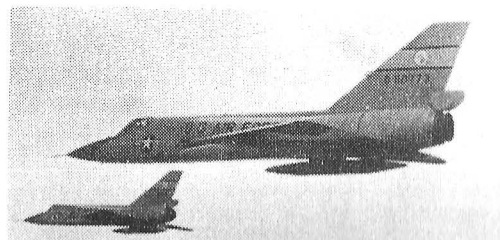

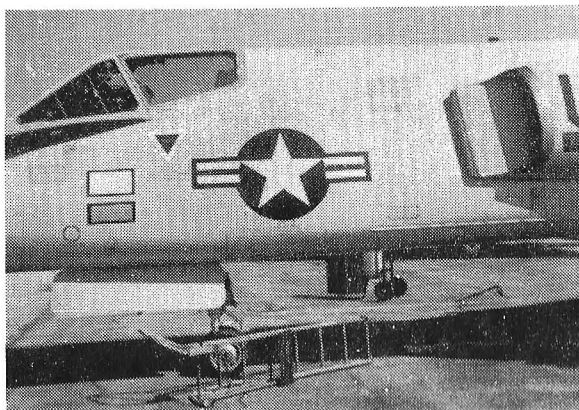

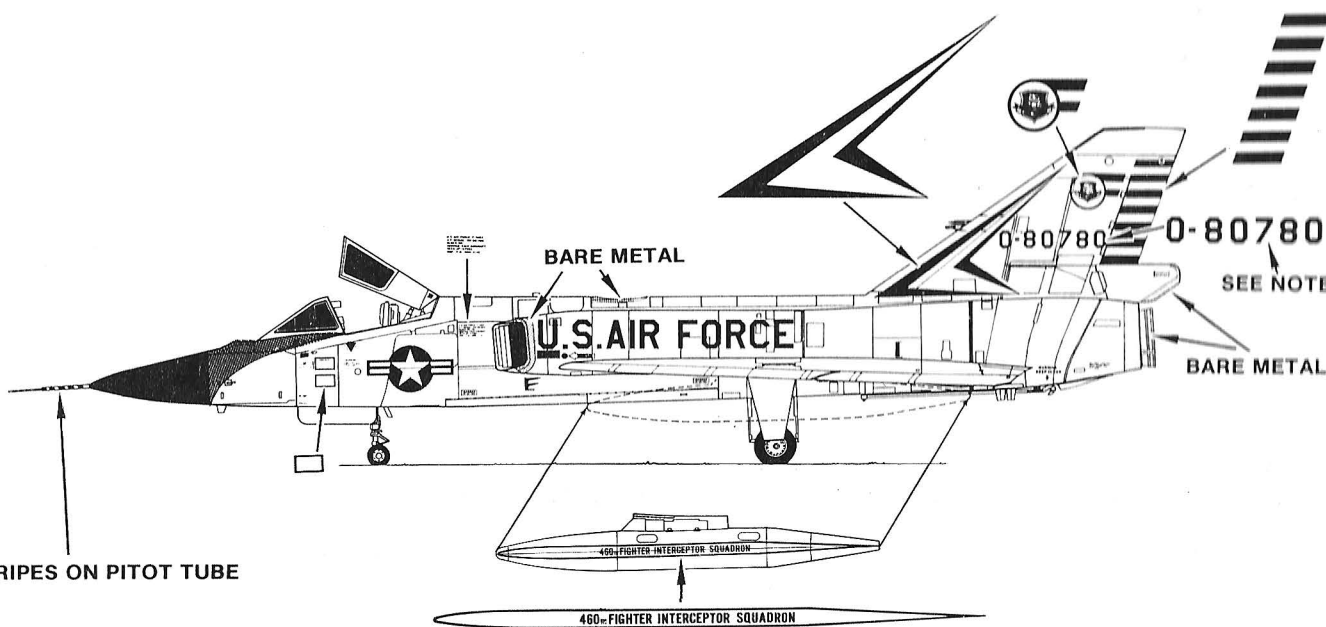
F-106A, 0-80780, 460th FIGHTER INTERCEPTOR SQUADRON

Use kit decals for USAF, U.S. AIR FORCE, national insignia, and all stencils.

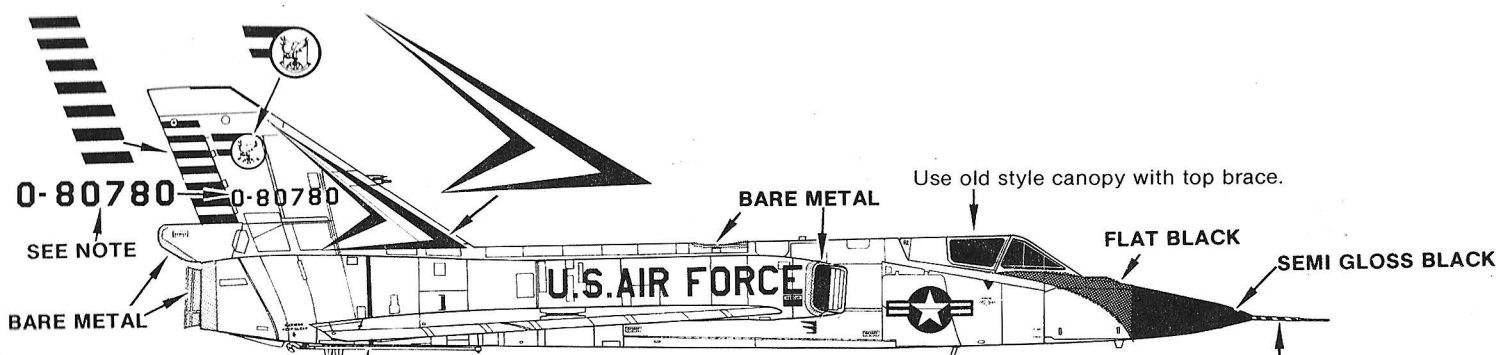

YELLOW AND BLACK STRIPES ON PITOT TUBE



Red turbine stripe on this aircraft. Use three red stripes provided on decal sheet.

NOTE

Add 0- in front of serial number for this aircraft. The 0- is provided separately.

PAINTING NOTES

All aircraft are overall ADC gray, FS 16473. The landing gear is aluminum, FS 17178, and the wheel wells are chromate green, FS 34151. Radomes and anti-glare panels are painted as indicated on the drawings. Intake lips, refueling receptacle, and end of fuselage around the engine are bare metal. Engine tail pipe is burnt metal. Follow kit instructions for painting other details.

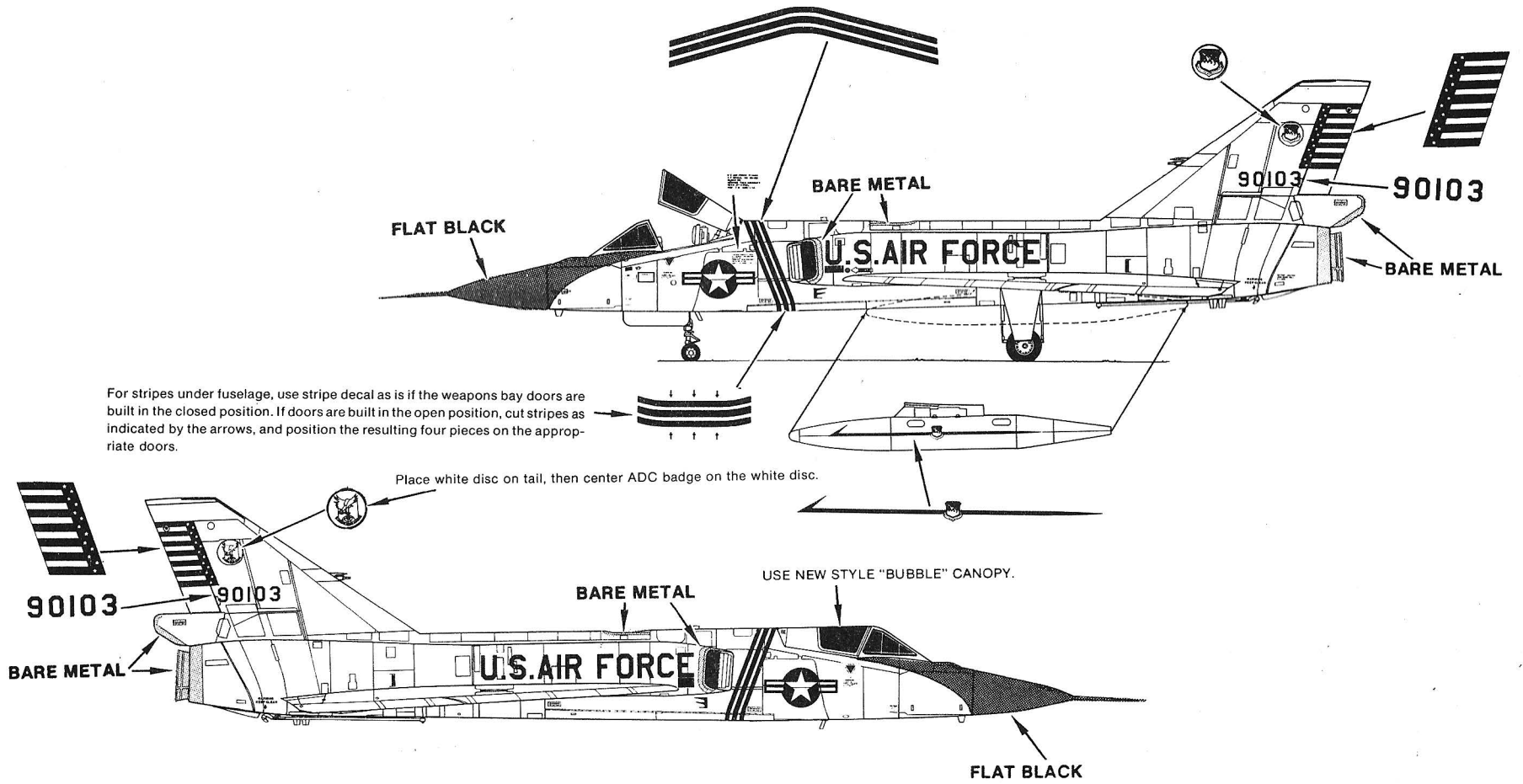

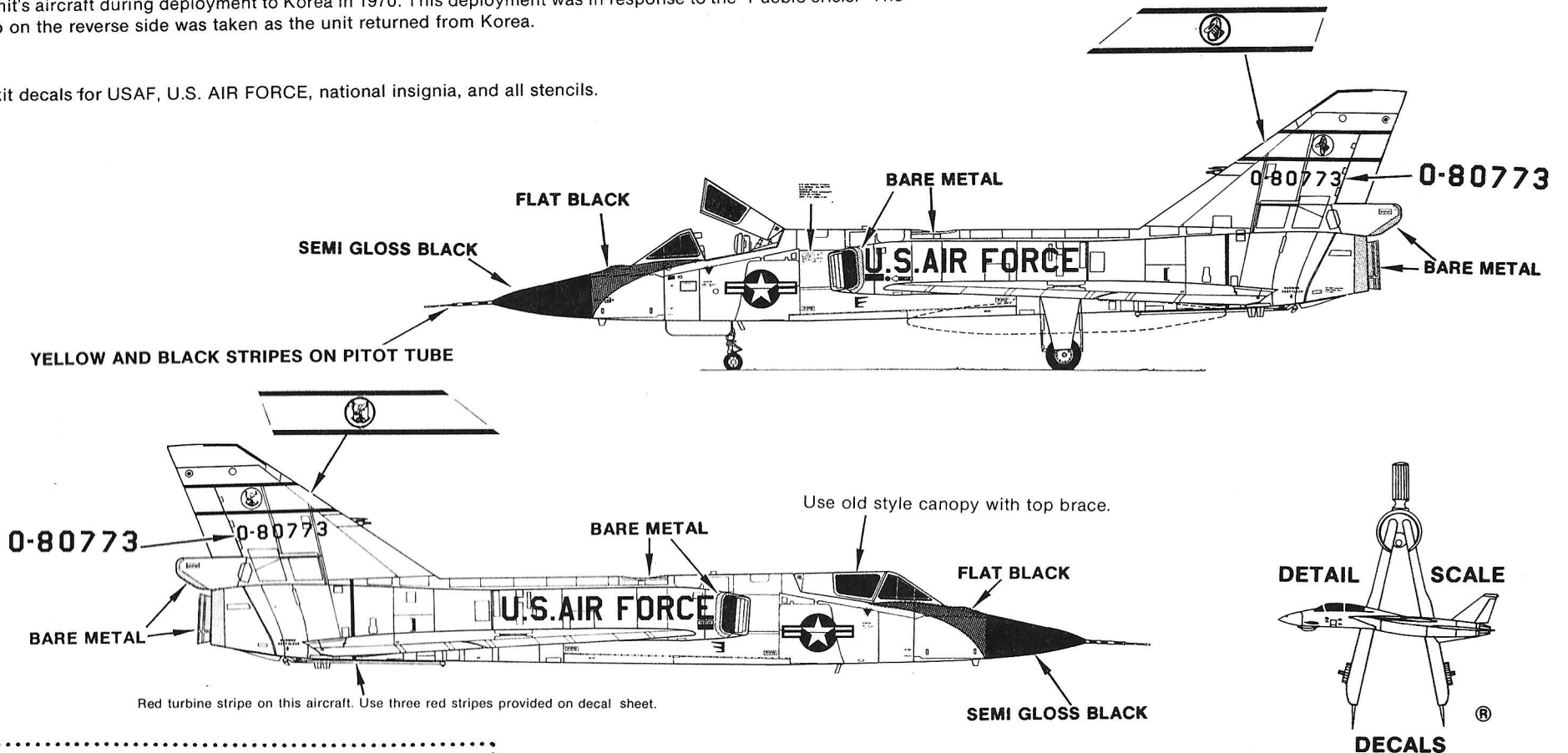

This Delta Dart is from the famous "Hat in Ring," 94th Fighter Interceptor Squadron. These markings were carried by the unit's aircraft during deployment to Korea in 1970. This deployment was in response to the "Pueblo crisis." The photo on the reverse side was taken as the unit returned from Korea.
