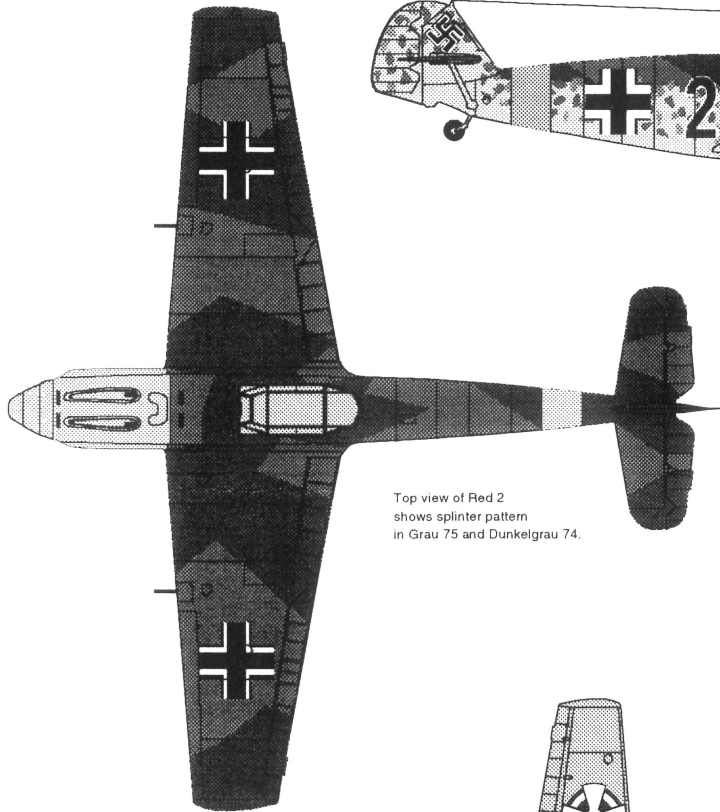
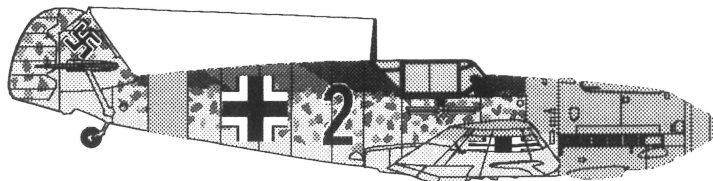


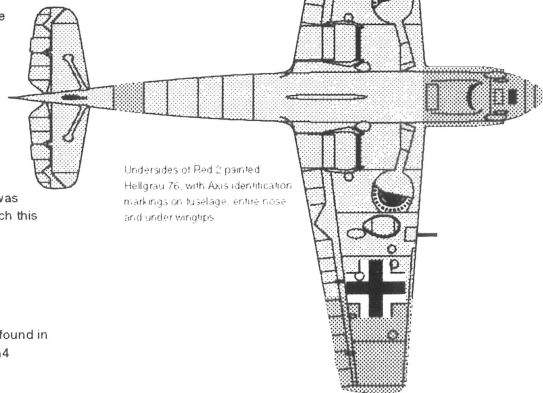

Top view of Red 2 shows splinter pattern in Grau 75 and Dunkelgrau 74.

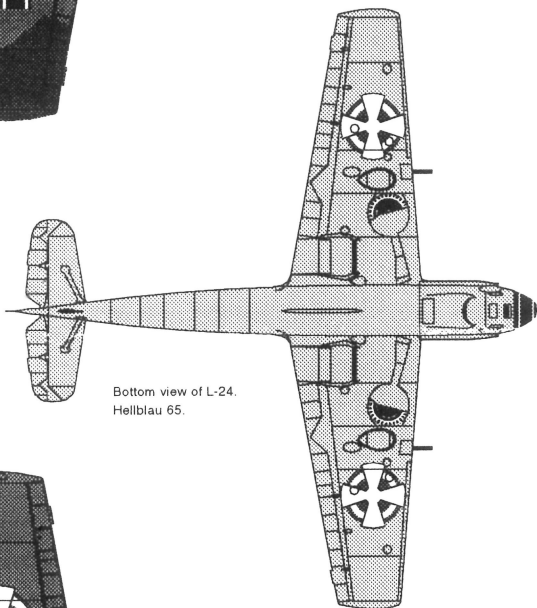


Bf-109E. Standard Luftwaffe camouflage 74/75 on top surfaces, with fuselage mottled in 74/75/02 and RLM 76 below. Luftwaffe insignia in all positions with crest on both sides below cockpit sill. Yellow nose, fuselage band, and lower wingtips for Axis aircraft operating in the East. Red 2 not as illustrated (oops). This is too bad, but it's such a nice drawing we present it anyways. Red 2 was seen in the company of Red 15, for which this scheme applies.

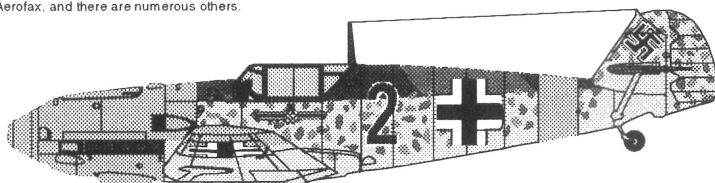


Undersides of Red 2 painted Hellgrau 76, with Axis identification markings on fuselage, entire nose and under wingtips.

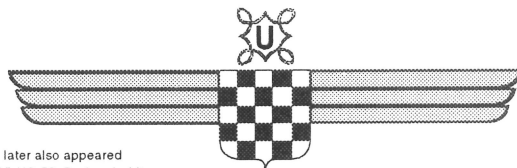

Bottom view of L-24. Hellblau 65.

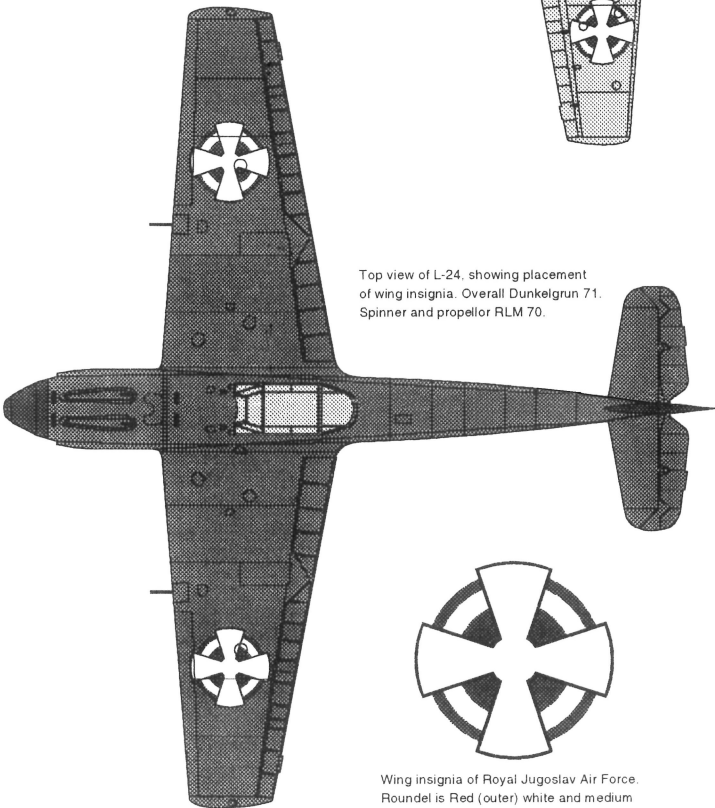
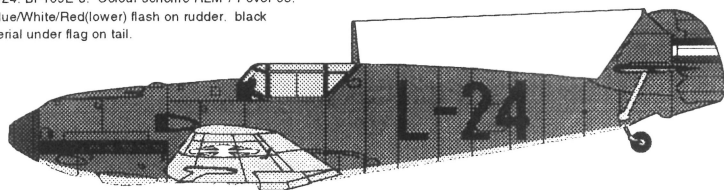


Camouflage for Red 2 started out as illustrated. Top wings and fuselage overpainted with RLM 75. Low on the fuselage. Dense, snakey mottle of RLM 74 was painted over this, on fuselage and the top of wings. Insignia and Yellow theatre markings as illustrated.

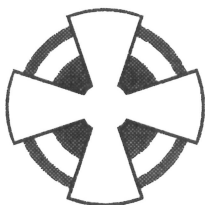


Crest on Red 2 later also appeared on Gustavs of 15./JG 52. Red and white Ustashi crest flanked with silver wings, red outline.

L-24, Bf-109E-3. Colour scheme RLM 71 over 65. Blue/White/Red(lower) flash on rudder. black serial under flag on tail.



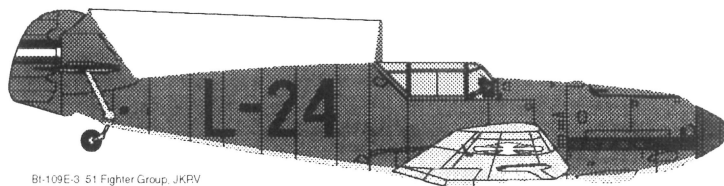
Top view of L-24, showing placement of wing insignia. Overall Dunkelgrun 71. Spinner and propellor RLM 70.



Wing insignia of Royal Yugoslav Air Force. Roundel is Red (outer) white and medium blue, cross outlined in dark blue.

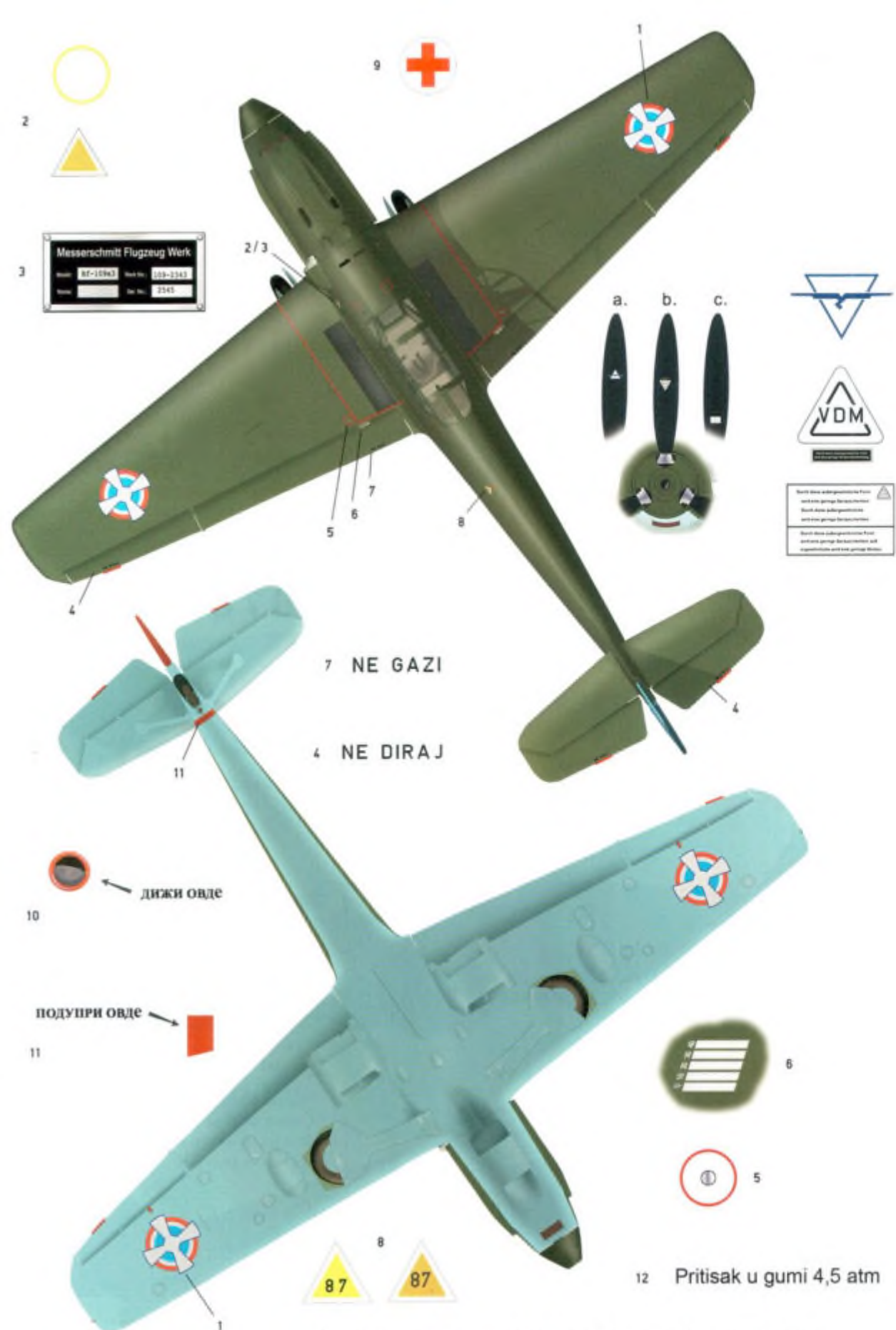


4101 - Bf-109E, Royal Yugoslav Air Force 15.(Kroat) /JG 51, I Fliegerkorps
