USMC Capt Jeff Kuss, Blue Angels pilot, was killed on 2 June 2016 near Smyrna, TN while preparing for the Great Tennessee Airshow. Capt Kuss was performing a "Split-S" maneuver when his jet impacted the ground.

Capt Kuss was from Durango, Colo., and graduated from Fort Lewis College in 2006. He joined the Blue Angels in September 2014 and had flown more than 1,400 hours, about 150 hours more than is required to join the elite flying team.

VFA-122 painted their 2016 TAC Demo jet with his Blue Angels #6 and his last name to honor Capt Kuss.
