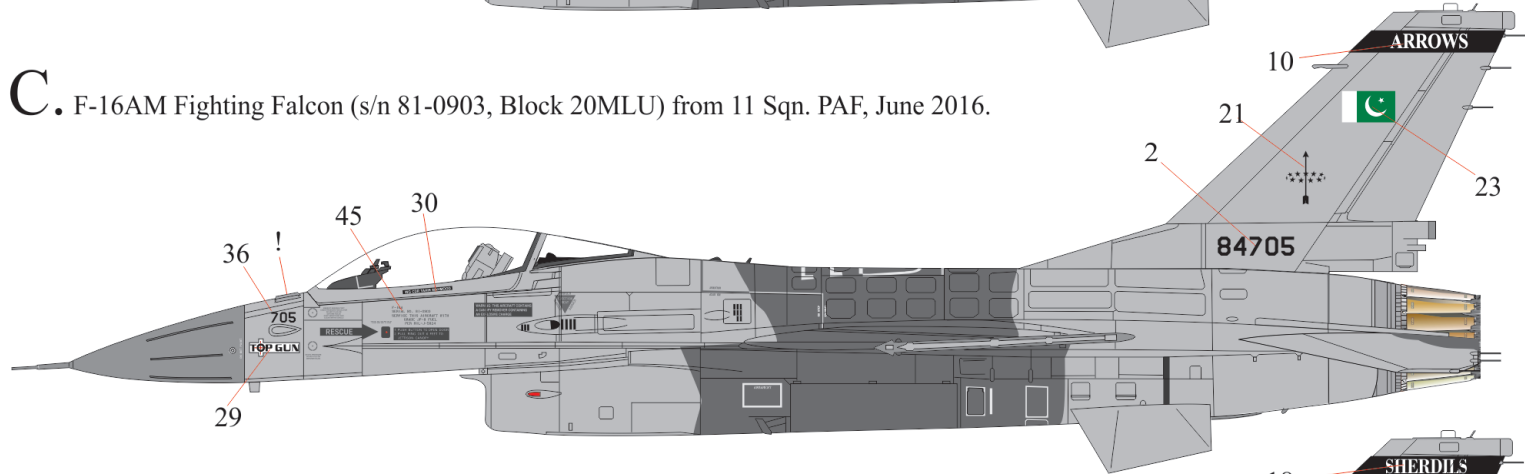
**A.** F-16AM Fighting Falcon (s/n 91-0901, Block 20 MLU) from 9 Sqn. PAF, March 2018.



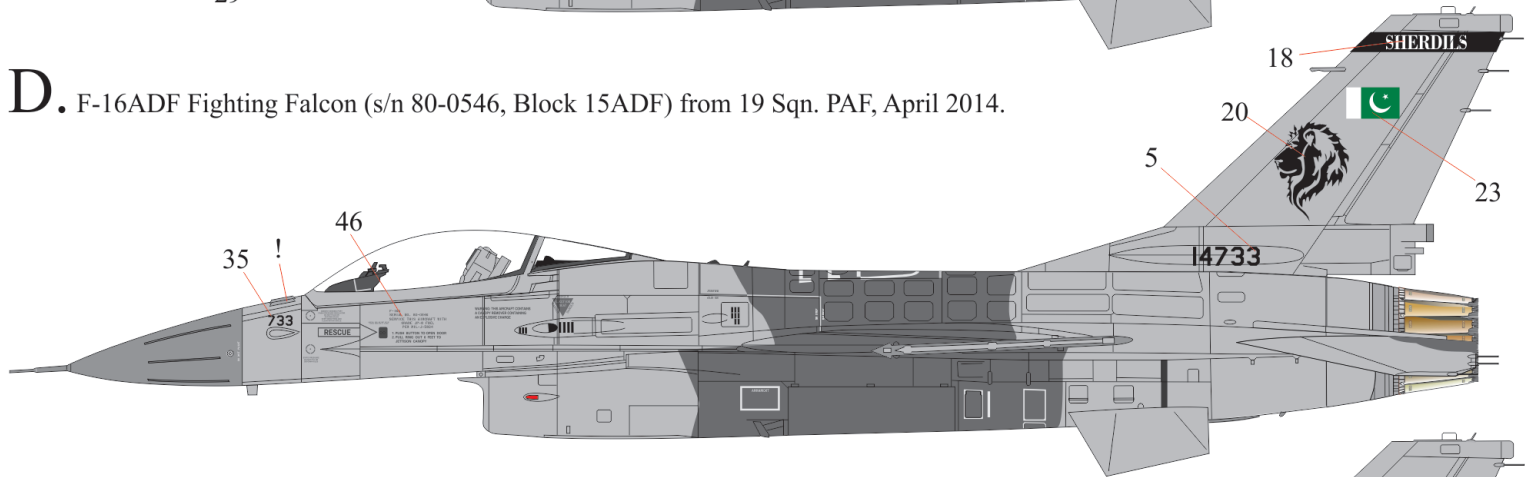

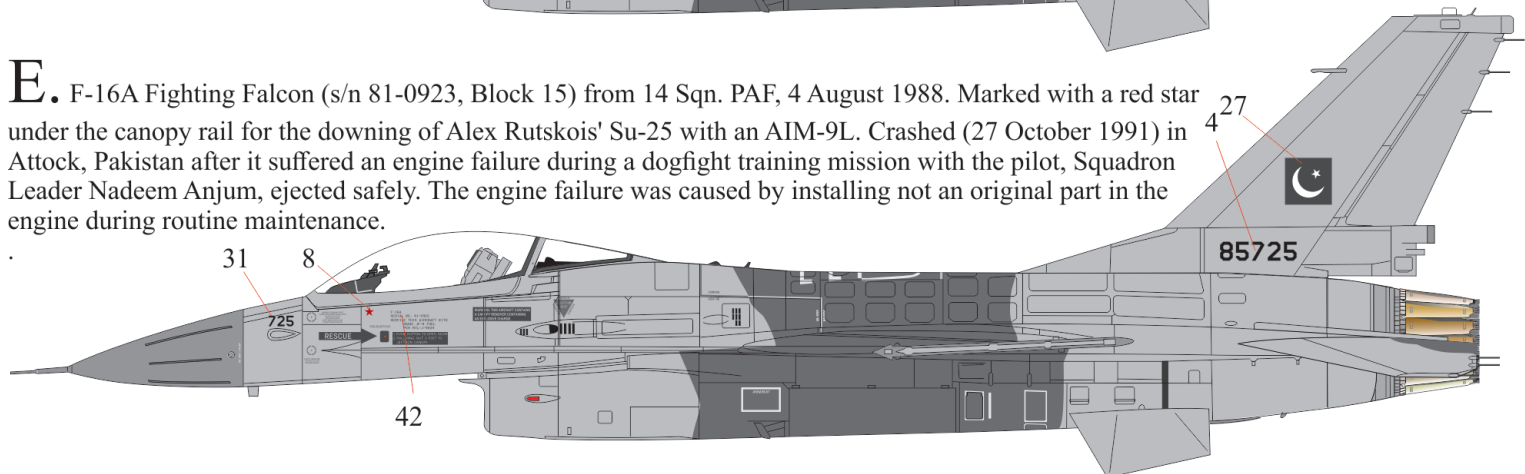
**C.** F-16AM Fighting Falcon (s/n 81-0903, Block 20MLU) from 11 Sqn. PAF, June 2016.



**D.** F-16ADF Fighting Falcon (s/n 80-0546, Block 15ADF) from 19 Sqn. PAF, April 2014.

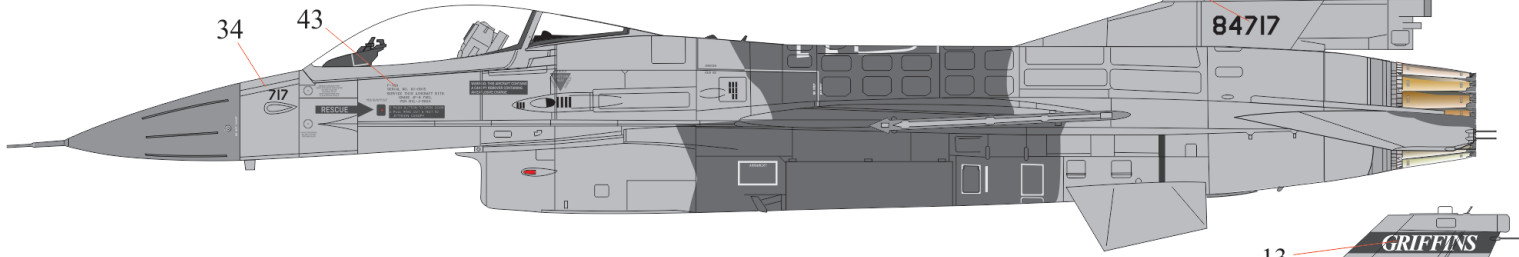


**E.** F-16A Fighting Falcon (s/n 81-0923, Block 15) from 14 Sqn. PAF, 4 August 1988. Marked with a red star under the canopy rail for the downing of Alex Rutskois' Su-25 with an AIM-9L. Crashed (27 October 1991) in Attock, Pakistan after it suffered an engine failure during a dogfight training mission with the pilot, Squadron Leader Nadeem Anjum, ejected safely. The engine failure was caused by installing not an original part in the engine during routine maintenance.



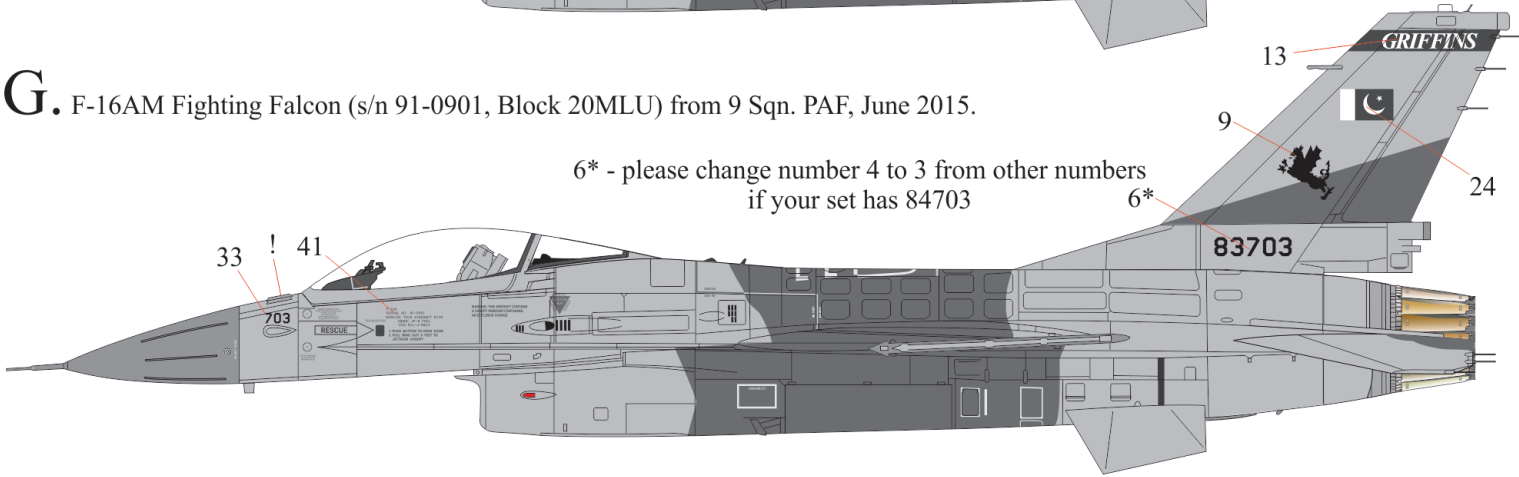
**F.** F-16A Fighting Falcon (s/n 91-0915, Block 15) from 14 Sqn. PAF, 03 November 1998.

At November 03, 1988, Flt. Lt. Khalid Mehmood challenged a formation of 3 Afghan Su-22s near Kohat and after a short dogfight, shot down one of the planes. The entire incident was observed from the ground by personnel of the Pakistan Army and by Phatan tribesmen.
