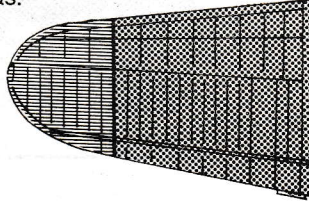
This decal sheet contains markings and insignia for sixteen aircraft of the Spanish Republican Air Force (FARE) covering a period during the Civil War of 1937 to 1939. The aircraft included on this sheet are: the **Tupolev SB-2 "Katiuska"** (Kit by FROG or NOVO); the **Polikarpov I-16** (Kit by REVELL) and the **Canadian Car & Foundry G-23** (licence built **Grumman FF-1**) (Vacuum Formed Kit by ESOTERIC). The Spanish Nationalist Air Force is covered on Blue Rider Decal Sheet BR215. There will be further sheets covering this period of aviation from Blue Rider.

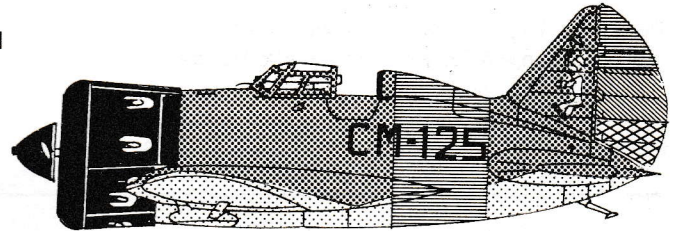

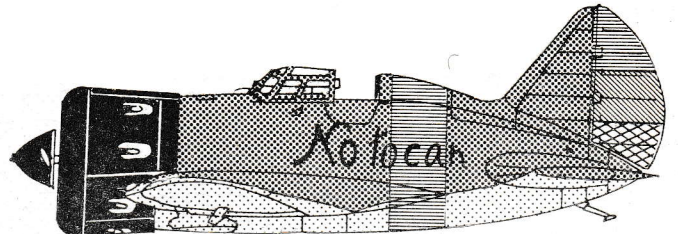

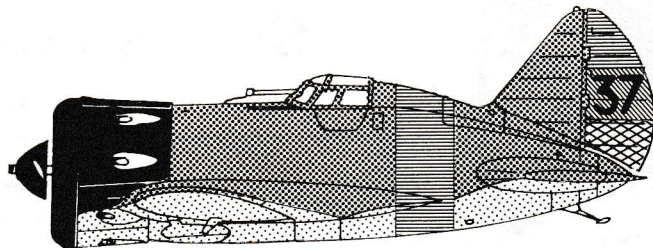
