Bf 109G-6/Trop, 7/JG 27, piloted by Obl. Emil Klade, Kalamaki, Greece, Jan., 1944. RLM 74 Graugr n & RLM 75 Grauviolett over RLM 76 Lichtblau with White fuselage band and rudder. Prop spinner is 1/3 White, 2/3 Black. Mottling is RLM 74/75

Bf-109G-6 "White 11", 7./JG 3, Winter 1943/44. The paint scheme was the standard RLM 74/75 upper surfaces with RLM 76 lower surfaces. A large patch of RLM 02 covers a previous tactical number. The spinner was RLM 70 (or Black) with a White spiral. A White stripe was applied to the rear fuselage. This aircraft had the lower piece of the landing gear doors removed. Underwing cannons were installed on this aircraft.



A/C 3: Bf 109 G6 of 3/HLeLv 24. Flown by Master Sergeant L. Ahokas, Lappeeranta, Finland, June 1944. Typical German 74/75/76 camouflage with Yellow lower front nose, lower wing tips and fuselage band. A/C logged 390 hours until discharged from service in 1954. 4 victories. At the time depicted here, it is very likely that the A/C had German Stencils.
