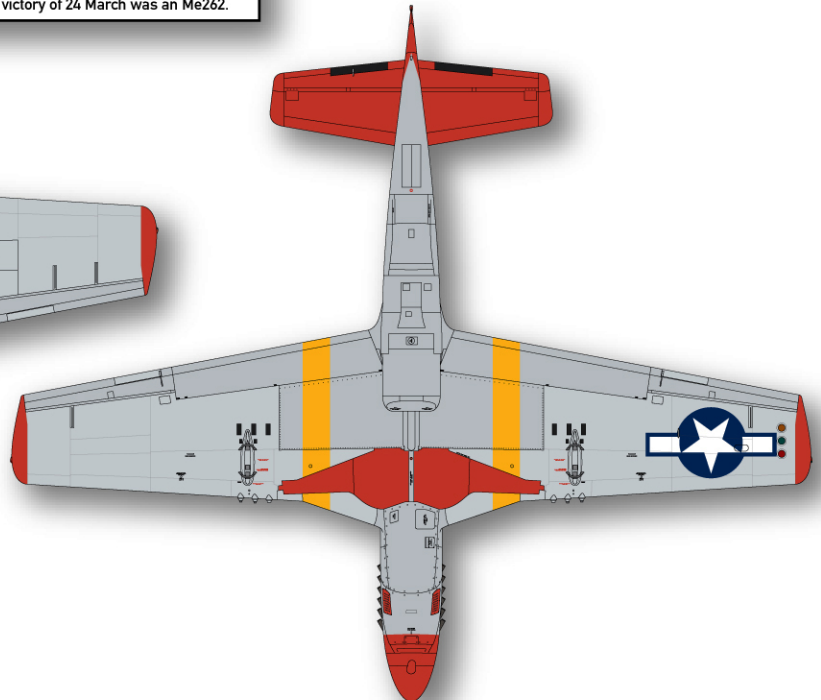
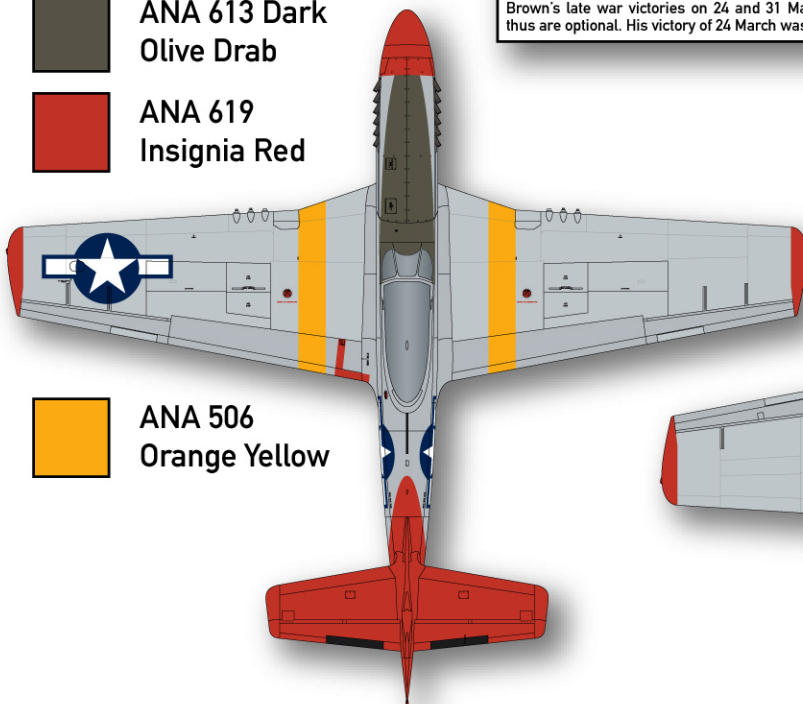

Detail Note

Captain Roscoe Brown's "Bunnie" was an Inglewood-built P-51D-15-NA. Points to note are the K-14 gunsight and the homing beacon wire antenna from the fin to the armor plate behind the seat. Her exhaust stacks were shrouded. "Bunnie" was otherwise very much standard. Frequently seen carrying 75 gallon teardrop metal drop tanks.

Markings were most likely standard ANA 619 Insignia Red (FS 11310) and ANA 506 Orange Yellow (FS 13538). Trim tabs on the rudder and elevators were gloss black, denoting the 100th FS. Kill markings would have been applied after Brown's late war victories on 24 and 31 March 1945, and thus are optional. His victory of 24 March was an Me262.
