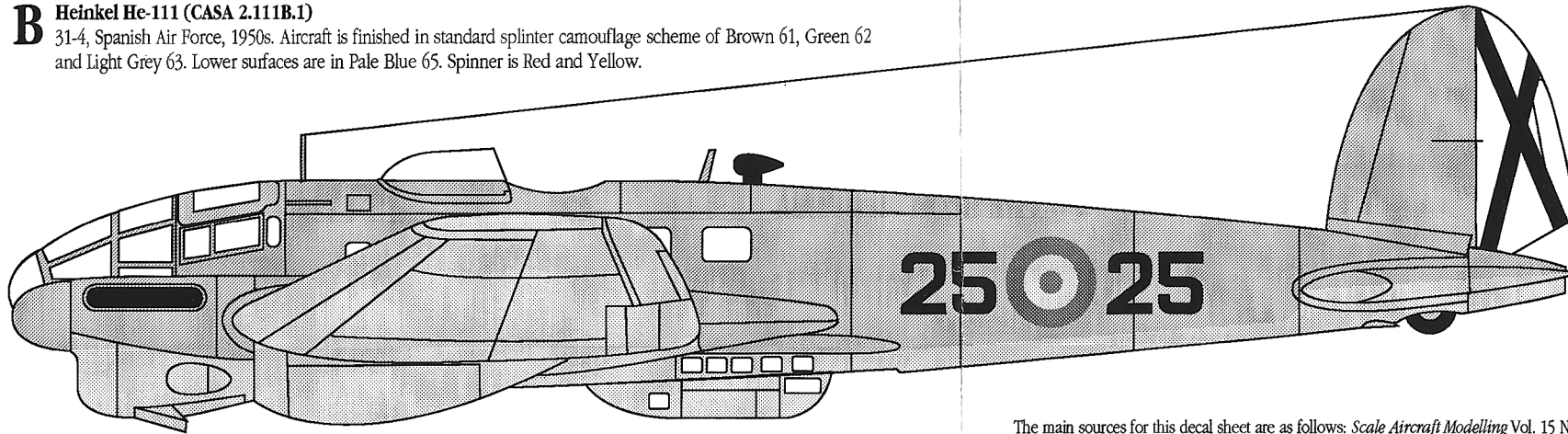
A 1/72 scale decal sheet for a de Havilland Tiger Moth and two Heinkel He-111's from the post Civil War period



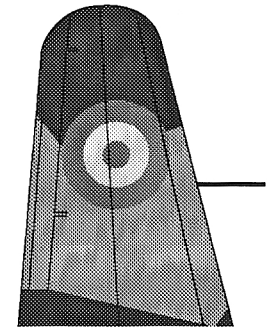
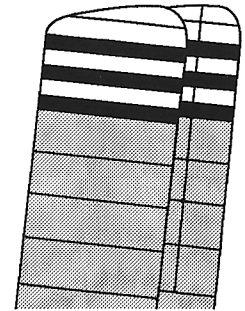
A de Havilland Tiger Moth
30-107, Grupo 30, Spanish Air Force,
1939. Upper surfaces are Light Grey,
lower surfaces are Pale Blue. Note
Black and White striped spinner.



B Heinkel He-111 (CASA 2.111B.1)
31-4, Spanish Air Force, 1950s. Aircraft is finished in standard splinter camouflage scheme of Brown 61, Green 62
and Light Grey 63. Lower surfaces are in Pale Blue 65. Spinner is Red and Yellow.



C Heinkel He-111 (CASA 2.111B.21)
25-25, Spanish Air Force, 1960s. Aircraft is finished in Light Grey on upper surfaces with Light Blue lower surfaces.
Spinner is Light Grey. Note the Rolls Royce Merlin 500-20 engines on this aircraft.
