


# Hellenic Air Force AB205 SAR

The Hellenic Air Force (HAF) uses the AB 205 and AB 205A-1 in the Search And Rescue (SAR) role, the type first entering service in 1971. It replaced the elderly Sikorsky H-19 then in service with the 358 SAR sgn., based at Elefsis AB near Athens, In 1976 more helicopters were received and in later vears a few more were also handed over to the HAF by the Hellenic Army's aviation arm. The squadron's aircraft can be detached to air bases all over Greece to provide SAR capabilities. The AB 205A-1 can be distinguished from the AB 205 by the position of its tail rotor. The AB 205 A1 has the tail rotor on the right (starboard) side and the AB 205 on the left (port) side. The tail rotor markings are also different. On the AB 205A-1 the blades



have three black stripes while on the AB 205 only one wider red stripe. Originally, and until some time in the late 1980s, both sub types carried a red stripe on their tail rotor blades as shown in the photo below.





These helicopters have always been finished in a Green - Dark Grey- Light Grey scheme with a broad yellow band (FS 13538) outlined in black to signify their SAR role. The two top colours have varied with two combinations having been seen: FS 34064 with FS 36081 and FS 34079 with FS 6270. The undersides have always been finished in FS 36622. Markings are fairly standard with only detail variations sometimes apparent between machines.

Roundels appear on both surfaces of both the horizontal stabilizers.






The emergency flotation bags may be light grey or almost black. Likewise the "Barracuda" logo on the emergency flotation bags can vary from one machine to another.

**NOTE:** The modeller can portray aircraft 4396 by separating the last "9" from marking 14 and turning this upside down to create the "6".








NOTE: Markings 17 and 21 are for the port side doors. Markings 16 and 22 are for the starboard side doors.
