


Intended for use with the Airfix Ferret Mk.2.

SMM3564M Ferret Engine Set


This is a standalone set which can easily be combined with the SMM3564L Interior Corpion Set. The fuel tank is identical in both sets, though a constluent of the set Set. The fuel tank is identical in both sets, though a small modification is needed. The air cleaner is similar, but has a longer pipe.

The engine on the real Ferret is a Rolls-Royce B60. This is the six cylinder, 4.26 litre water-cooled petrol engine connected by a fluid coupling to a pre-selector five speed epicyclic gearbox. The B60 Mk.3A engine produced 116 bhp at 3,300 rpm and 129 bhp at 3,750 in its later B60 Mk.6A form.










## **Parts List**

- 1 Engine
- 2 Fan/radiator
- 3 Fuel tank also in SMM3564L Interior Set.
- 4 Fan belt
- 5 Generator
- 6 Exhaust

- 7 Oill filler pipe (too short see below)
- 8 Air cleaner and pipe
- 9 Fuel filter
- 10 Manifold
- 11 Oil cooler
- 12 Engine bay brace (strut too short see page 3)
- 13 Driveshafts






Step 2 This top part of the fuel tank needs to be carved out to a curved shape to clear the front of the engine block.

This is about 1.5 mm higher than the original flat edge.

It is hidden with the engine in place.



Step 4 Slide the engine assembly into place and firmly glue to the floor hull.

Step 5 Add the fuel filter (part 9) to the right hull wall.



Step 6 Slide the radiator vertically onto the fan belts.

Before glueing, use the kit engine deck (without cutting the awful grille off), to make sure the radiator is in the correct position. It should sit on top of the engine base, and against the hull walls.

Keep fitting the hull top to make sure everything fits underneath.

Step 7 Fit the remaining parts in this order:
Part 9 on the left hull wall,
Partr 12 which fits under the ribs on the hull walls and onto the radiator – with a longer strut,
Part 11 sits on the hull rib and on top of the strut to the radiator.

If desired, replace the kit grille with SMM3564G.

Part 12 – remove strut and replace with longer one at 9 mm to the radiator
