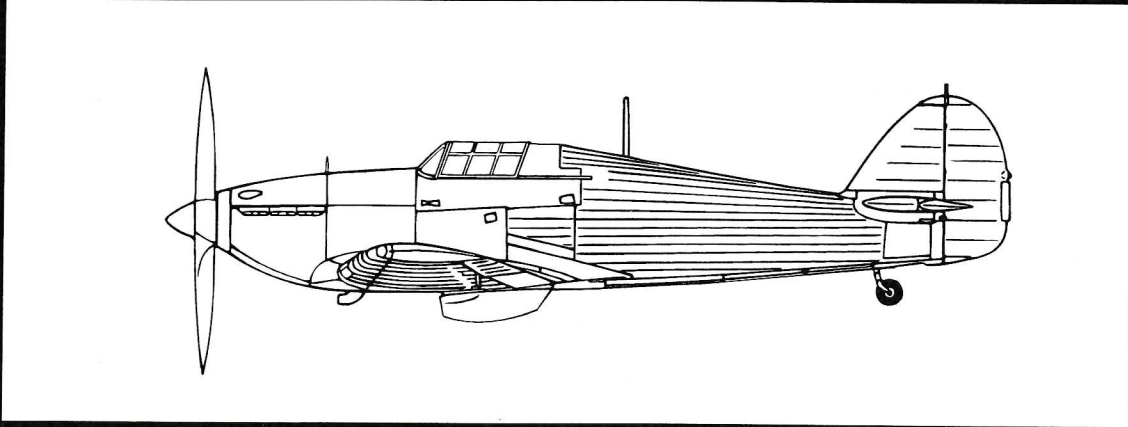




# Classic Airframes



## Hawker Hurricane Mk. I

First flown in November 1935, the Hawker Hurricane requires no introduction. Together with the Supermarine Spitfire, the two aircraft spearheaded the British aircraft industry into the forefront of "Modern Fighter" development. This kit presents for the first time in 1/48th scale the earliest operational version of this aircraft, distinctive because of its fabric covered wings.

As well as serving with the RAF, the aircraft immediately caught the eye of foreign governments looking for modern fighters and it was exported to Belgium, Finland, Yugoslavia, Turkey, Rumania, South Africa. It was also ordered by Poland, but they never arrived.

The Hurricane's original fabric wings were gradually replaced by metal although some aircraft used their original wings well into the Battle of Britain.

Classic Airframes is pleased to offer this variant of this distinguished aircraft. We would like to thank Steven Eisenman and Jim Maas for their cooperation in this project.

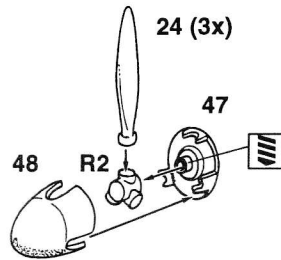
Fuselage interior and tubular structure



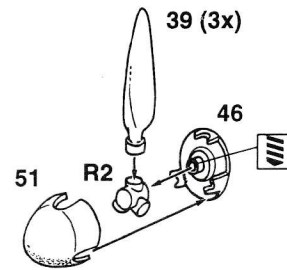

Propeller**



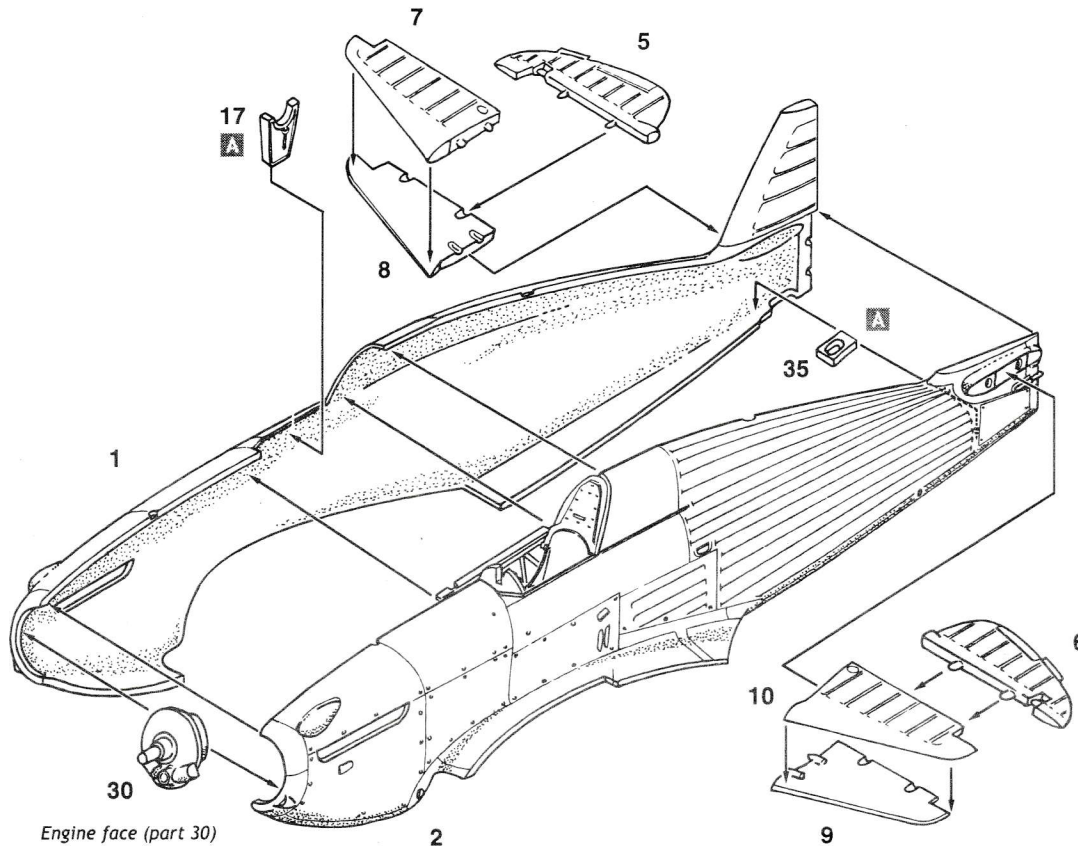

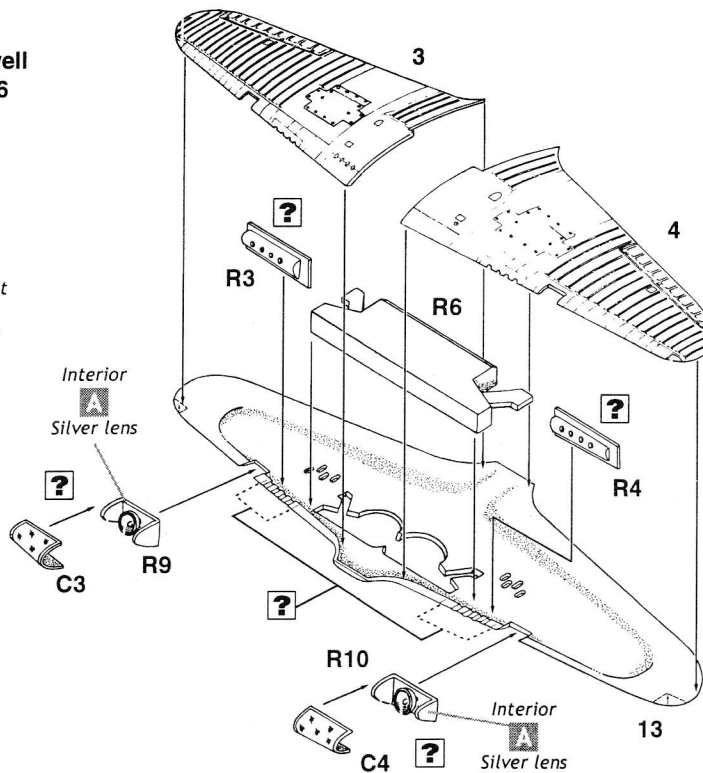
The wheel well part R6 has been resin-cast to capture greater detail. Due to molding limitations, this entailed a large pour stub that must be removed. This is illustrated above by the dashed area. Carefully cut and sand this area away and dry-fit and trim to fit between parts 3/4 and 13.



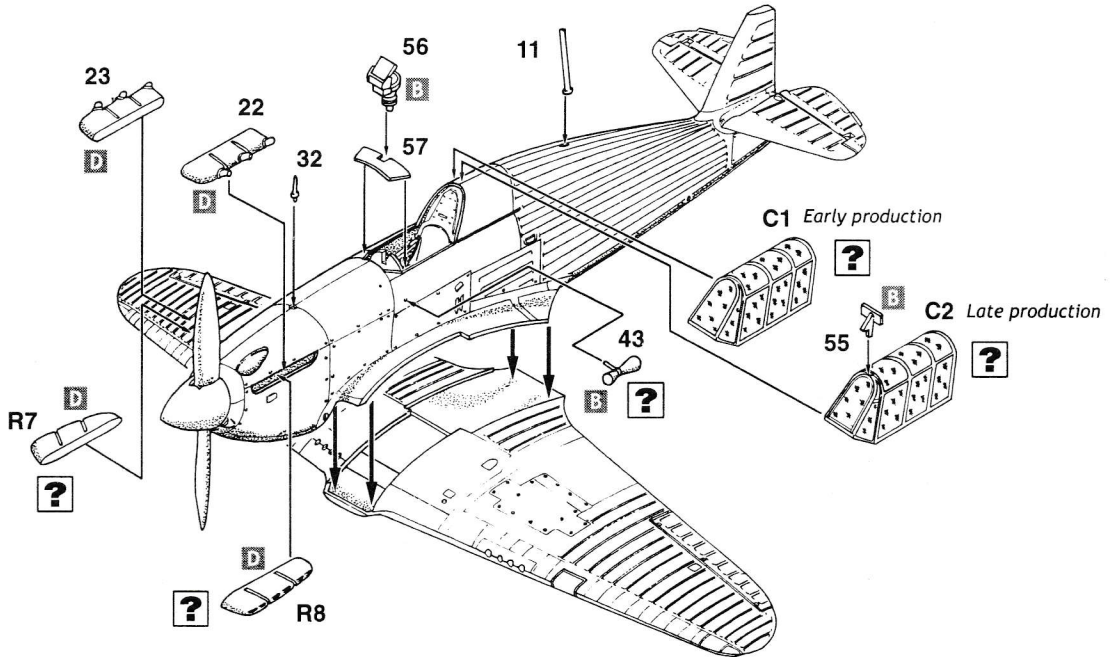
OPTIONS

Gun ports R3 and R4 are optional. You must remove the appropriate sections of the wing leading edge to fit.

Landing light assemblies R9/C3 and R10/C4 are optional. You must remove the appropriate sections of the wing leading edge to fit.



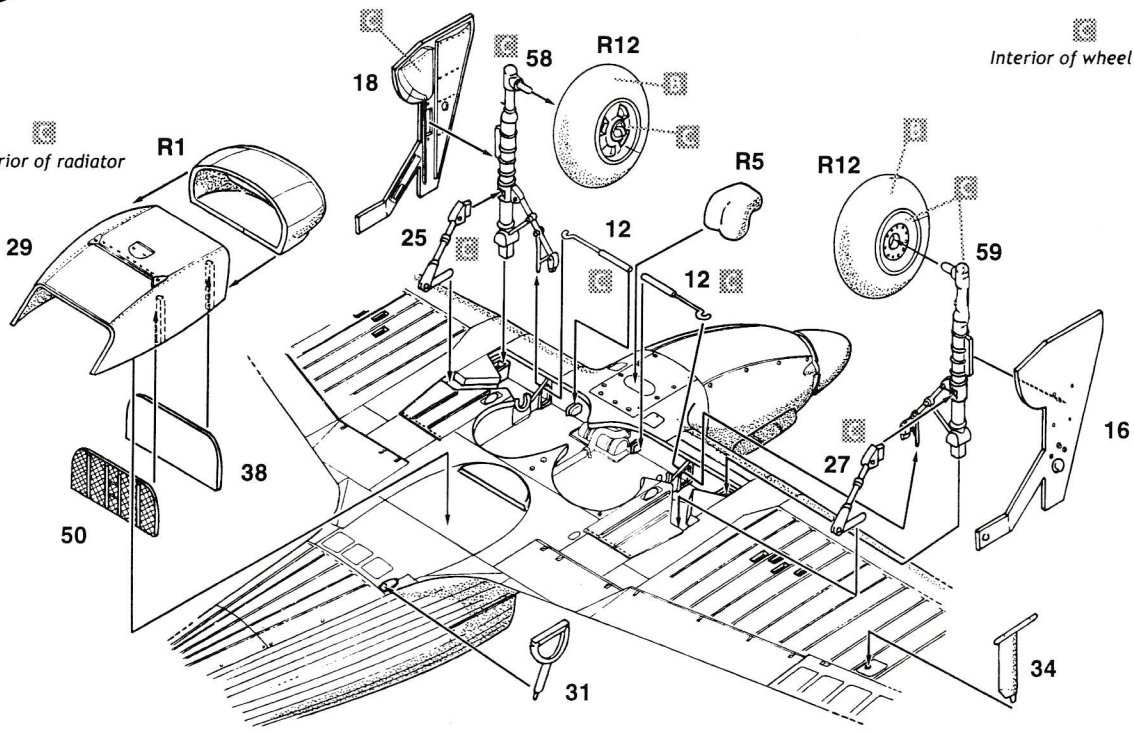

Interior of radiator

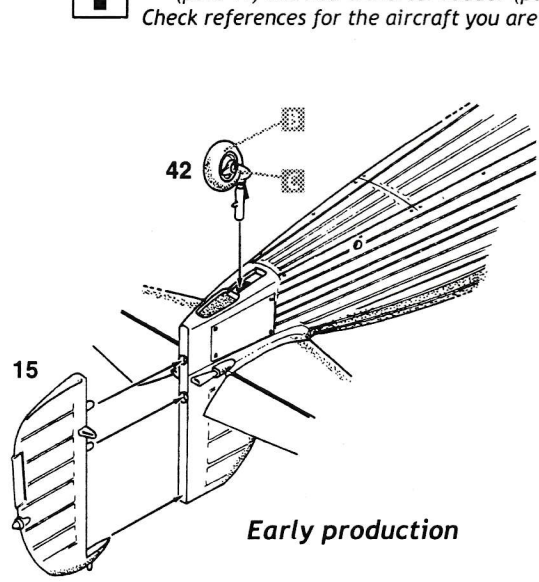
Interior of wheel wells



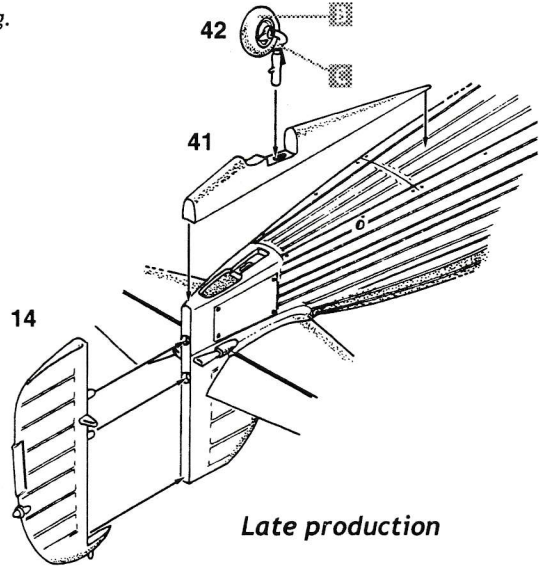
