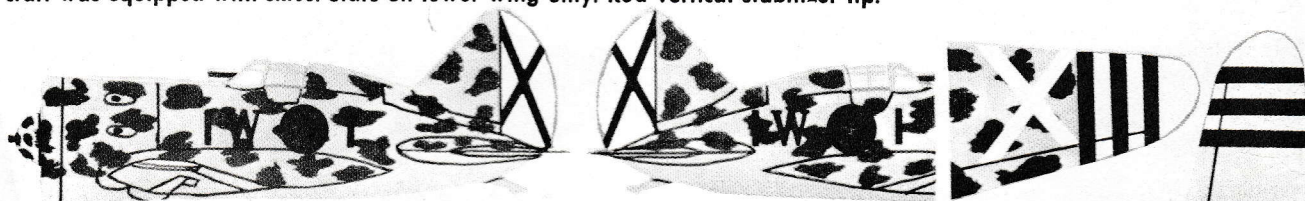

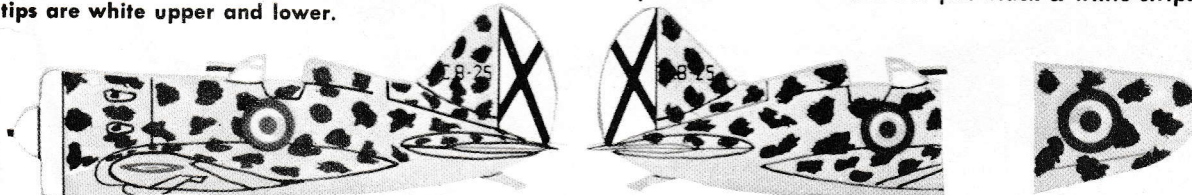

SOVIET TYPE 24 in winter scene of white. Upper wings red. No. 3 blue lower wings and stabilizer. Body white. This aircraft was equipped with skies. Stars on lower wing only. Red vertical stabilizer tip.

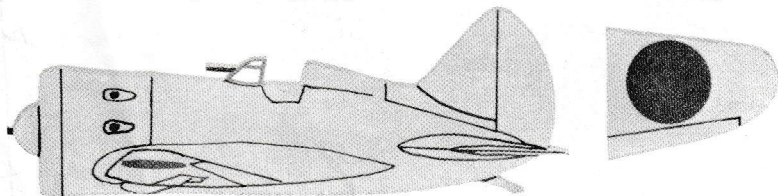

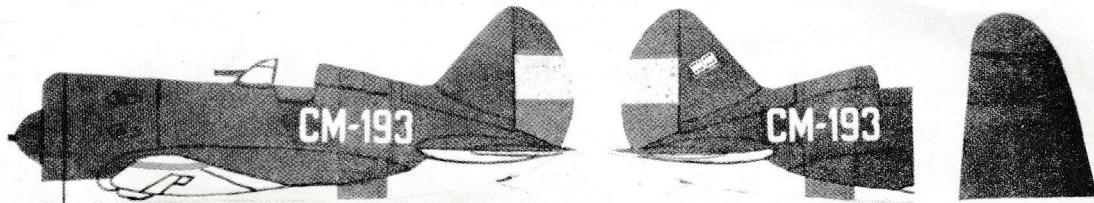

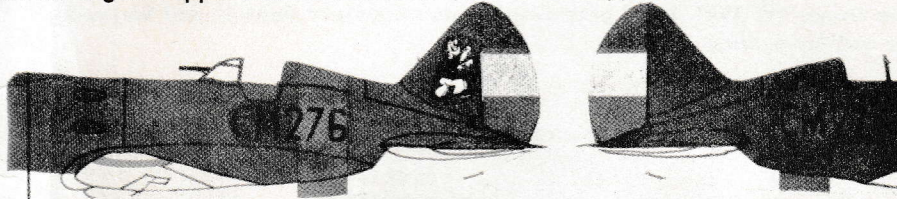
JAPANESE TYPE 10. This aircraft was captured by Japanese army forces late 1939. No. 5 gray overall. Wing markings upper and lower.





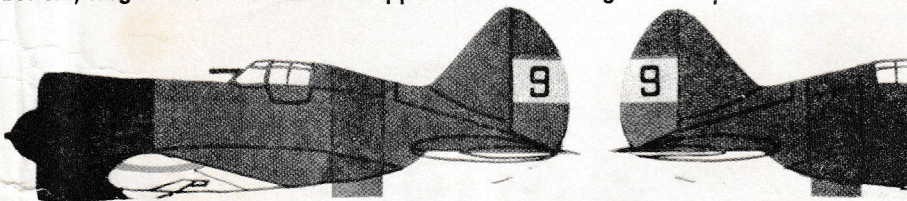
SPANISH REPUBLICAN TYPE 10. This aircraft was flown by a Mexican, Francisco Tarazona. Commander of the 3rd Flight, 11th Squadron of the 21st Group which flew in defense of Barcelona, Nov. 1938 - Jan. 1939. No. 6 green upper and No. 3 blue lower. Red band upper and lower wing.

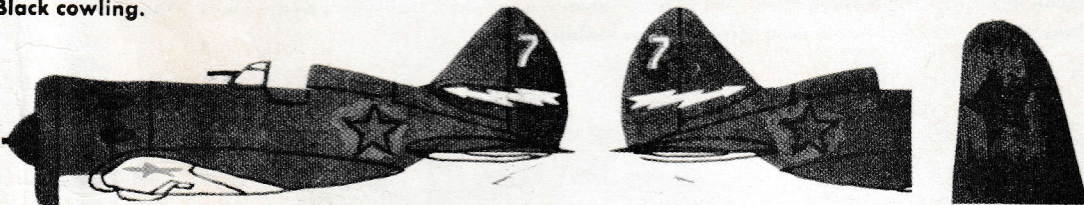

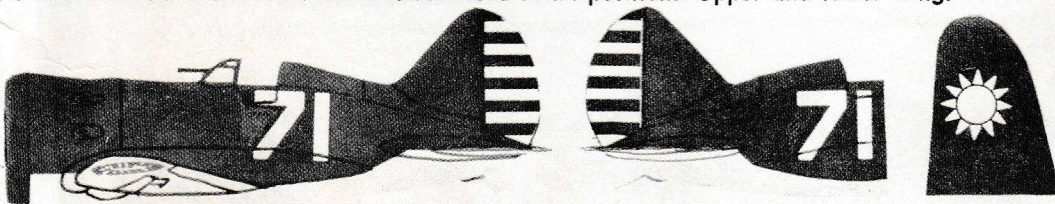
SPANISH REPUBLICAN TYPE 6. Used during 1938. Note canopy. No. 6 green upper and No. 3 blue lower. Black cowling.

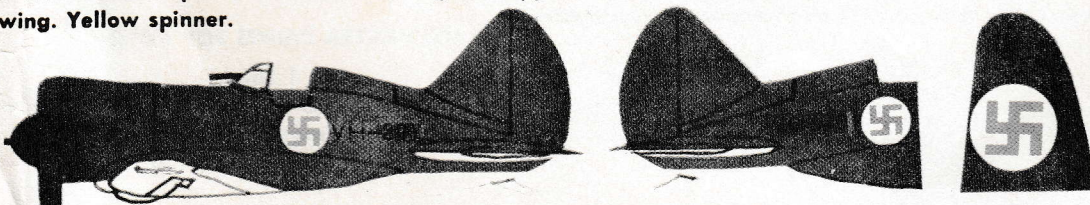

CHINESE TYPE 10. Aircraft of this type flew in defense of Nanking and Chungking. Many were flown by Soviet volunteer pilots 1937 - '39. No. 6 green upper and No. 3 blue lower. Marking upper and lower wing. Yellow spinner.
