RCAF CF-104D Starfighter

On the early 1960's the Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) was looking for a new supersonic aircraft to substitute the F-86 Sabre. The choice was to produce locally the Canadair CF-104 Starfighter (CF-111, CL-90), which was a modified version of the Lockheed F-104 Starfighter supersonic fighter aircraft built under licence. It was primarily used as a ground attack aircraft, despite being designed as an interceptor. It served with the RCAF and later the Canadian Armed Forces until it was replaced by the McDonnell Douglas CF-118 Hornet.

CF-104 was optimized for the nuclear strike/reconnaissance role, fitted with R-24A NASARR equipment dedicated to the air-to-ground mode only as well as having provision for a ventral reconnaissance pod equipped with four Vinten cameras. Other differences included retaining the removable refueling probe, initial deletion of the fuselage-mounted 20 mm (.79 in) M61A1 cannon (replaced by an additional fuel cell) and the main undercarriage members being fitted with longer-stroke liquid springs and larger tires.

The Twin Seater Variant called CF-104D was full operational for the same missions of the Single Seater, but normally fly unarmed. They served as Operational Conversion Aircraft, preparing new pilots for the Starfighter. In total 200 CF-104 are built by Canadair for the Royal Canadian Air Force
