RECOMMENDED KITS: Revell in 1/144.

PAINTING: Refer to the photograph below for complete marking information. Paint the entire fuselage and fin white. The wings and tail-planes appear in the standard gray and natural metal patterns. The engine cowlings and pylons are natural metal overall, with burnt metal exhausts. Note the black radome on the extreme tip of the nose.

DECAL APPLICATION: The cheatlines on this decal sheet cover a very large part of the fuselage, so care and patience must be used when applying. The stripes are slightly longer than necessary in case any patching is required. Pay close attention to window and door spacing when applying the fuselage titles. Note that the registration numbers are often seen on the fin as well. The large registration number should be applied to the underneath of the left (port) wing. The IATA logo should be positioned just below and to the rear of the first door on the left (port) side only. The IATA logos are very rarely seen on the right (starboard) side of the fuselage - however, two are provided. The aircraft names should be placed on the nose just below the windscreen. The small fleet numbers should be centered on the nose gear doors. Note that red "IBERIA" titles are often carried on both sides of the engines. Note that we have provided the more commonly seen gray and white door outlines. However, overall gray door outlines have been seen on some aircraft. This decal sheet possesses a constant clear coat. Therefore, cut each piece out individually before soaking in water.

REGISTRATION NUMBERS: The registration numbers EC-DLD/Lopez de Vega, EC-DIA/Tirso de Molina, EC-DIB/Cervantes, EC-DLC/Francisco de Quevedo, EC-GAG/Calderon de la Barca, and EC-EEK/Garcia Lorca are all 747-200s.
