

B-29A Superfortress



The B-29A was employed as a long-range heavy bomber to bomb the Japanese mainland from distant bases in China and the Pacific islands. The B-29A was the first aircraft to deliver an atomic bomb in 1945 and served well into the 1950's for both the United States Army Air Force and the United States Air Force.

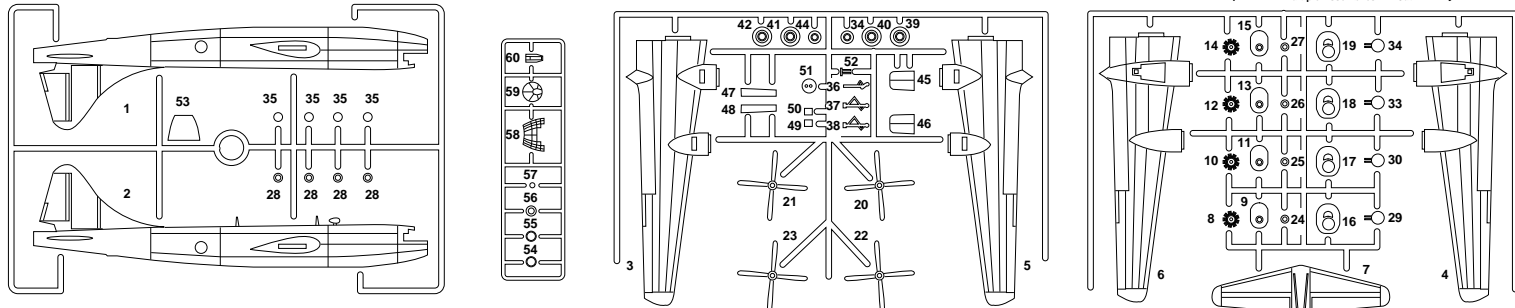

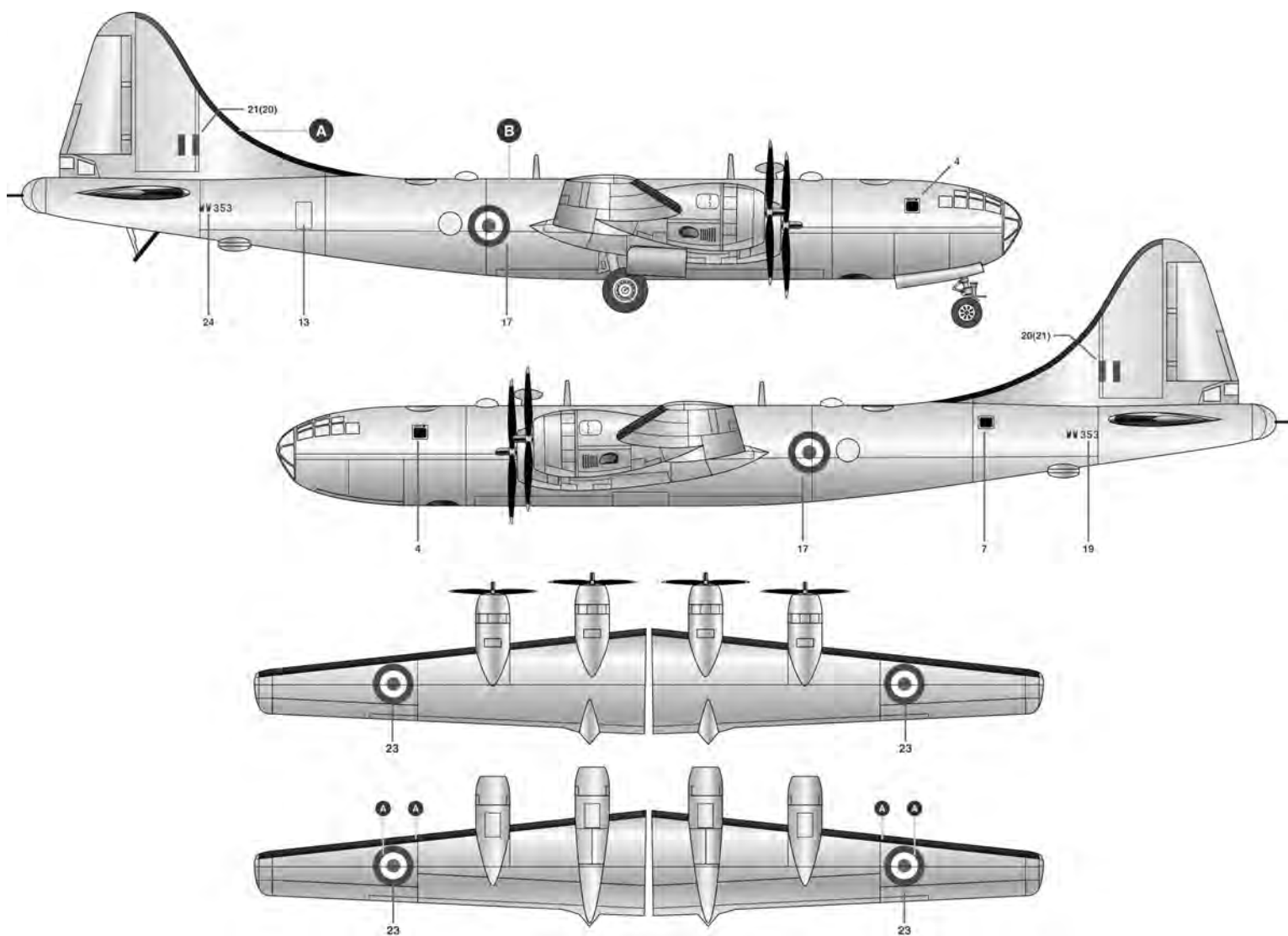
