Applying the gauges and placards

DO NOT APPLY INSTRUMENTS OR PLACARDS DRY

There is a piece of Wet Media paper included with this product. This is not clear decal film, it's a special product that will allow the transfers be applied much like a wet decal but there is no clear film involved. The wet media paper will allow precise positioning to take full advantage of the fact that these transfers are designed to precisely fit the kit parts.

To use the Wet Media paper Simply rub the transfer onto the shiny side of the Wet Media paper, dip it into

water, set it on a non-absorbant surface and wait for the transfers float free. Using a small paintbrush, pick the transfer up and place it onto the kit part. Keep the surface wet, stay patient and gently position the transfer. Once the transfer is in position, gently wick the water away and press the transfer down into the kit part until it conforms.

To make lenses over the instruments, use 5-minute epoxy with a little extra hardener. Gradually add the epoxy with a fine piece of wire or tooth pick until it fills the bezel without forming a curved surface.
