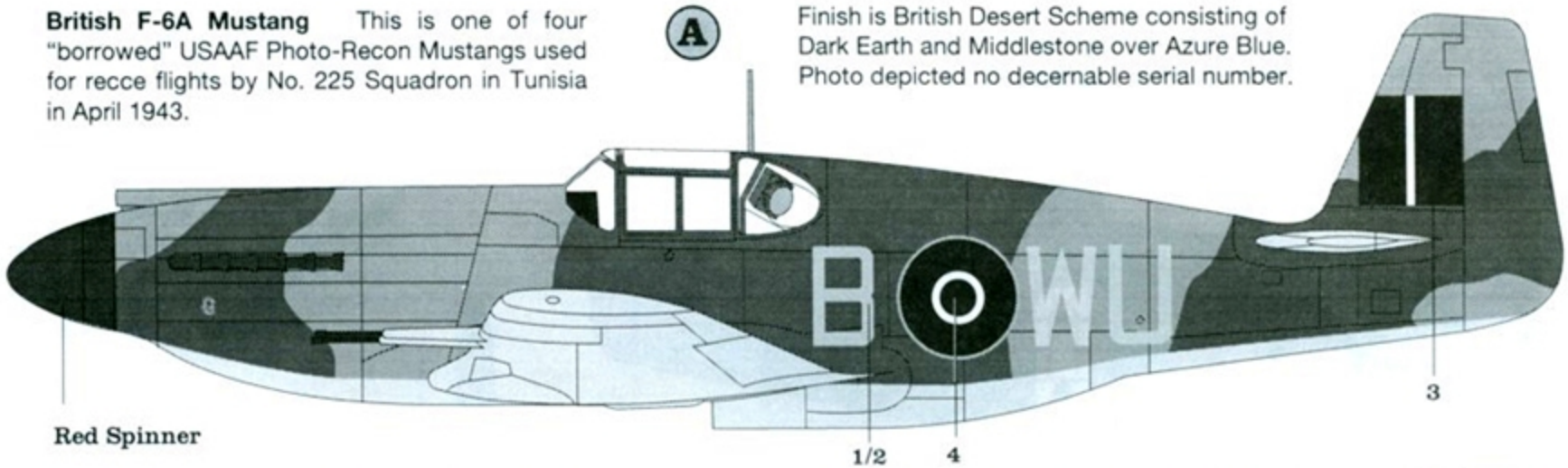

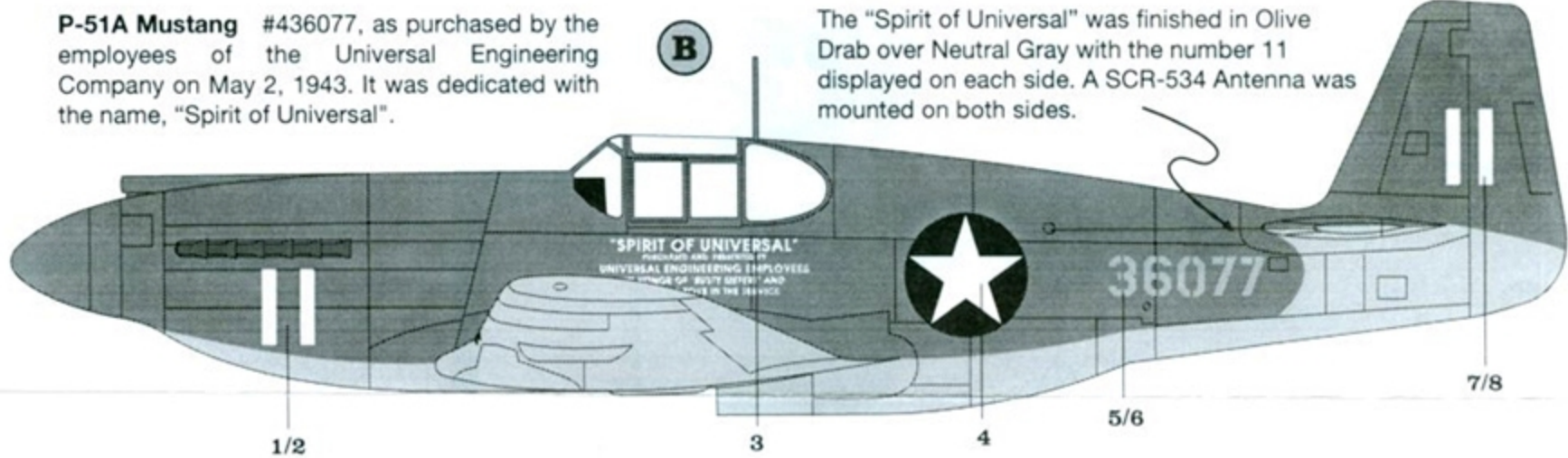
Finish is British Desert Scheme consisting of Dark Earth and Middlestone over Azure Blue. Photo depicted no discernable serial number.



Red Spinner

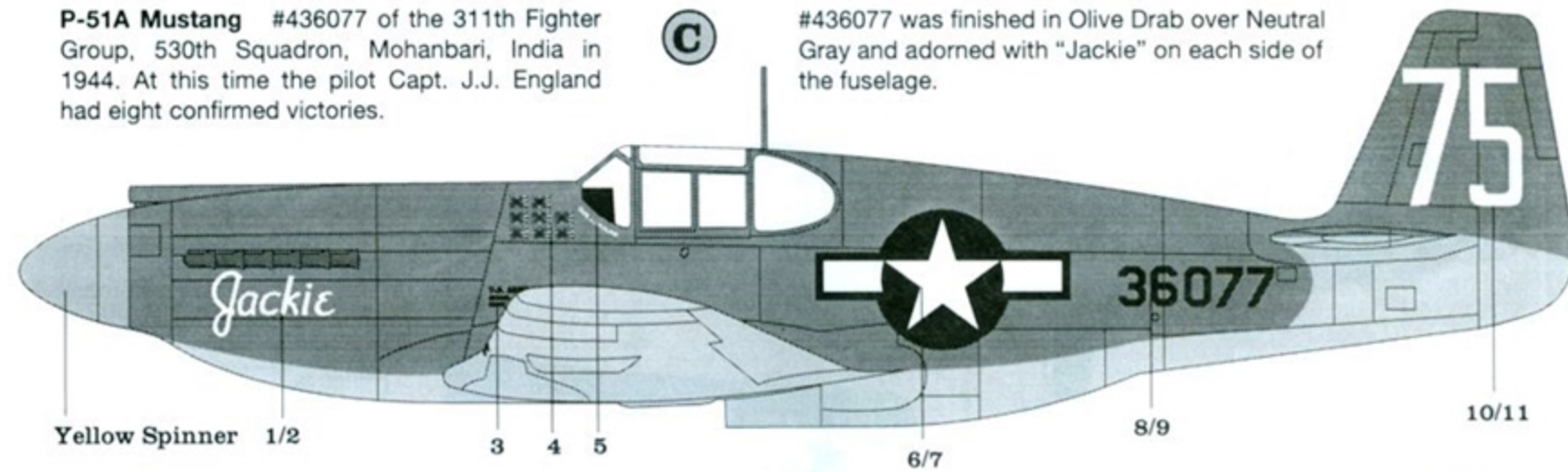
P-51A Mustang #436077, as purchased by the employees of the Universal Engineering Company on May 2, 1943. It was dedicated with the name, "Spirit of Universal".

The "Spirit of Universal" was finished in Olive Drab over Neutral Gray with the number 11 displayed on each side. A SCR-534 Antenna was mounted on both sides.



P-51A Mustang #436077 of the 311th Fighter Group, 530th Squadron, Mohanbari, India in 1944. At this time the pilot Capt. J.J. England had eight confirmed victories.

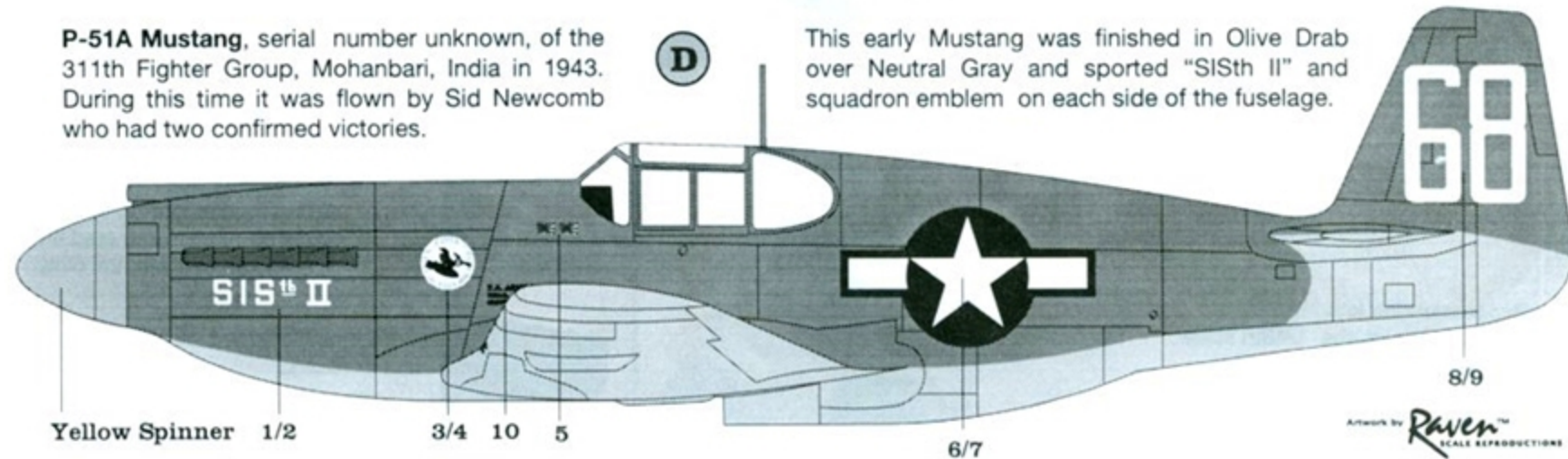
#436077 was finished in Olive Drab over Neutral Gray and adorned with "Jackie" on each side of the fuselage.



Yellow Spinner 1/2

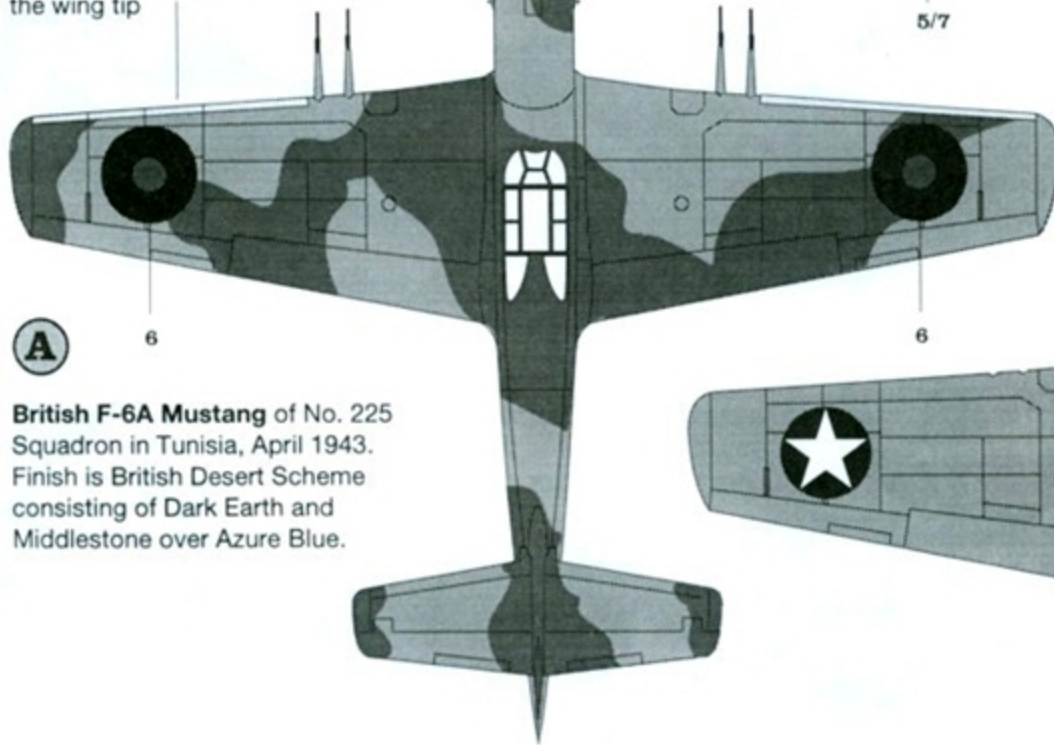
P-51A Mustang, serial number unknown, of the 311th Fighter Group, Mohanbari, India in 1943. During this time it was flown by Sid Newcomb who had two confirmed victories.

This early Mustang was finished in Olive Drab over Neutral Gray and sported "SISth II" and squadron emblem on each side of the fuselage.

Six-inch yellow identification stripes positioned on the upper and lower leading edge from the gun bay to the wing tip

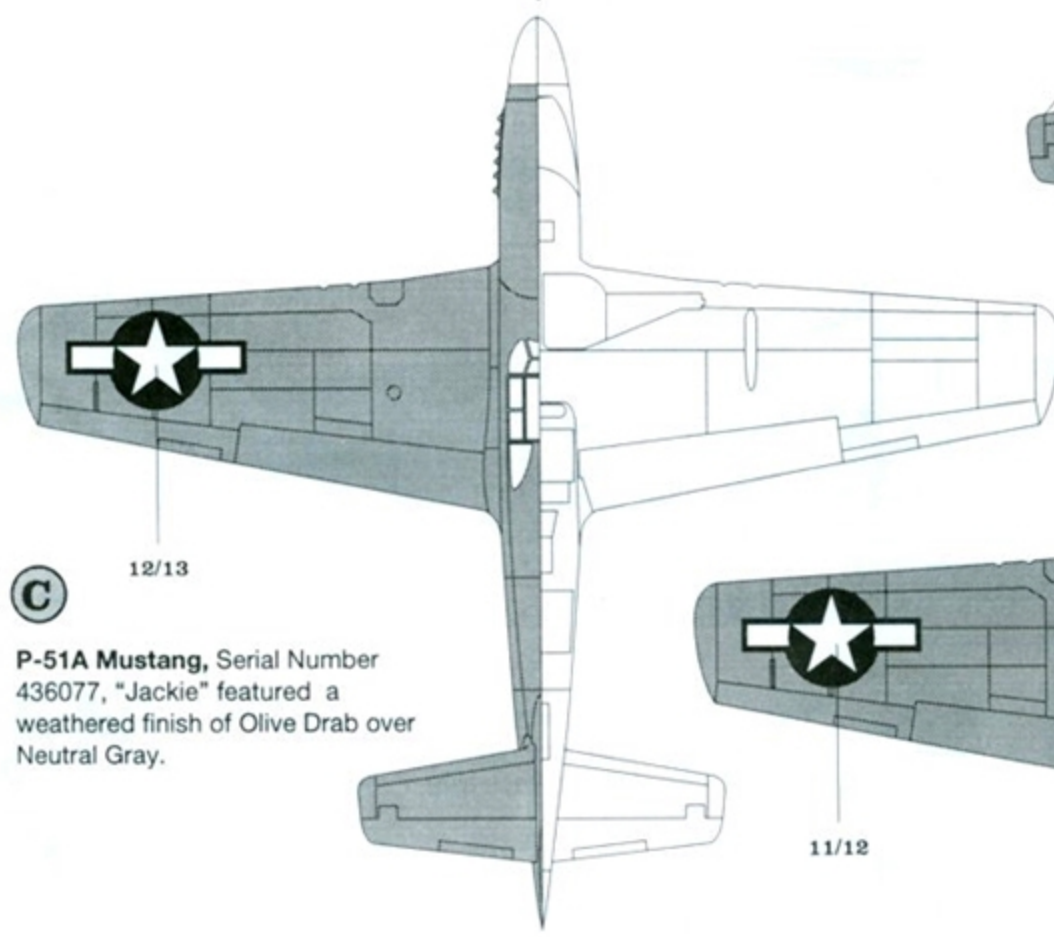
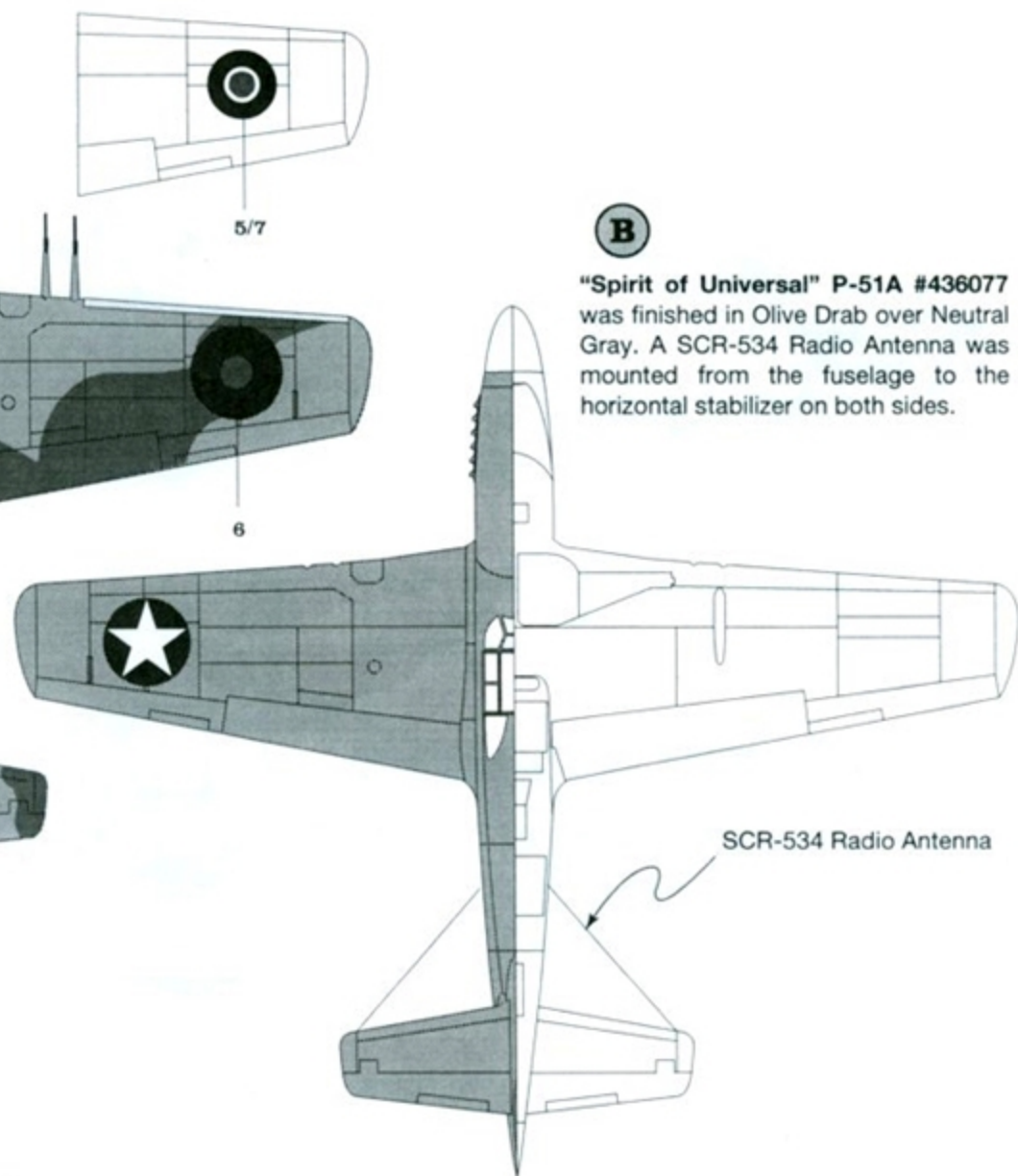

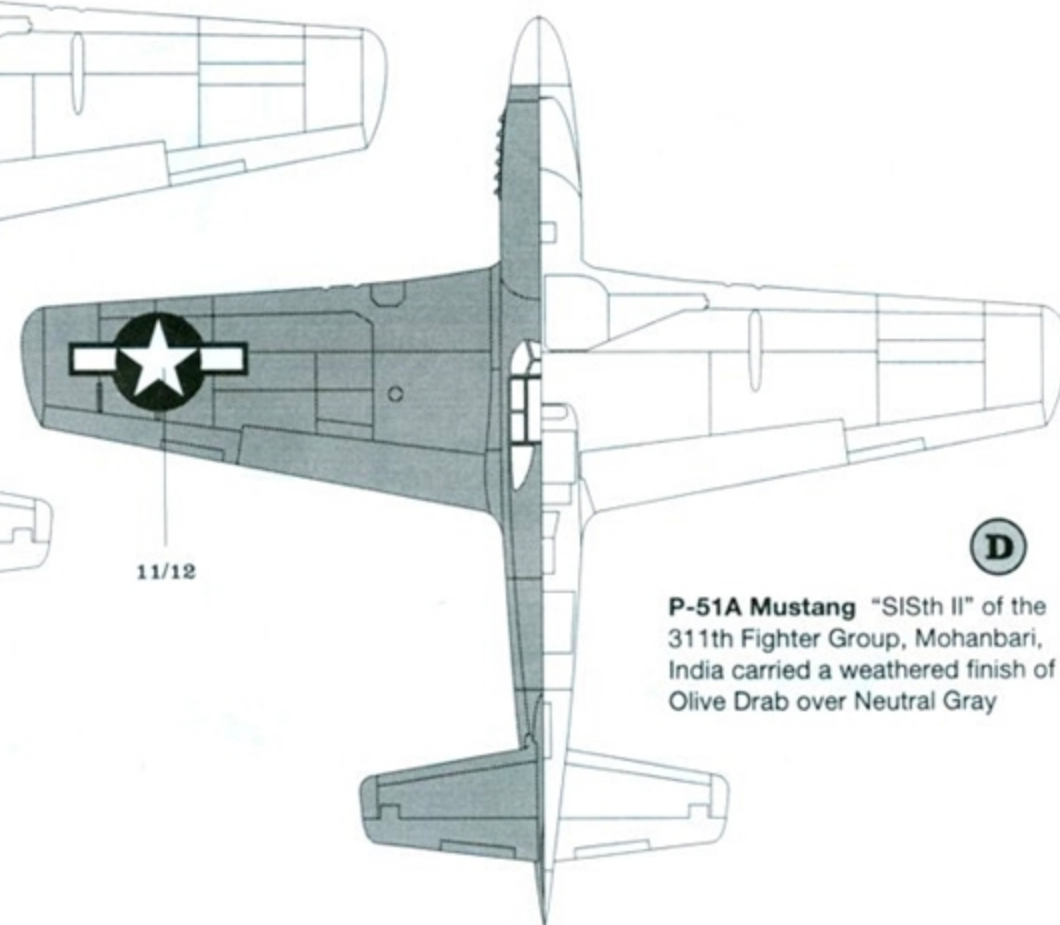
