Pilot: Neil D. Stanley was listed as an original 391st FS pilot on 14 Dec 1943. By war's end, Capt. N.D. Stanley claimed 1.5 aircraft, 75 missions, 150 Sorties, 4 Aborts, 194.5 hours as of 4 May 1945.

Colors: Natural metal overall without Black I.D. bands. OD glare panel.

Prop: Curtiss Electric Asymmetrical

Dorsal Fin: Not fitted as delivered but later retrofitted

National Markings: Factory Standard

Stencils: Factory Standard
