VFA-201 was the first Naval Reserve Squadron to be activated since the Korean War. They deployed on the USS Theodore Roosevelt (CVN-71) as part of Carrier Wing Eight in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. After 6 months out at sea, they returned from their deployment in May of 2003. During the cruise the Hunters were the proud recipients of the Reserve Battle E Award. This award recognizes the squadron for the number of flight hours, number of arrested carrier landings, safety, readiness and training, ordnance delivered, pilot qualifications, mission readiness, enlisted advancement and retention and Hazard Reports (HAZREP).
