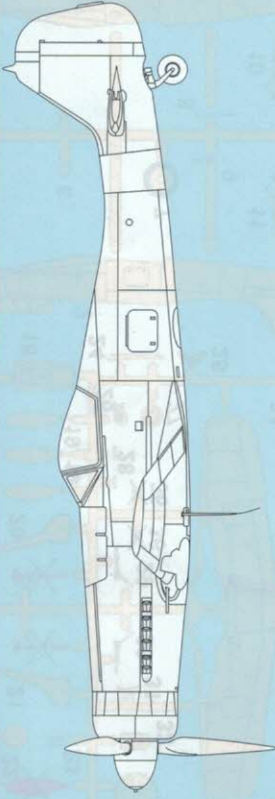

Focke - Wulf Fw 190D-13



Historie

Stíhací letoun Focke-Wulf Fw 190 D, někdy také nazývaný Langnasen-Dora (dlouhonosá Dora). Jako prototypy pro verzi D bylo využito šest letounů Fw 190 A. Letouny byly vybaveny motorem Jumo 213 A. Prototyp V21 dostal nové konce křídla, jež zvětšily rozpětí o 11 cm. Trup byl prodloužen o 50 cm kvůli vyvážení, protože řadový motor Jumo 213 A byl delší než původní hvězdicový motor BMW 801. Letouny byly vyzbrojeny dvěma kulomety MG 17 v trupu a dvěma kanóny MG 151/20.

Další dva letouny obdržely motory Jumo 213 A-1 o výkonu 1 776 k. Výzbroj tvořily dva kulomety MG 131/13 v trupu a čtyři kanóny MG 151/20 v křídlech.

Fw 190 D-13 bylo vyrobeno malé množství 4 až 5 kusů. Pohonnou jednotkou byl motor Jumo 213 F. Výzbroj tvořily tři 20 mm kanóny MG 151/20 E umístěné v kořenech křídla a v ose vrtule. Jeden ze strojů (posledního velitele JG26, Frantze Götz) se dochoval dodnes v USA ve velmi dobrém stavu.

History in brief

Fighter Focke-Wulf Fw 190 D was known as Langnasen-Dora. As prototypes for the Fw 190D version was used six aircraft Fw 190 A. The aircraft was equipped with the engine Jumo 213 A.

The V21 prototype has got a new wingtips, which increased the wingspan over 11 cm. Fuselage has been extended over 50 cm because inline engine Jumo 213 A was longer than the original BMW 801 radial engine. Aircraft were armed with two MG 17 machine guns in the fuselage and two guns MG 151 / 20 cannons in the wings. Next versions were equipped by 1776 PS Jumo 213 A-1 engines. Armament consisted from two MG 131/13 machine guns in the fuselage and four cannons MG 151/20 in the wings.

Fw 190 D-13 was manufactured in a small numbers, 4 to 5 ones. Powerplant was the Jumo 213 F engine. Armament consisted from three 20 mm guns MG 151/20 E, located in wing roots and in the axis of the propeller. The machine of the last commander of JG26, Frantz Götz has been preserved to this day in the USA in very good condition.
